

ANATOMY SPINAL – Spinal Nerve Plexuses

5. One of two nerves that are derived from C5-T1 spinal nerve roots.
8. Nerve which innervates the latissimus dorsi muscle.
9. Nerve which passes through the quadrangular space and innervates the teres minor muscle.
11. Occipital nerve derived from C2 and perhaps C3.
14. Movement of the ankle that is weakened with damage to L4 spinal nerve root.
16. Brachial plexus nerve which innervates the supraspinatus muscle.
17. Muscle innervated by C1 of the cervical plexus.
18. Part of the fibula around which the common peroneal nerve winds.
19. Part of the common peroneal nerve which innervates the peroneus longus and brevis.
22. Muscle group in the hand which is innervated by the median nerve.
24. Strap muscle innervated by the ansa cervicalis.
25. Gluteal muscle which is supplied by the inferior gluteal nerve.
27. Muscle in which the lumbar plexus is formed.
28. Cord from which the musculocutaneous nerve is derived.
29. Cord from which the radial and axillary nerves are derived.
30. Branch of the femoral nerve which innervates skin over the medial aspect of the leg.

1. Nerve which innervates the adductor longus muscle.
2. Thigh compartment innervated by the femoral nerve.
3. Triangle in which the roots of the brachial plexus are located.
4. Palsy caused by traction injury to the two lower roots of the brachial plexus.
6. Position of the forearm in a child with Erb-Duchenne's.
7. Scapula deformity related to damage to the long thoracic nerve.
10. Lumbar plexus nerve which supplies the skin in the inguinal region.
12. Gluteal nerve which innervates the tensor fascia latae muscle.
13. Part of the common peroneal nerve which innervates the skin in the first dorsal web space.
15. Cervical plexus nerve derived from C3 and C4.
20. Lumbar plexus nerve which innervates the sartorius muscle.
21. Nerve which innervates the hamstring part of the adductor magnus muscle.
23. Parts of the brachial plexus which lie behind the clavicle.
26. Nerve which is derived from S2, S3 and S4 spinal nerves.
