This headlamp is also zoomable and tiltable to suit your exact visibility needs. And it can take a punch—it's made from the highest-quality, most durable materials. To top it all off, it's water-resistant.

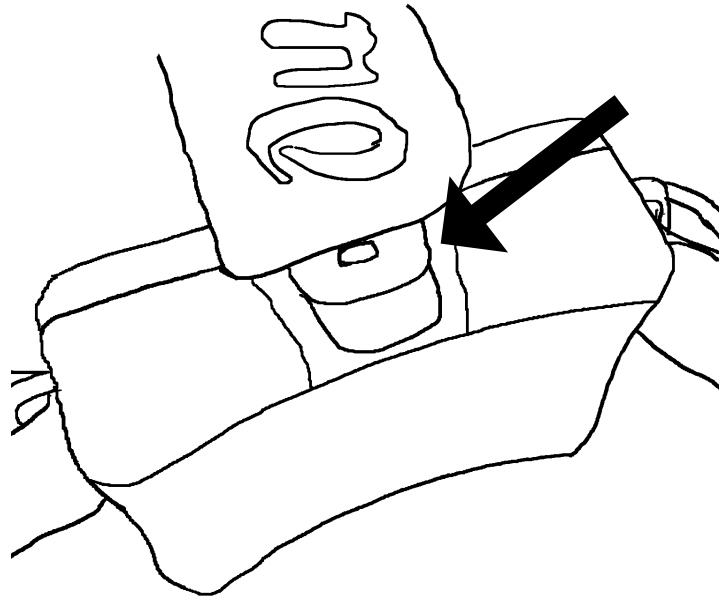

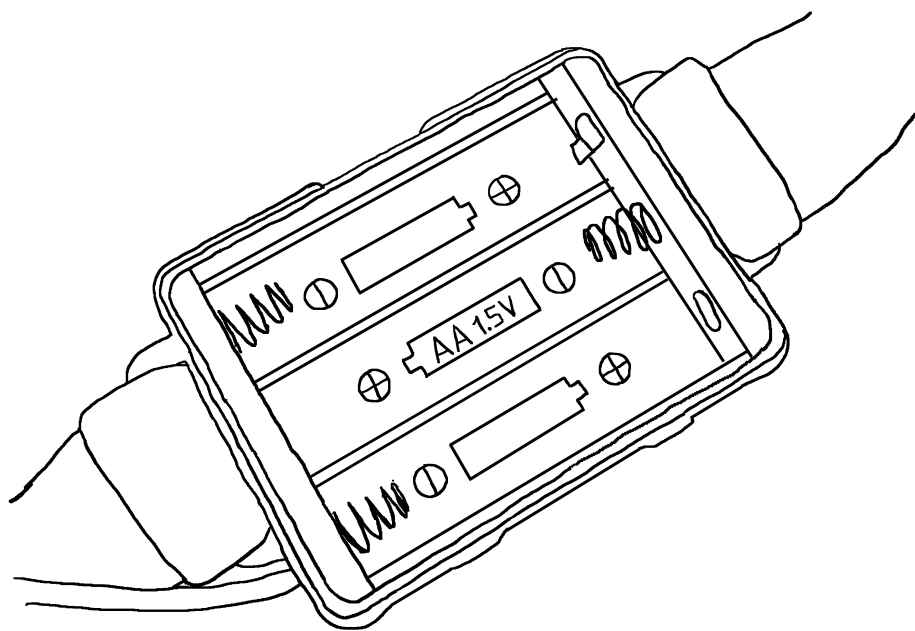
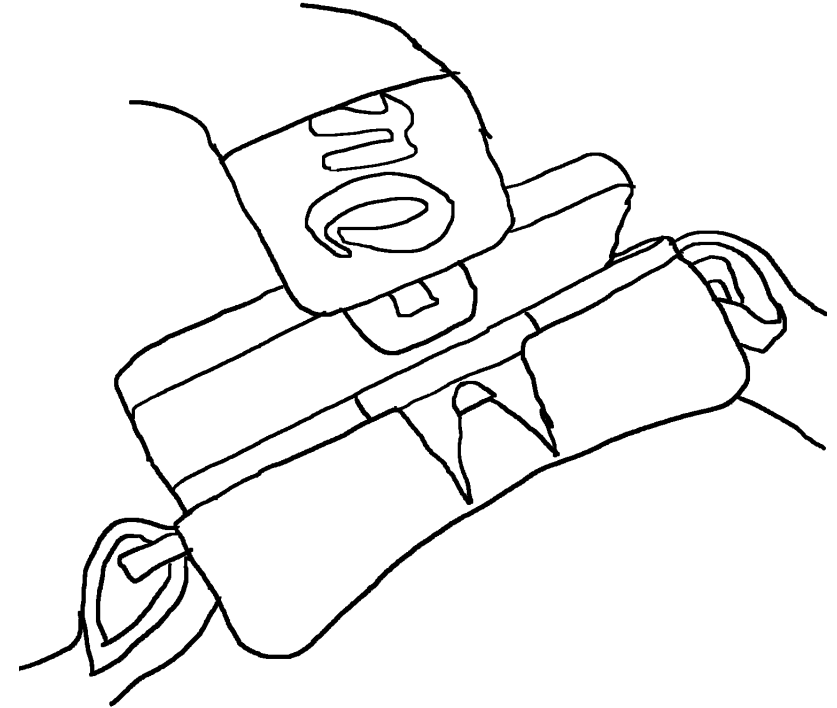


