Basic:

- 1. Side edge file guide
- 2. File
- 3. One mid-range/medium coarseness stone- ceramic or diamond
- 4. Ski specific iron
- 5. 2 vise set up
- 6. Gummi stone
- 7. Plexi wax scraper
- 8. One all around base brush, nylon
- 9. Wax; universal or hydrocarbon (CH8)
- 10. Tuning gloves- thin but tough

Intermediate:

- 1. Adjustable side edge file guide, 1* and 2* at least
- 2. 1* Base edge file guide
- 3. File
- 4. Medium and fine coarseness stones
- 5. Ski specific iron
- 6. 3 vise set up
- 7. Gummi stone
- 8. Plexi scraper and sharpener
- 9. Copper, horse hair, and nylon brushes
- 10. Wax for multiple temperature ranges, hydrocarbons i.e. CH8, CH6, etc.
- 11. Tuning gloves
- 12. Travel workbench
- 13. Large stiff paint brush to clear edge debris
- 14. Clean towel

Advanced:

- 1. Adjustable side edge file guide, 2*, 3*, (4* optional)
- 2. .5* base edge file guide, 1* base edge file guide
- 3. Coarse file and fine file
- 4. Small wire brush for cleaning files
- 5. Coarse, medium, fine, ultra fine coarseness diamond stones
- 6. Sidewall removal tool
- 7. Ski specific iron
- 8. 3 vise set up
- 9. Gummi stone
- 10. Plexi scraper and sharpener
- 11. Steel, copper, horse hair, and nylon brushes
- 12. Range of waxes; hydrocarbons for training, high and low fluorocarbon waxes for races.



- 13. Tuning gloves
- 14. Travel workbench
- 15. Large stiff paint brush to clear edge debris
- 16. Clean Towel
