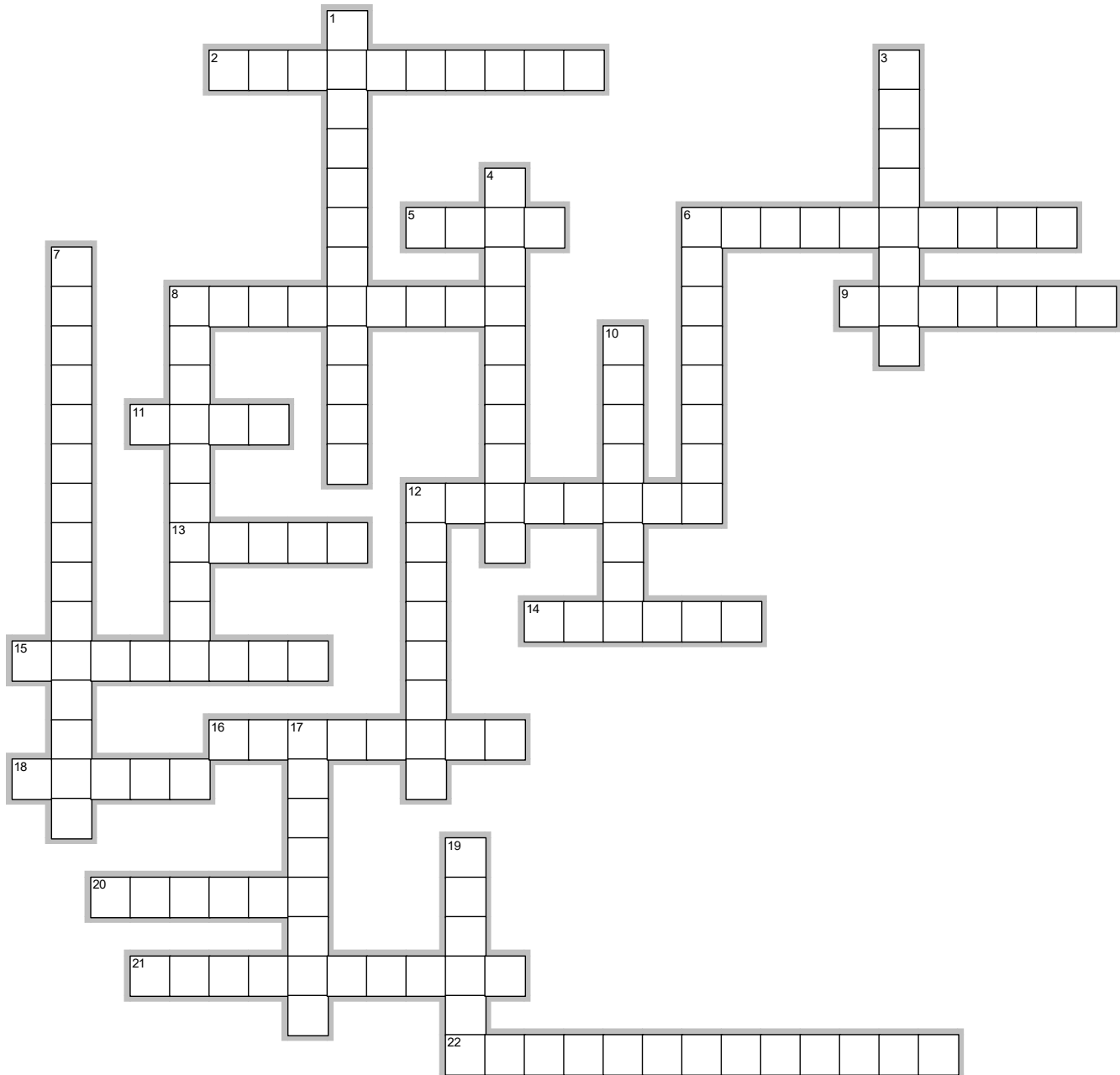

12. Protozoan spread by orofecal contamination and causes bloody diarrhea.
13. Naegleria fowleri is this type of parasite.
14. Type of Taenia associated with eating under cooked infested pork.
15. Balantidium coli is this type of parasite.
16. Bug which spreads Trypanosoma cruzi.
18. Type of mosquito which spreads Wuchereria bancrofti.
20. Organism which carries the parasite but shows no ill effects.
21. Trichomonas vaginalis is this type of parasite.
22. Disease caused by Wuchereria bancrofti.