How to Insert Batteries



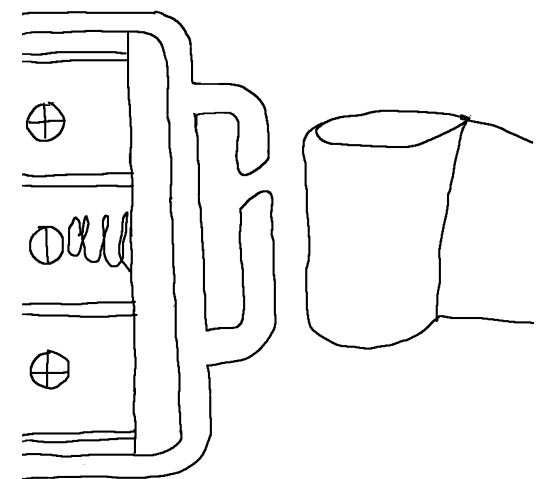
1. **Lift the top head strap. Underneath it there is a tab on the Battery Pack. Pull to unlatch the lid.**

2. **Place three **AA** batteries (regular or rechargeable) in the Battery Pack, in alternating directions (refer to the + and - symbols inside the case). Replace the lid and press firmly to lock in place.**



Important: If using rechargeable batteries, **DO NOT USE LITHIUM BATTERIES.** We recommend using Ni-MH.

3. **Note that the straps can come off and on in case one is twisted or needs to be replaced.**



