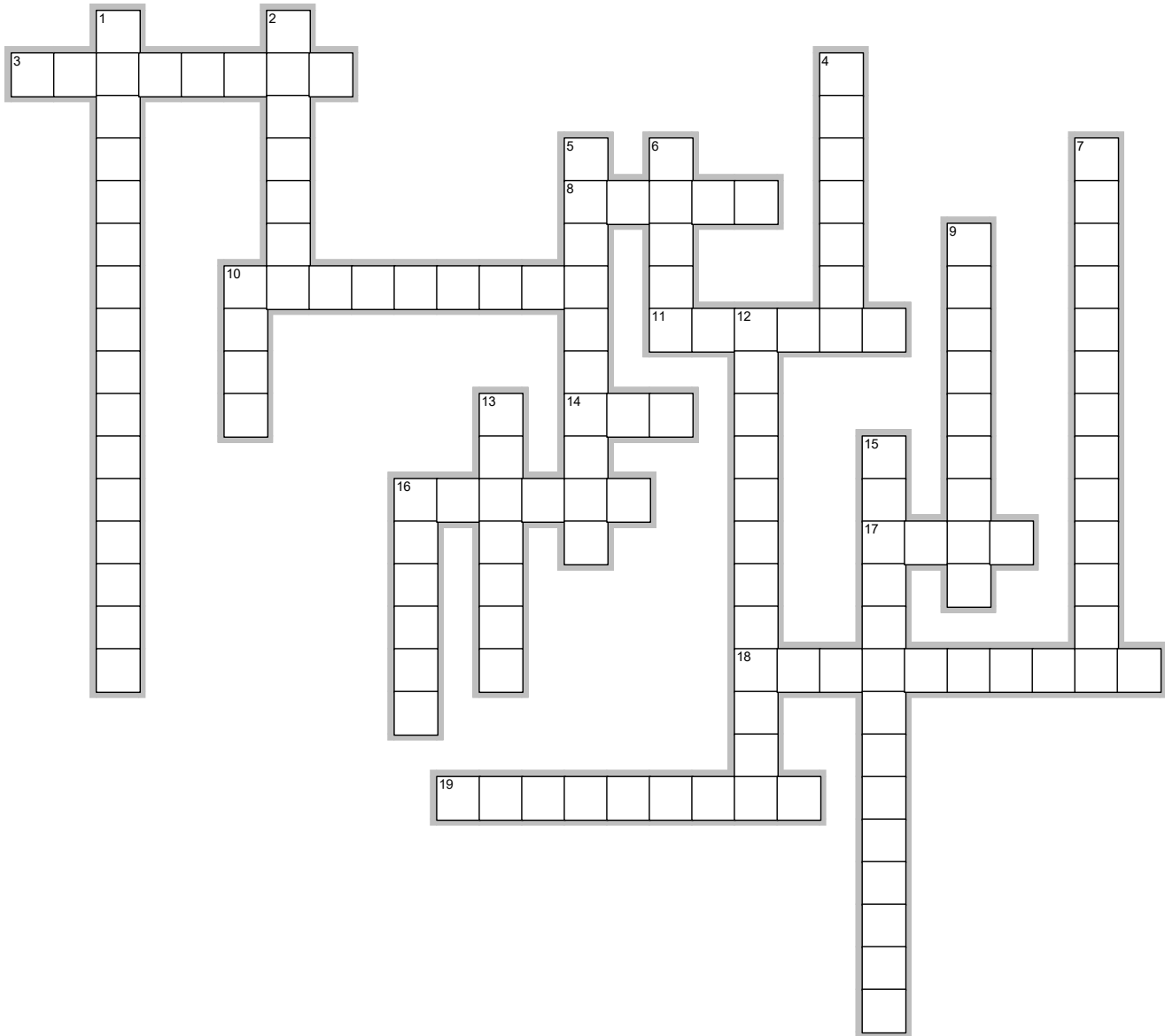

17. Most common cause of cancer death in both sexes.
