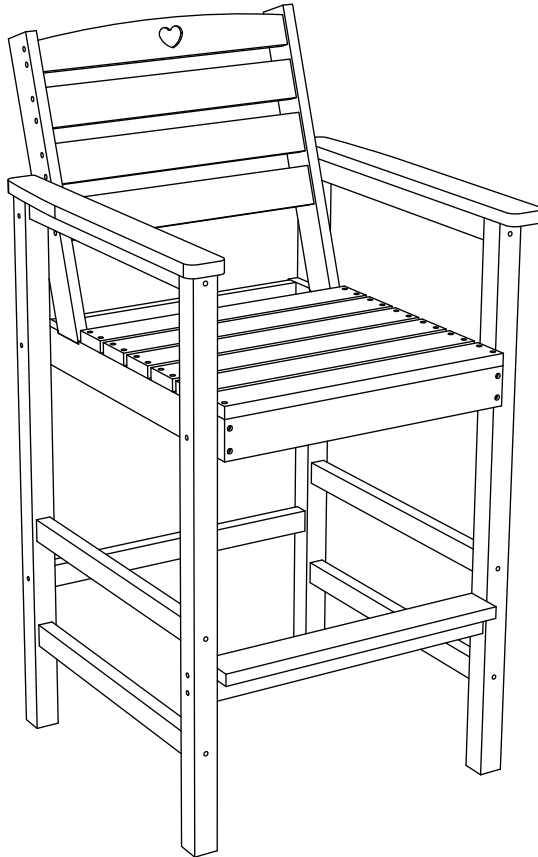

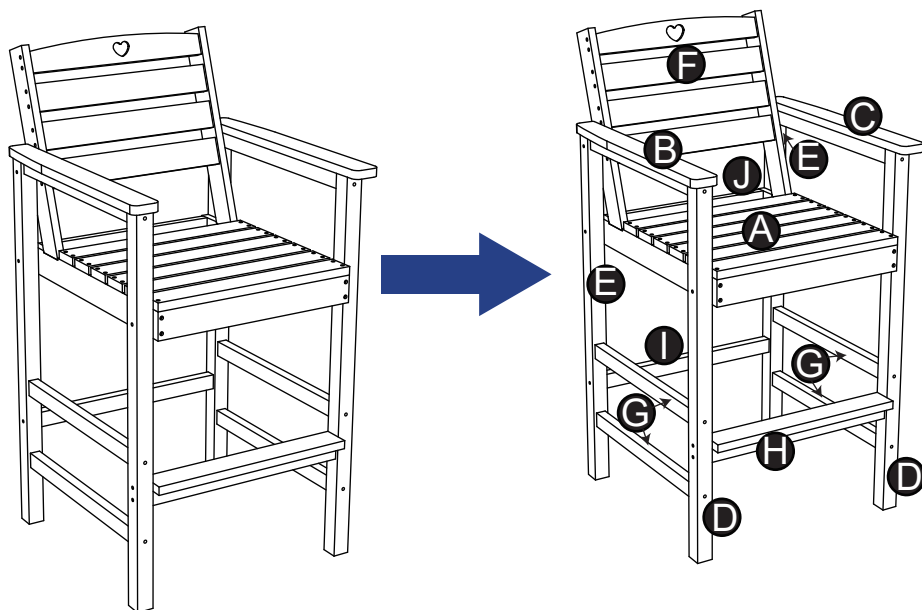
- READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE ASSEMBLING.

- PLEASE DISPOSE ALL PACKAGING AND PLASTIC BAGS.

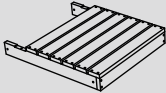
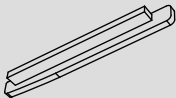
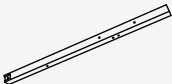
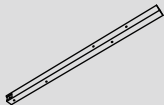
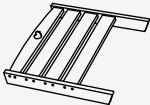
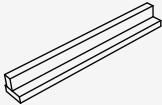
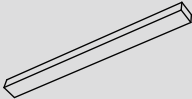
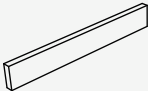

Accessory Installation Locations"