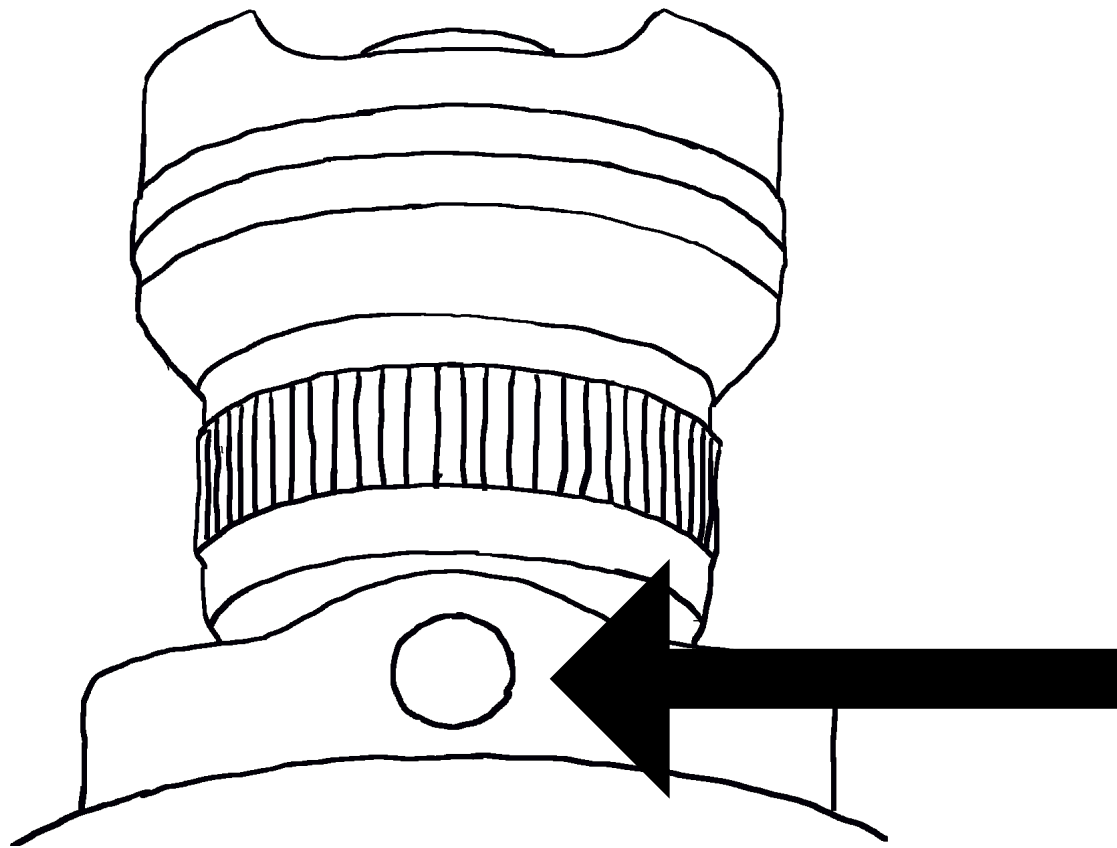
Pro Tip

Having trouble inserting the batteries? First, make sure you're using **AA batteries.**

Next, ensure that you're inserting each battery in the correct direction, according to the + and - symbols inside the Battery Pack.

How to Turn Your Headlamp On and Off



Press the On/Off/Mode Button on the top of the black Bulb Base. You will need to cycle through the High, Medium, and Low modes before you reach the Off setting.

How to Select a Mode

Continue to click the On/Off/Mode Button until you reach your desired setting. The order of the modes is: High, Low, and Strobe.

