

## Cleaning a Thermocouple in a P9000/P12000

- 1. Remove the bottom panel by removing the 2 screws on the side. The bottom panel will not drop out as the fan wires will hold it in place. Just move it out of the way.
- 2. Locate the copper wire coming out of the bottom of the valve.
- 3. Disconnect the copper wire using an 8mm wrench.
- 4. Lightly sand the end of the thermocouple with fine sand paper or a rough scouring pad.
- 5. Reconnect the thermocouple into the valve. Ensure the connection is tight.
- 6. Replace the bottom panel.
