The journey began with Paul, who, with his father Antoine, planted their first Niellucciu vines in 1973. In 1989, Etienne took over and expanded the vineyard to 64 hectares. Nestled in the "Trà mare è monti" landscape, Clos Culombu benefits from Corsica's unique microclimate.

They cultivate 19 grape varieties, emphasizing indigenous Corsican grapes. Niellucciu and Sciaccarellu dominate red and rosé wines, while Vermentinu leads white wines. They also work with the CRVI to reintroduce forgotten grape varieties.

Clos Culombu embraced organic and biodynamic practices since 2010, earning ECOCERT organic certification in 2013 and DEMETER biodynamic certification in 2018. Their holistic approach underscores a commitment to quality, sustainability, and innovation.

In essence, Clos Culombu is a family's enduring love affair with Corsican wine, blending tradition with innovation, cherishing their terroir, and championing responsible practices. Their philosophy: stay humble, embrace diversity, and strive for excellence.














# Des Capitelles By the Laugé family Mus dis Capitelles



Mas des Capitelles, situated in AOP Faugères, covers 24 hectares and predominantly cultivates Southern grape varieties, including Carignan, Mourvèdre, Grenache, Syrah, and Cinsault. Their vineyard benefits from a unique terroir characterized by a southern exposure, dry climate, 250m altitude, slightly acidic soils, and protection from northern winds.

The domain is dedicated to organic and biodynamic practices, emphasizing sustainability and minimal intervention in winemaking. Old Carignan and Mourvèdre vines contribute to wines of exceptional quality and aging potential, with natural temperatures maintained during vinification and minimal sulfites used during aging.

Selective manual harvesting with low yields (20-30 hl/ha) and traditional vinification result in wines with remarkable aging potential, exemplified in cuvées like Vieilles Vignes, Loris, and Collection. The vineyard's foundation lies in Carignan, known for producing powerful wines expressing their terroir, while Mourvèdre adds character with notes of leather, pepper, and remarkable aging potential.

Mas des Capitelles is deeply committed to sustainability, achieving organic certification in 2011 and combining organic farming practices with biodynamics to enhance soil microbial life and prevent fungal diseases. Rooted in a family tradition for generations, the estate embodies an artisanal, family-driven, and quality-focused winemaking philosophy that carries the journey from vine to bottle.

His 4.5-hectare vineyard features various soil types, including schist, clay-limestone, sandstone, and basalt, allowing him to create a diverse range of red wines. The flagship wine, a blend of Syrah, Grenache, Carignan, and Cinsault, showcases exceptional elegance and restrained power. The estate focuses on both grape variety and geological diversity.

The vineyard's unique terroirs—represented by Cinsault, Carignan, Grenache, and Syrah—cultivated organically, play a vital role in achieving harmony and elegance in the wines. Gavin vinifies each grape variety separately, using eggshaped concrete vats and oval French oak foudres. This distinctive approach captures the region's purity, complexity, and unique character.

La Traversée, a benchmark in the sector, takes full advantage of the distinctive soils that underline its wines' quality. Gavin's expertise, tasting pleasure, and extended finish have earned this emerging estate its first star—a well-deserved accolade.

Savor La Traversée's joyful and zesty Cinsault, expresses the freshness of the 2021 vintage. The Terrasses du Larzac is an outstanding, robust wine with fine structure, silky tannins, and an enticing bouquet of floral, spicy, and aniseed notes, providing captivating complexity and remarkable length.

# Domaine **Modat**

Nestled within Cassagnes in the Agly Valley, Domaine Modat's vineyards grace an elevated plateau, ranging from 300 to 400 meters in altitude. Quentin Modat embarked on a journey to produce top-tier wines, starting with the debut vintage in 2007. The unique high-altitude terroir, predominantly composed of gneiss soils (granitic sand overlaying fractured granitic bedrock), provides the ideal conditions for crafting wines celebrated for their finesse, freshness, and elegance.

