## Ried Sätzen Maurerberg Wiener Gemischter Satz<sup>DAC</sup> 2019

This single-vineyard Gemischter Satz hails from a south-facing exposure in Vienna's Southwestern-most corner. With 11 grape varieties rooted in soil based on Dolomite limestone, the wine offers an elegant expression of the local terroir.