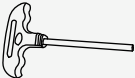

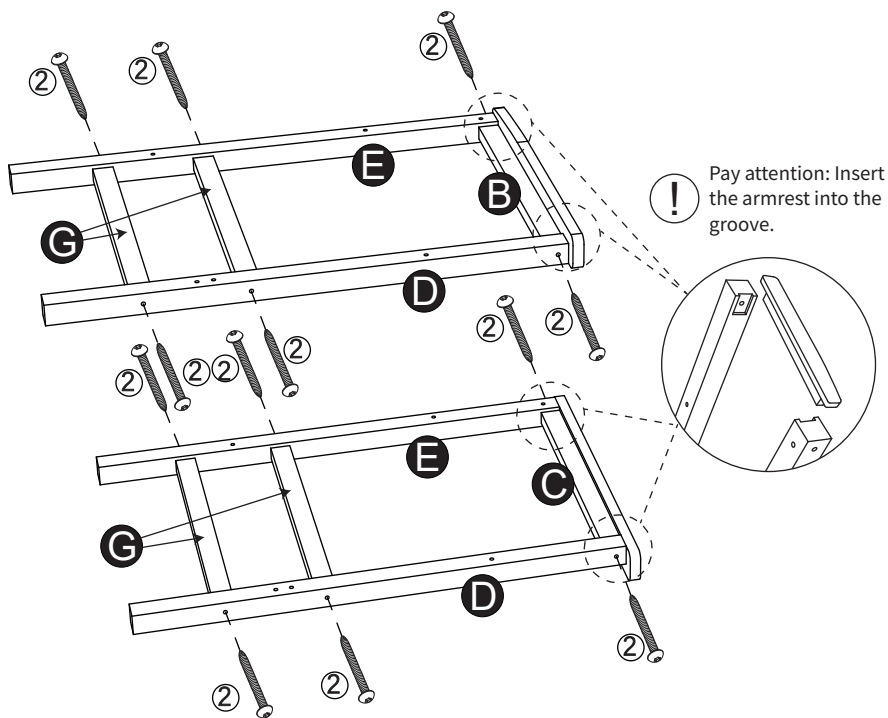
Before assembly, please review the provided diagram to understand the placement of parts.



PLEASE DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN THE SCREWS BEFORE THE CHAIR IS COMPLETELY ASSEMBLED.

Step1

Take out 'D', 'E', and 'G' as shown in the diagram. Use the allen key ⑥ to tighten and secure the screws① M6*80mm. Repeat the same step to assemble the other one. Then, according to the screw hole direction of the support legs 'D' and 'E', assemble the armrests 'B' and 'C', and tighten them with the screws① M6*80mm.

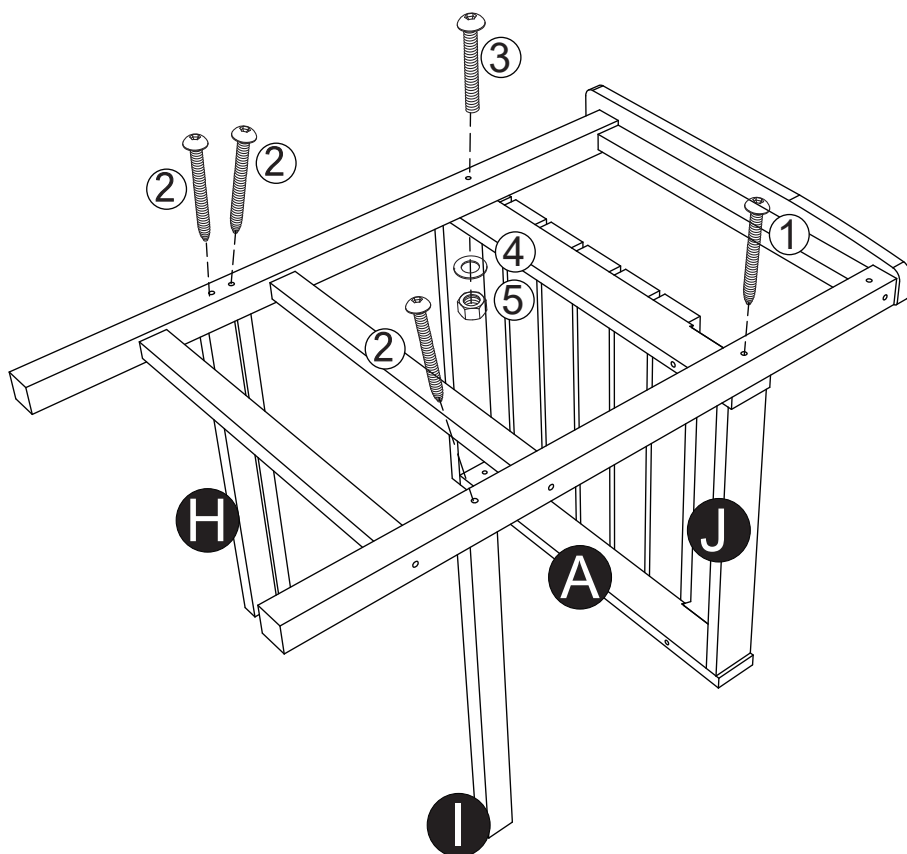




PLEASE DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN THE SCREWS BEFORE THE CHAIR IS COMPLETELY ASSEMBLED.

