Gabriela was born in Buenos Aires, Argentina, in 1962. She has walked a fertile spiritual path, which fueled her work with a philosophical conception. Since she was a little girl, painting has been a part of her life in most of its stages.

After having been a businesswoman and a professional in the area of Marketing, as well as having engaged in activities such as drama and poetry, Gabriela woke up to a deep understanding of her existence. The portals of her creativity were opened through her works of art as a result of everything she has experienced. Tolomei is recognized as one of the most emerging artists in Argentina with an international level. Her career includes exhibitions in: New York, Miami, Palm Beach, Los Angeles, Barcelona, Madrid, Mexico City, Punta del Este, London, Paris, Munich, Stockholm, and Qatar.

SOCIAL RESPONSABILITY

Gabriela has been and will continue to be a highly active artist in the field of social responsibility, creating pieces of art and donating them to various hospitals in different locations around the world, bringing the alchemy of healing colors and positive energy that helps heal the body and soul of those who must go to a hospital.

She has actively collaborated for 12 years in donating her work to the Divino Niño Orchestra in Tucumán.

Furthermore, a significant charity-oriented campaign by the non-profit organization "Doctors Without Borders" began in the summer of 2019 and lasted for 3 months. It involved the creation of a special sale featuring some of her works. This campaign also received support from Arlene Angard's Gallery in NYC.

One of her large-format works, titled "New York," was donated to Mount Sinai Hospital in NYC and garnered full coverage of this donation in DESIGN Magazine NYC.


