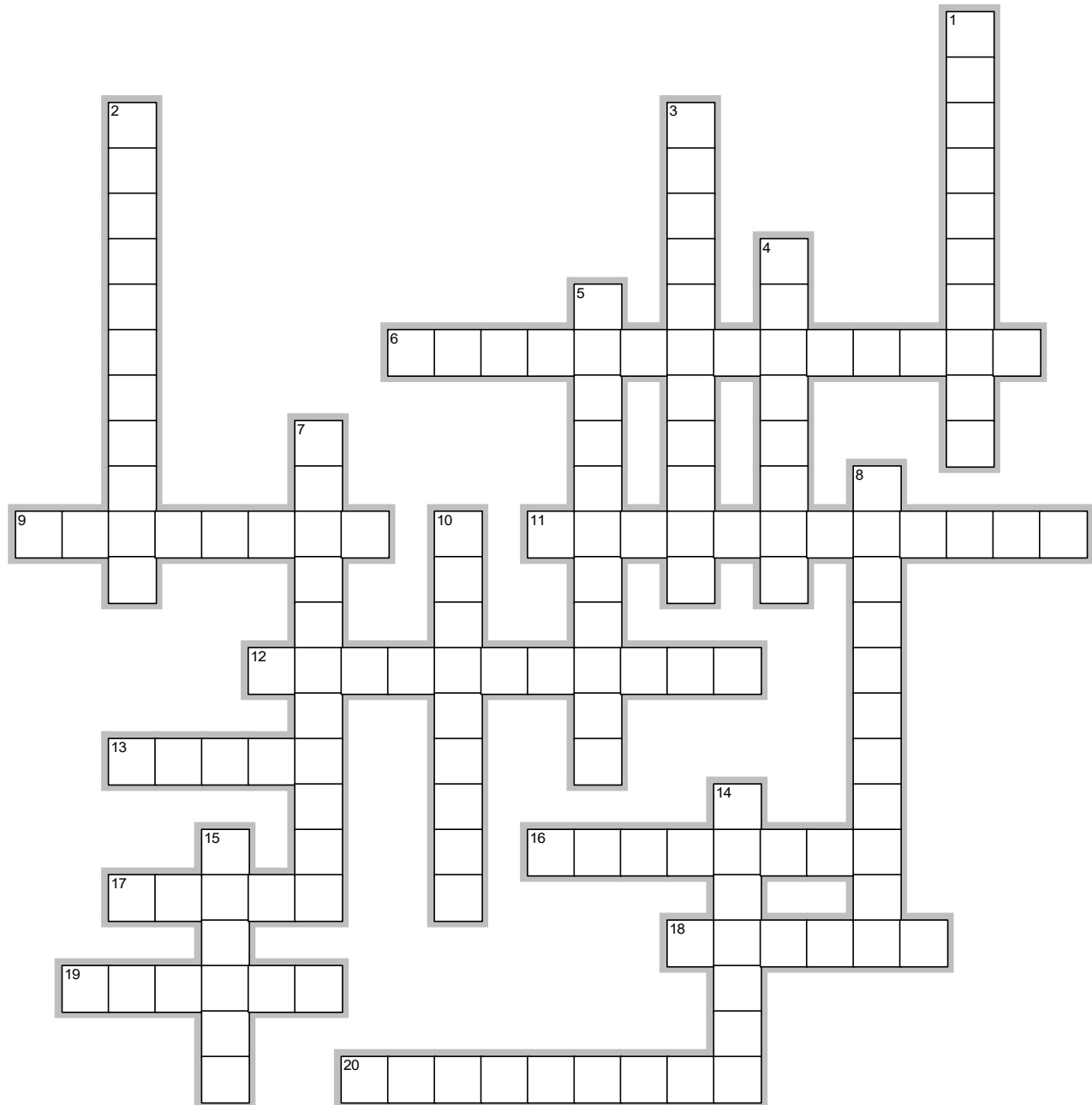

6. Can cause the urine to be brown in color.
9. A side effect to epoetin alfa.
11. Dopamine has this effect on the renal arteries.
12. Foamy urine.
13. For proper visualization during an excretory urogram this structure should be emptied.
16. Polycystic kidneys are characterized by fluid filled cysts in the epithelial of these.
17. Furosemide causes increased urine production by acting on this loop.
18. This stimulates the release of antidiurectic hormone.
19. This condition is characterized by ataxia, slurred speech, skin eruptions and tremors.
20. Released into the blood when there is muscle damage.

1. In acute glomerulonephritis, serum _____ is elevated.
2. Stimulation of this nervous system causes renal vasoconstriction.
3. Renal dysfunction can result from this.
4. Used to manage renal failure.
5. Rare autoimmune syndrome characterized by the formation of antibodies in the glomerular and alveolar basement membranes.
7. The functions of the kidneys include maintaining this balance.
8. Fungal infection associated with long term antibiotic usage.
10. Mental confusion in the elderly may be indicative of this.
14. A small amount of this in the urine is considered normal. However a high level may indicate renal damage.
15. Epoetin alfa is used to treat condition.