Step2

When installing the seat board 'A', ensure the orientation is correct and aligns with the direction of the armrests. Use the allen key ⑥ to tighten the screws ① M6*80mm and bolts ③ M6*70mm. When installing the bolts, use washers ④ and nuts ⑤. During tightening, use the wrench ⑦ to secure the nuts and prevent slipping. Install the foot bars 'H, I' underneath the support legs, and use the allen key ⑥ to tighten the screws ② M6*80mm to secure them.

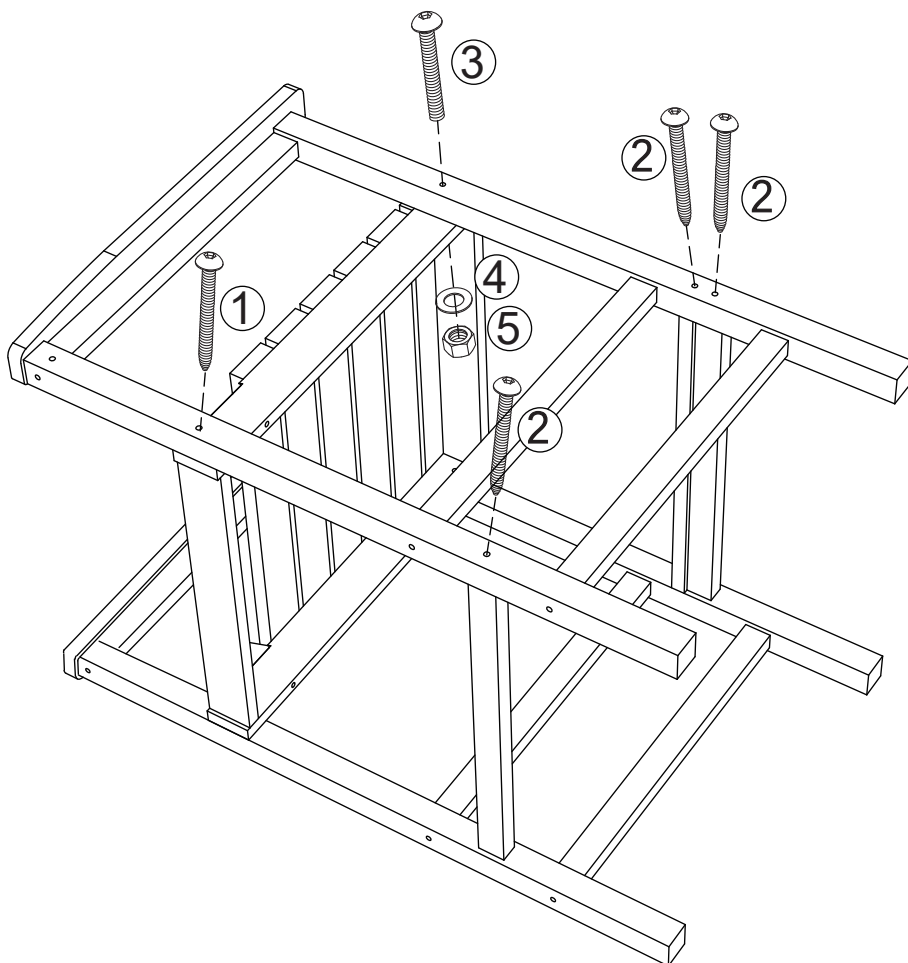




PLEASE DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN THE SCREWS BEFORE THE CHAIR IS COMPLETELY ASSEMBLED.

Step3

Repeat Step 2 to install the support leg on the other side.

