# MAKING THE BOOTIES

NOTE: The booties are worked with the U.S. size E-4 / 3.5 mm hook.

### **LEFT BOOTIE**

With white, ch 13.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, 3 sc in same st, 7 sc, 1 hdc, 3 dc, and then work 8 dc in last st. With these 8 dc, turn so you are working back along the underside of the foundation chain; work across underside with 3 dc, 1 hdc, 7 sc, 2 sc in last st, and join to work in the round with 1 sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> ch.

Rnds 2-9: Continue following chart. Cut yarn.

### **RIGHT BOOTIE**

Work as for left bootie.

### FLOWER (Make 2 Alike)

With yellow, begin with a loop formed using the end of the varn.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, 12 sc around loop, and join to work in the round with 1 sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> ch. Cut yarn.

Rnd 2: Join white; ch 1, \*1 sc, ch 3, 2 tr in next st, ch 3\*; rep \* to \* 5 more times and end with 1 sl st in 1st ch. Cut yarn.

Make a second flower the same way so you have 1 for each bootie.

## FINISHING

### FOR EACH BOOTIE

Weave in ends.

Sew a flower to front instep.

Glue a ladybug to the flower.
