FINDING THE RIGHT LOCATION

- Choose an appropriate location to display your artwork away from direct sunlight, as prolonged exposure can cause fading and deterioration of colours. We suggest hanging your art next to a window instead of directly in front.
- Keep the artwork away from heat sources and high humidity to prevent possible damage.

SECURING YOUR ARTWORK

- Hang the artwork with heavy duty wall anchors, art hangers or screws.
- We don't advise using double sided adhesive hooks or tapes as there is great risk they will not hold and you will damage your artwork.
- If placing your art on a shelf, try sticking a small piece of blu-tac behind the top corners leaning against the wall to keep things extra secure.

CLEANING

- Lightly dust the surface of the artwork with a soft duster to remove any accumulated dirt or debris. We suggest taking it off the wall before you begin.
- Don't use any liquids or sprays to clean your artwork.

HANDLING

- Always handle the artwork with clean hands or wear cotton gloves to prevent oils and dirt from transferring onto the surface.
- If you need to transport your art, make sure to wrap it securely with a piece of bubble wrap.
- Frames are fragile, so never carry them by the top. Instead support your artwork with one hand under the base or with two hands on either side.
