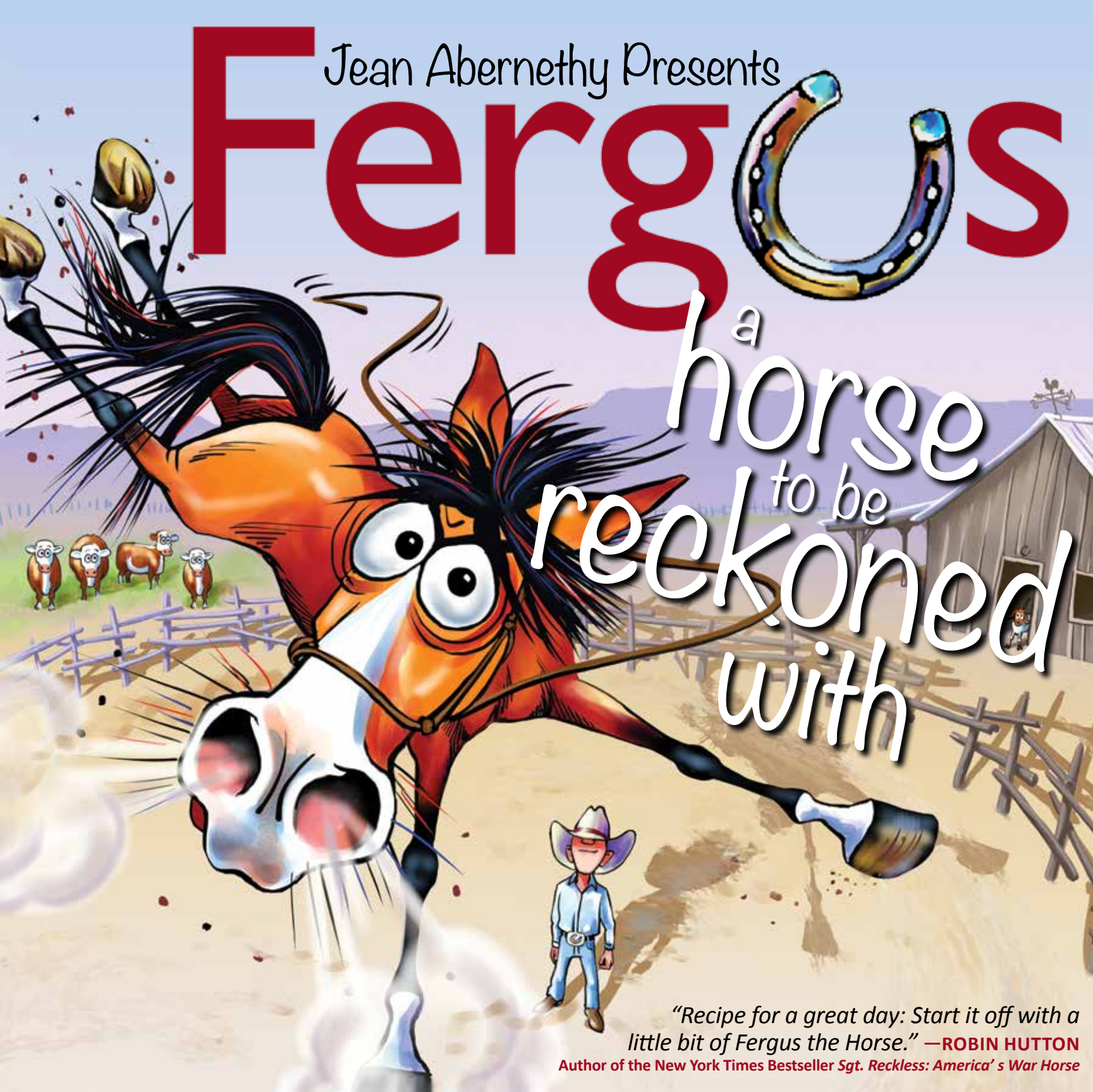

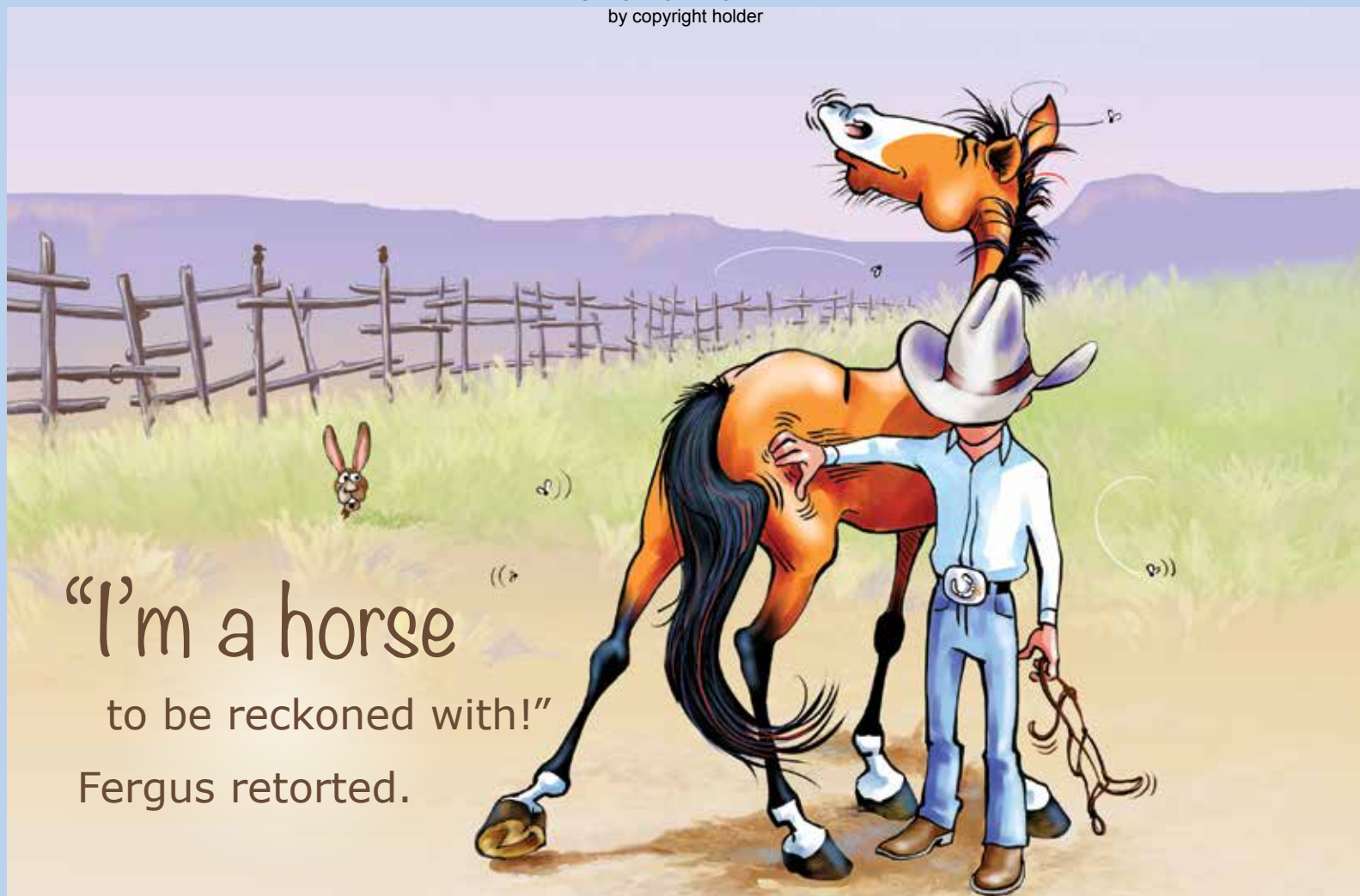

