- ✓ Pencil bag with pencils, eraser, sharpener, scissors, glue, wax crayons and pencil crayons
- ✓ Set of 12 to 24 soft pastels (NOT oil pastels)
- ✓ Neutral or earth-tone pastel paper pad of 160gsm thickness, at least 12 sheets
