

RING SIZE GUIDE

Ring measurements are very precise
Please read all instructions carefully to ensure accurate measurements



MEASURE THE BAR WITH A RULER. IT MUST BE EXACTLY 50 MM LONG

- BEFORE PRINTING, SET PAGE SCALING "NONE" ON YOUR PRINT DIALOG BOX. (TO OPEN THE PRINT DIALOG BOX, PRESS CTRL+P)
- 2. YOUR RING SHOULD BE TIGHT ENOUGH SO THAT IT WILL NOT FALL OFF, BUT LOOSE ENOUGH TO SLIDE OVER YOUR KNUCKLE
- 3. FOR BEST RESULTS MEASURE YOUR FINGER SIZE: AT THE END OF THE DAY AND WHEN YOUR FINGERS ARE WARM
- 4. THICKER RINGS (OVER 5MM IN WIDTH) WILL FIT MORE TIGHTLY
- 5. MEASURE 3 TO 4 TIMES TO ELIMINATE A WRONG READING

OPTION 1 - MEASURE YOUR CURRENT RING

- 1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger. Engagement and wedding rings are worn on the ring finger on the left hand
- 2. Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. The edges of the circle must be clearly visible INSIDE the ring
- 3. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size



MEASUREMENTS MUST MATCH THE INSIDE EDGE OF THE RING



OPTION 2 - MEASURE FINGER WITH PAPER SIZER

- 1. Carefully cut out the ring sizer below as well as the small slit at the left end of the sizer
- 2. Wrap the ring sizer around the widest part of the intended finger so that the numbers are visible to you. The widest part may be your knuckle so bear this in mind!
- 3. Insert the pointed end through the slit you made in the sizer and pull tightly
- 4. Make note of the number that lines up with the slit, this is your ring size