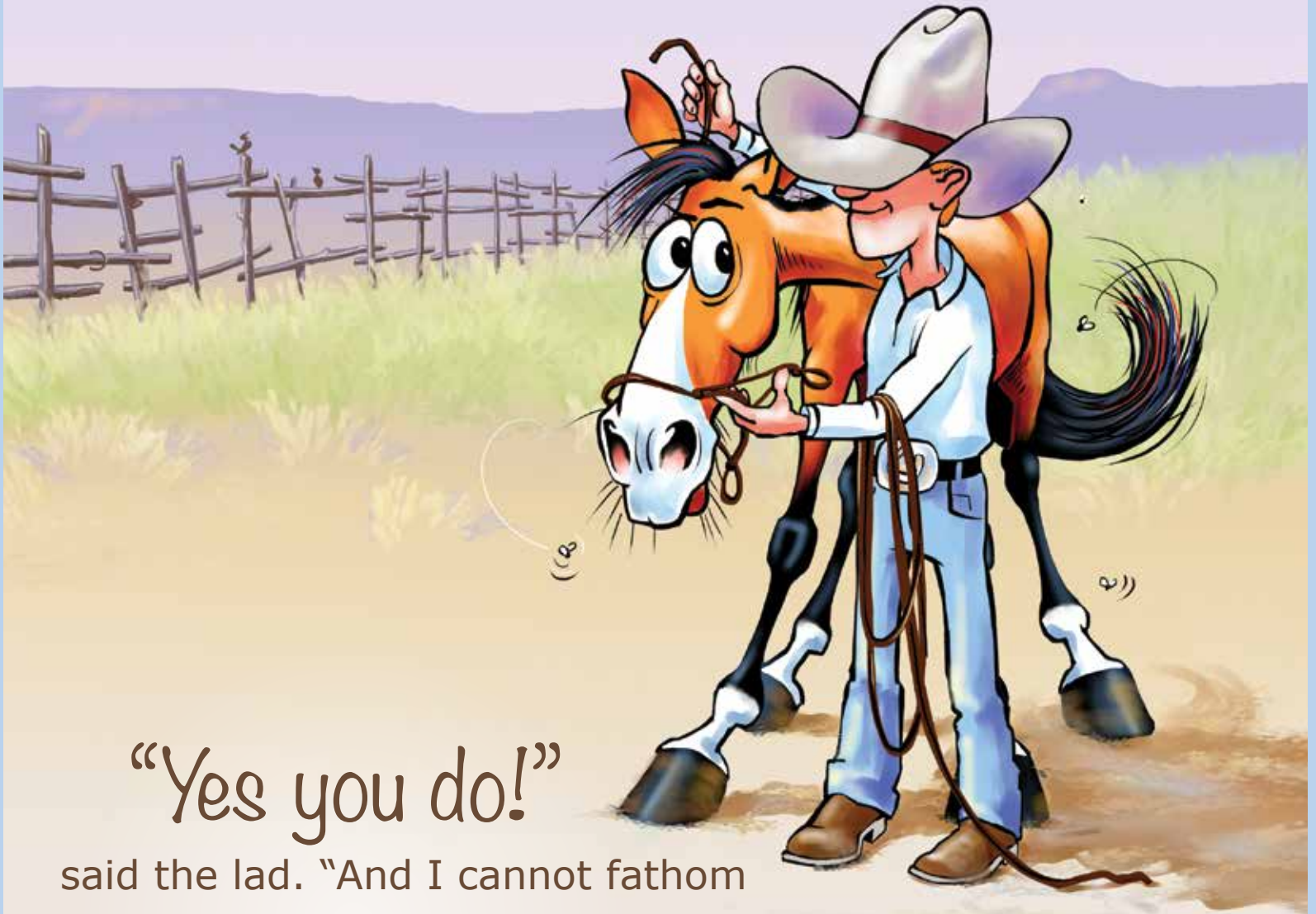