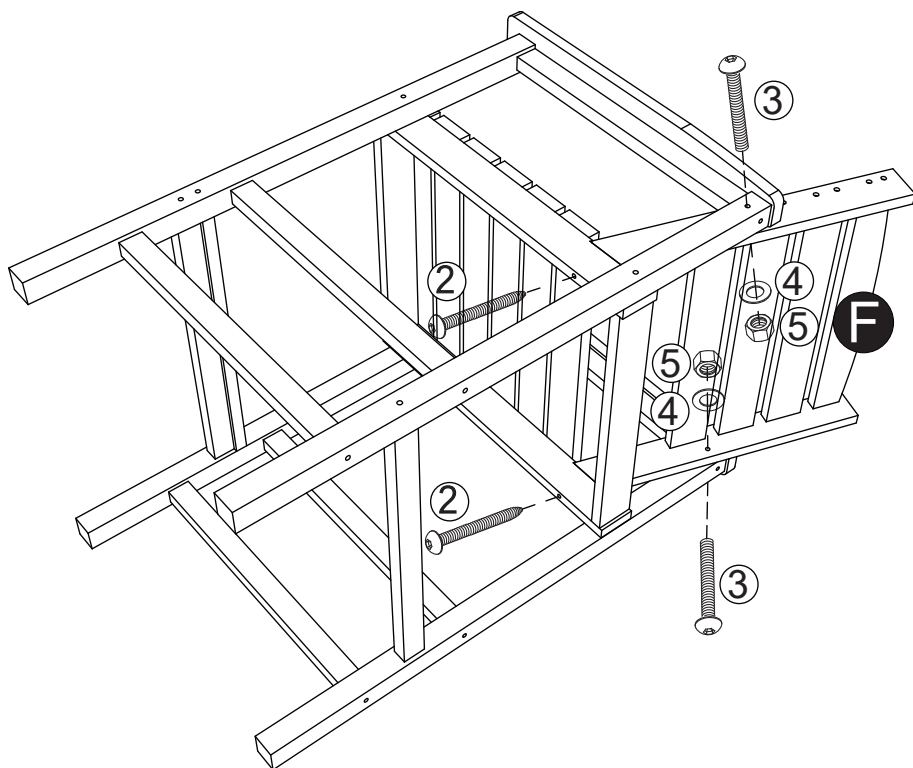




PLEASE DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN THE SCREWS BEFORE THE CHAIR IS COMPLETELY ASSEMBLED.

Step4

As shown in the image, for the final step of installing the backrest "F", you will need screws ②M6*70mm, bolts ③M6*70mm, washers ④, and nuts ⑤. When tightening the bolts with the allen key, be sure to use the wrench ⑦ to prevent slipping.

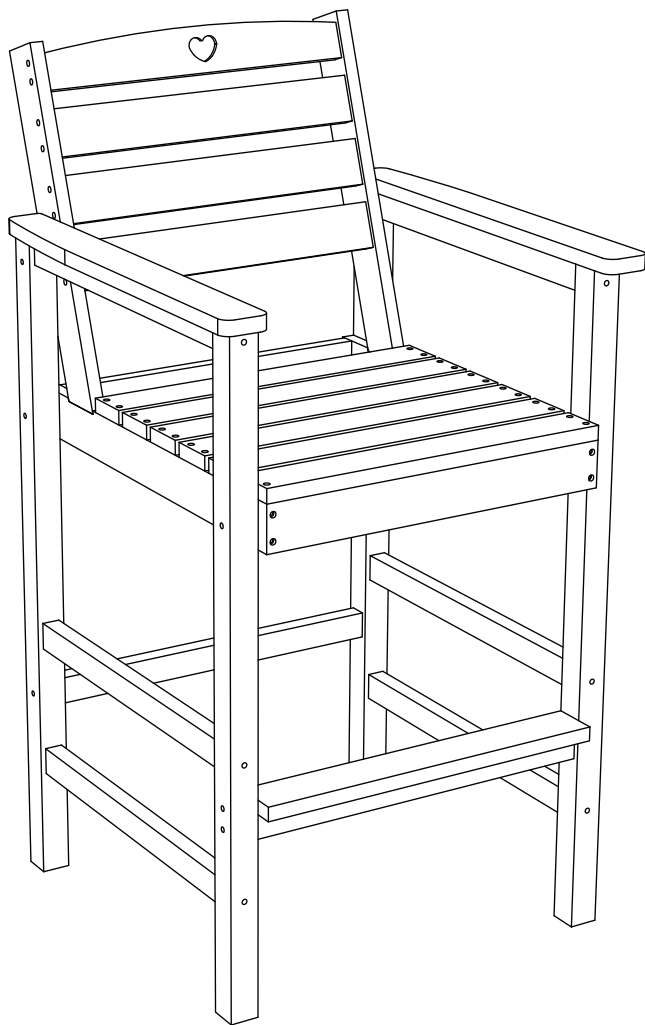
