	D Pitching/Networking _	(Example: 48 weeks x 7 hours/wk = 336)
	E Business Management _	(Example: 48 weeks x 2 hours/wk = 96)
	F Administrative/Other _	(Example: 48 weeks x 7 hours/wk = 336)