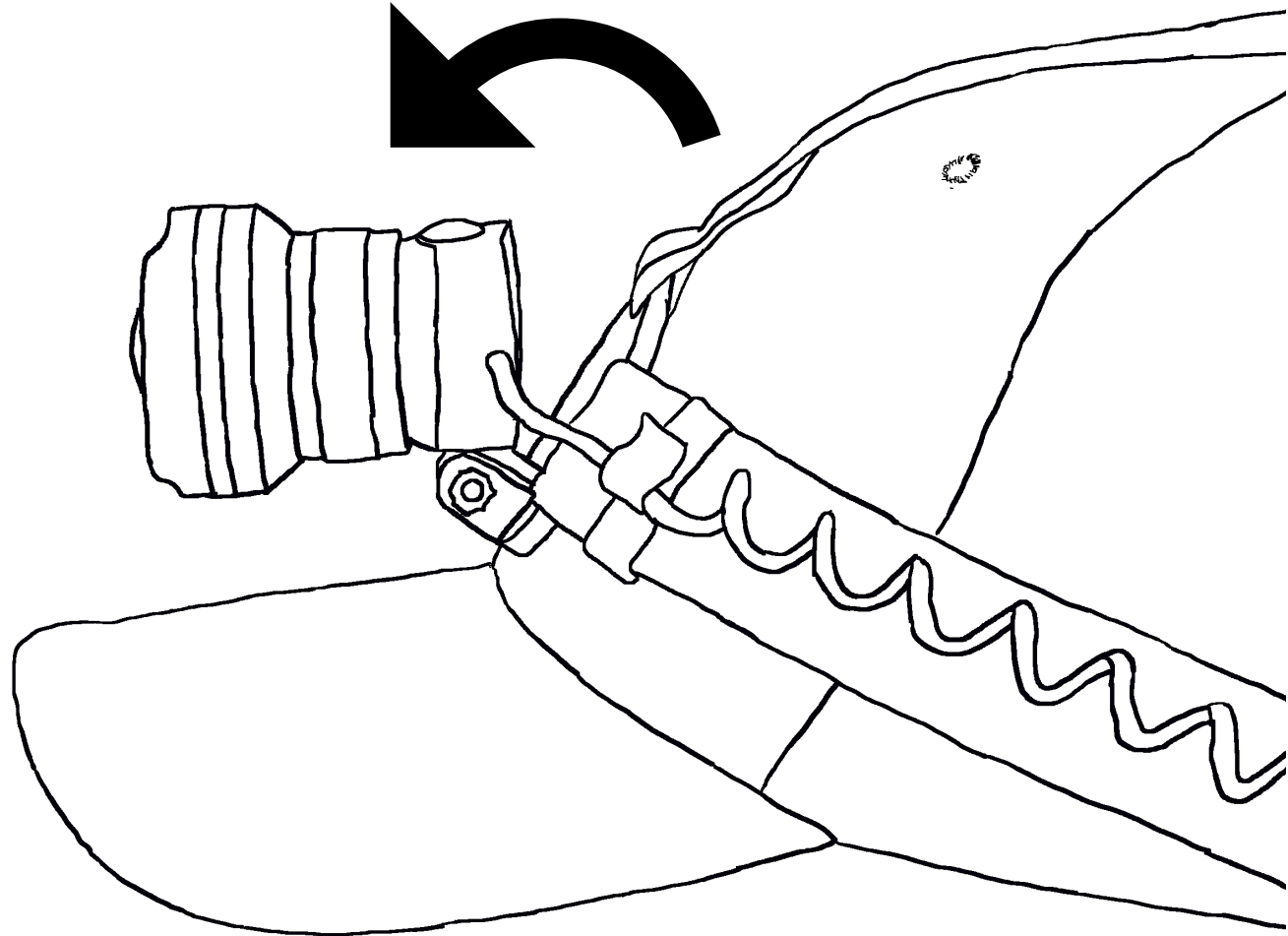


Don't be fooled by its name—the headlamp's Low mode is actually very bright.

In fact, we recommend using the Low setting most of the time, and switching to High mode when you need a jolt of super brightness. This hack will help extend your battery life.

How to Tilt

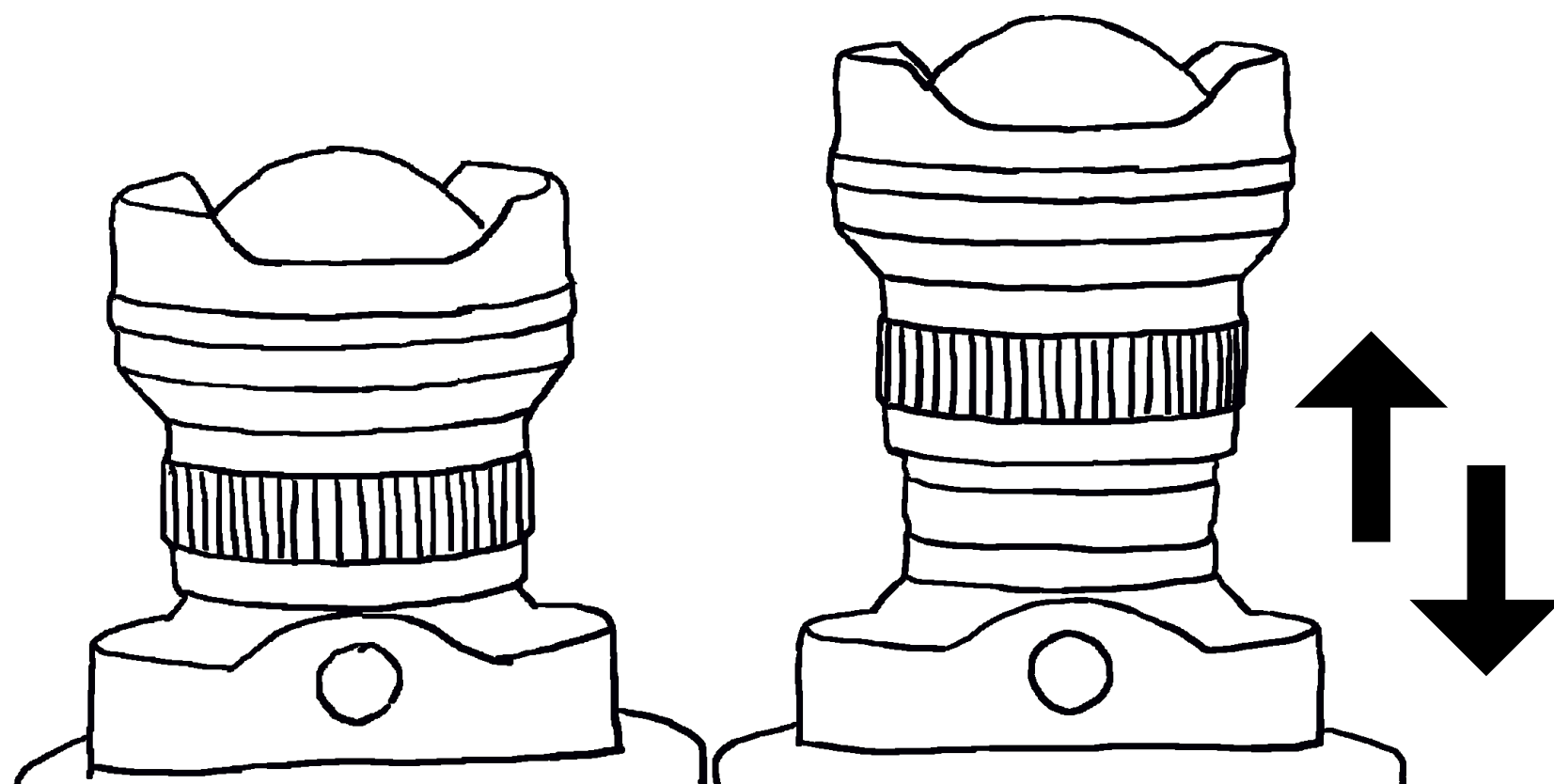
Move the Bulb Head in an upward and downward motion. The Bulb Head will tilt from its black Bulb Base.



