

## Replacing the original fan in a P9000/P12000 with the 3" boxer fan part# 01-042

- 1. Undo  $2 ext{ screws} 1 ext{ each side} ext{located at the bottom of the unit to}$  disconnect the bottom cover plate. Remove the cover.
- 2. Undo the knot holding the black and red power wires together
- 3. Unscrew the screws holding the fan in place
- 4. Disconnect the red wire from the rheostat (speed control) and remove fan from unit
- 5. Connect red wire of the new fan on the rheostat to the same tab that you just removed the old one from.
- 6. Attach new fan using screws and washers provided. Make sure the washers go between the fan bracket and the unit.
- 7. Tie the black wire from the fan and the red wire from the on/off switch in a knot so that the knot will come below the bottom of the heater.
- 8. Replace the bottom cover making sure to thread the red and black wires through the white grommet hole on the bottom.