said the lad. “And I cannot fathom

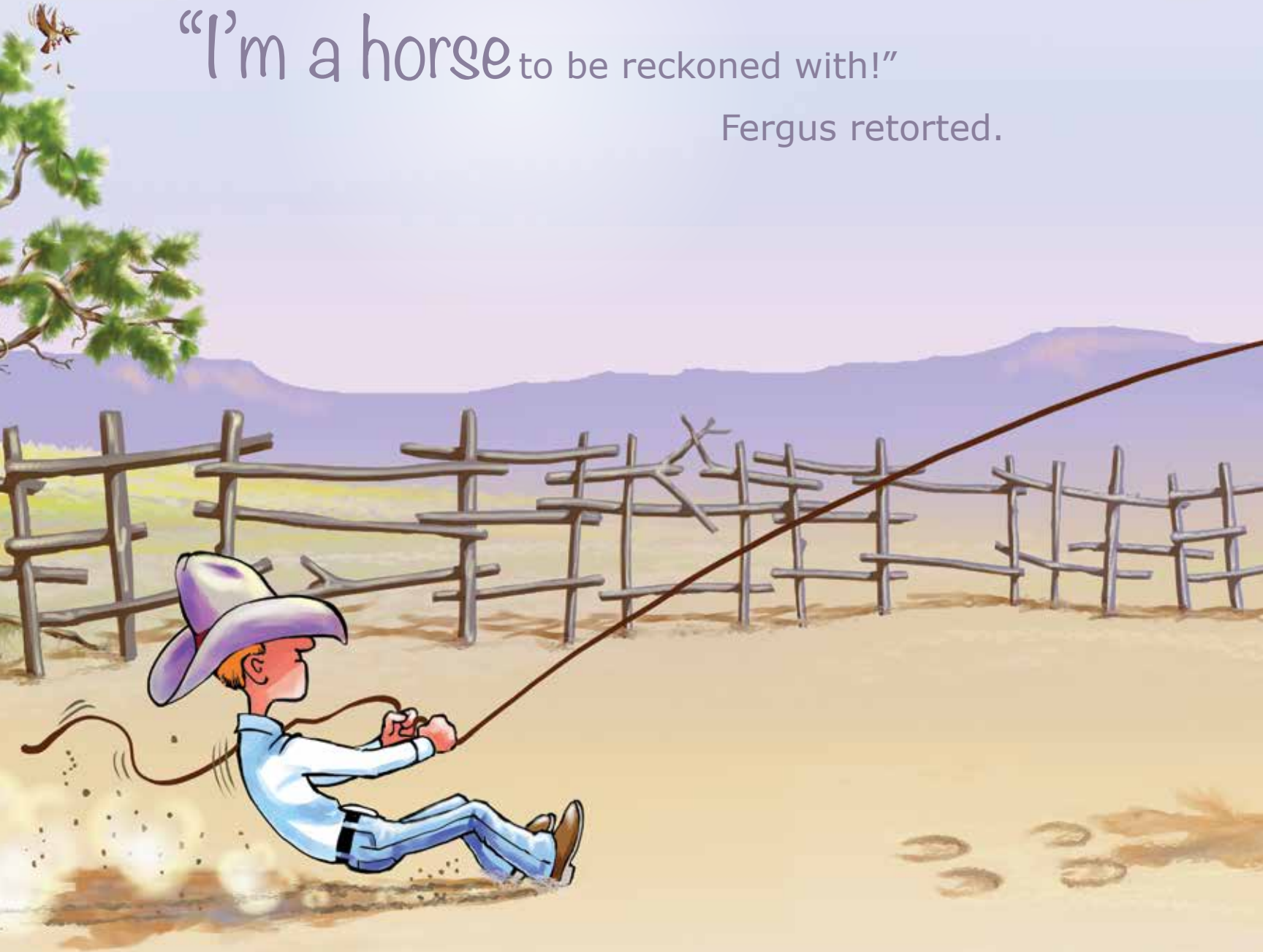
why this little thing should not accent your face.