How to Zoom

To zoom in the light, pull the Bulb Head outward, away from the black Bulb Base. To zoom out, simply push the Bulb Head back inward, toward the Bulb Base. There is no need to rotate the head.

Warning: Note that when you pull out the head of the lamp, there is an inner-cylinder under it. DO NOT rotate the inner-cylinder as it can break the wires inside the headlamp. If the inner cylinder is loose, just tighten it by hand.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Q: How comfortable is the Lighthouse Beacon 1000?

A: We've designed the LHB-1000 to be as comfy as possible. The headlamp is 6.2 ounces without batteries, and 9.6 ounces with batteries.

Q: Does it require special batteries?

A: No. The headlamp requires **three AA batteries**, either regular or rechargeable.

If you use rechargeable batteries, we recommend Ni-MH batteries. **DO NOT use Lithium Batteries.**



IDEA: To use rechargeable batteries - You can buy an external charger that plugs directly into the wall. Have 2 sets of batteries. You can have one charging while the other is in your headlamp. This way you're headlamp is always charged and ready to go! Never wait for your headlamp to charge!

“The headlamp runs on standard batteries that can be replaced. I prefer the ability to replace batteries and keep going, when a recharging station is not available.”

To extend the life of your batteries, we recommend setting your headlamp to Low mode—which is very bright on its own—most of the time.

When your batteries start to run low and the light begins to dim, switch to High mode to get a final jolt of brightness out of the batteries.

Q: Can you wear this headlamp while running?

A: Yes. We hear from many customers who run with this headlamp, whether it's on their nightly jog or in marathons and extreme races.

Q: Can you wear it with a bicycle helmet or hard hat?

A: Yes. To ensure that the headlamp stays securely in place, we recommend attaching the front and back of it to your helmet with heavy-duty fasteners.



Scotch Heavy-Duty Fasteners or Scotch Fasteners Extreme are your best bet for attaching the LHB-1000 to your helmet—they're three times stronger than regular Velcro and won't get debris in their fibers like Velcro will.

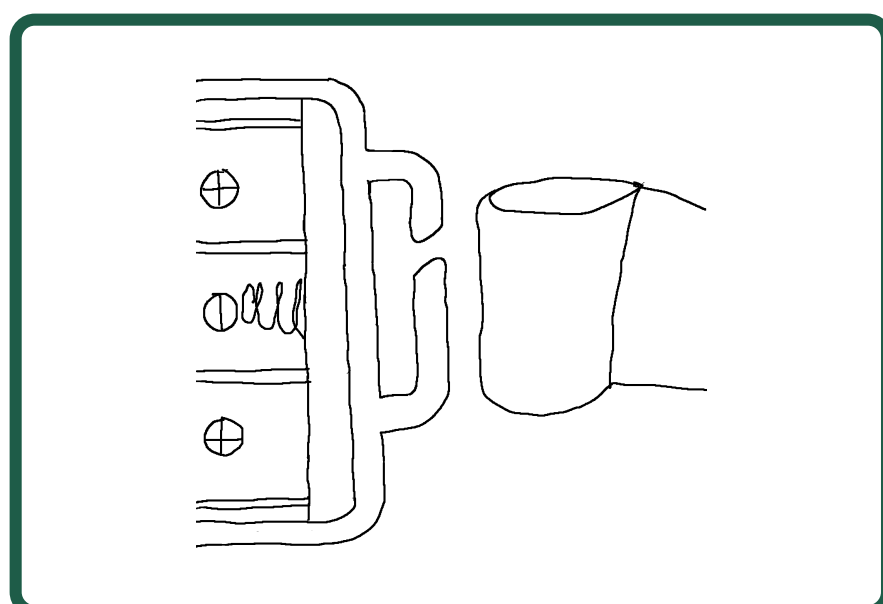
Problems?

Q: I put 3 batteries in the battery box and they won't stay in place. They rattle around. Why?

A: Take the 3-AAA batteries out that you put in. Get 3-AA batteries and put them in instead. Problem solved!

Q: One of the head-straps is sewn on and twisted. What do I do?

A: Note that the straps can come off and on. Just take it off, twist it so it is correct, and put it back on.