With a commitment to organic farming since 2007, Domaine Modat obtained official certification in March 2014. Quentin Modat's quest for excellence led to the cultivation of approximately ten hectares using biodynamic practices starting in 2012, with the entire vineyard transitioning to biodynamics in 2015. Vinification at Domaine Modat adheres to a philosophy of minimal intervention, emphasizing gentle extraction, utilization of native yeasts, and minimizing the application of sulfur-based inputs whenever possible.





The vineyards, exposed to South/Southeast sunlight, ensure complete grape ripening, with vines aged 30 to 70 years. Sustainable practices, including phytosanitary methods and organic fertilizers, maintain terroir authenticity, and harvesting occurs only at full grape ripeness.

Grapes, pressed immediately upon arrival, settle in tanks for 12 to 24 hours. Vinification unfolds in stainless steel tanks or 2 to 6-year-old oak barrels for 6 to 12 months, chosen based on AOC and grape richness. Natural malolactic fermentation during aging enhances aroma and structure.

Winter sees the wine resting on lees, and after a light filtration, bottling takes place between spring and the upcoming harvest, preserving the aromatic distinctiveness. Under Denis VERVIER's leadership, Domaine ROMANIN harmonizes heritage, meticulous craftsmanship, and sustainability, resulting in expressive and award-winning Burgundy wines.

# Domaine **Bersan**

Jean-François and Pierre-Louis Bersan uphold a five-century family legacy, emphasizing unwavering respect for their 20-hectare vineyard's exceptional terroirs. The estate, comprising 13 hectares of whites and 7 hectares of reds, integrates modern viticultural techniques while undergoing a transition toward organic viticulture, showcasing a firm commitment to environmental stewardship.

Their cellar, a pinnacle of precision and hygiene, features stainless steel tanks for fermentation and oak barrels for aging. Nestled within vaulted cellars from the 11th and 12th centuries, the wines mature with grace and character, earning global appreciation. With an annual production of around 120,000 bottles, nearly half are distributed internationally. Despite this, the estate remains devoted to personally hosting visitors and connoisseurs in their "caveau."

Domaine Bersan's 20 hectares of vineyards display a rich tapestry of Burgundian varietals, including Aligoté, Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, and Pinot Noir, across nearly ten distinct Burgundian appellations. Situated in Saint-Bris Le Vineux, the vineyards in the Yonne Valley boast an ancient subsoil blending clay, limestone, Portlandian, and Kimmeridgian strata. With a viticultural history spanning centuries, the vine remains central to the community's culture and prosperity, and the wines of Domaine Bersan artfully capture the essence of Burgundy's rich winemaking heritage by marrying tradition and innovation.



Domaine des Chanssaud, a family-owned vineyard since 1826, managed by Patrick Jaume since 1985, spans 46 hectares. The terroir, composed of clay, sand, and quartz-rich soil, enables optimal grape maturity. Committed to ecofriendly practices, they transitioned to organic farming in 2012 and have a modern cellar for quality vinification. A third of their Châteauneuf du Pape red wine undergoes oak barrel aging.

The estate, passed down through generations, comprises 46 hectares, 20 in Châteauneuf appellation and 26 in Côtes du Rhône. The terroir features clay, sand, and quartz pebbles from the Rhône's alluvial deposits, maintaining stable ambient temperatures for grape maturity. They've cultivated the vineyard in harmony with the environment, transitioning to organic farming in 2012.

Their modern cellar, established in 1995, ensures optimal vinification conditions, with a capacity of 2500 hectoliters for winemaking and 700 hectoliters for storage. The vineyard includes 14 hectares of Châteauneuf du Pape and 21 hectares of Côtes du Rhône, showcasing prominent grape varieties.

The former cellar has been transformed into an aging cellar and a welcoming tasting space, blending tradition and innovation. One-third of Châteauneuf du Pape red wine undergoes one year of oak barrel aging for quality control. The bottled wines are stored in a climate-controlled room until they mature.

# Domaine Chamfort