It’s perfectly safe, doesn’t rub, doesn’t chafe;

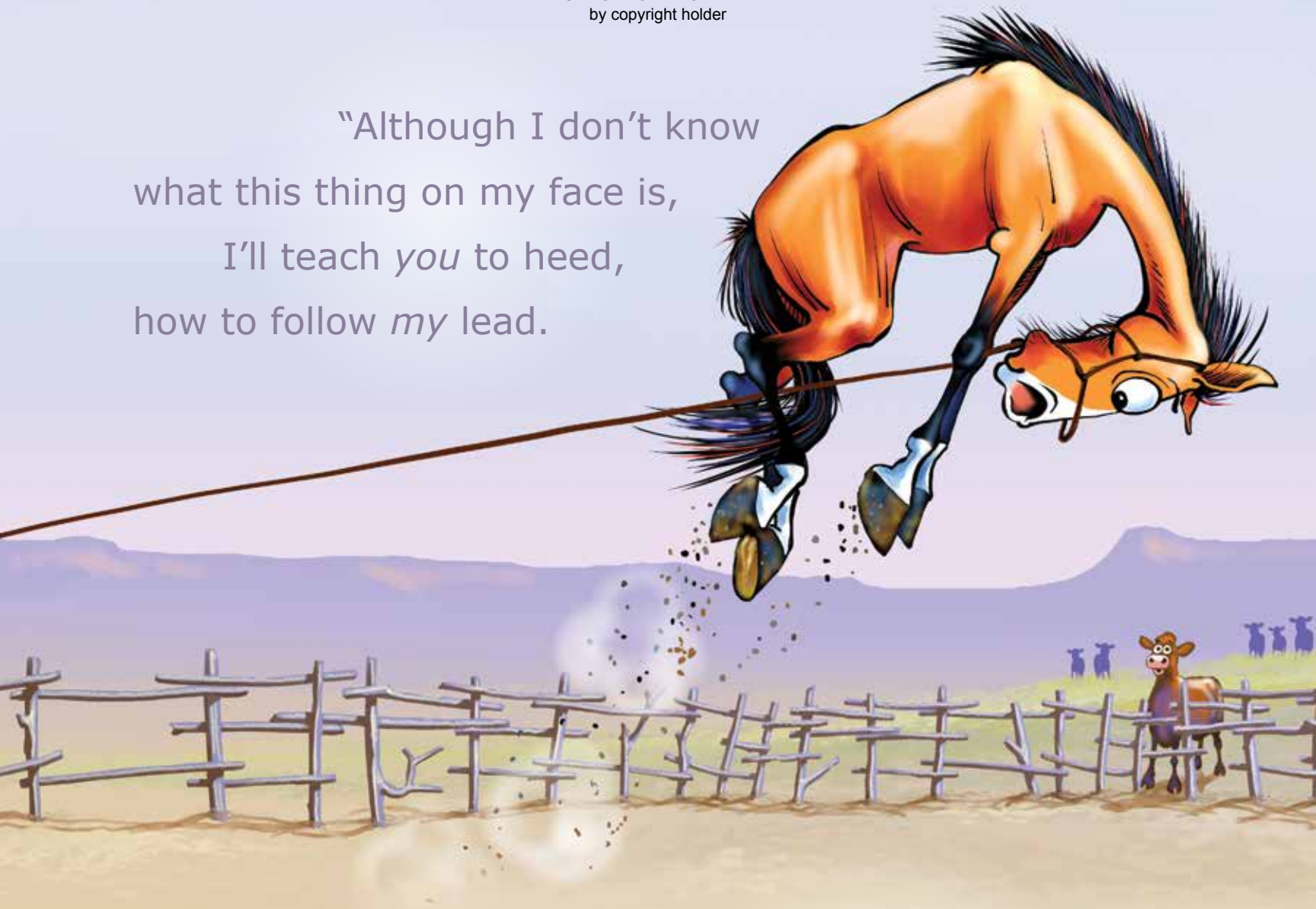
you’ll find you can wear it with poise and with grace!”
