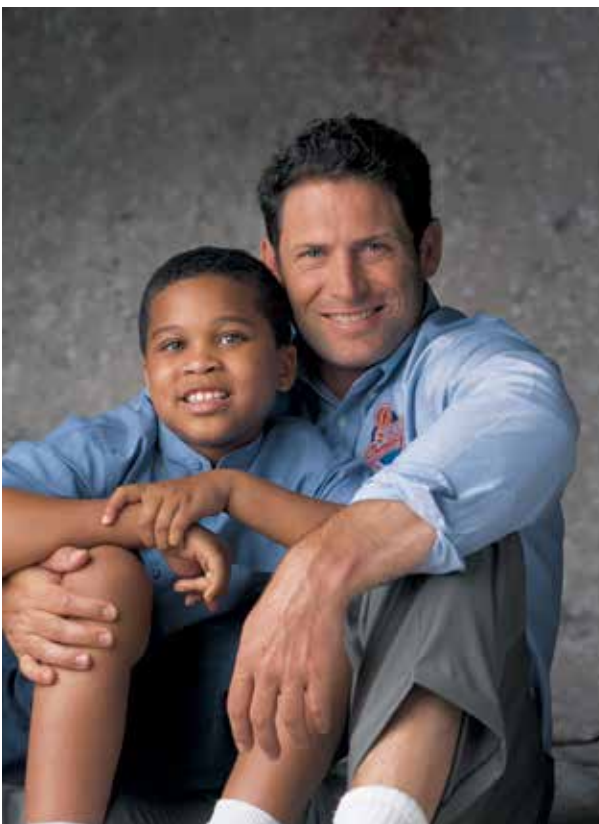

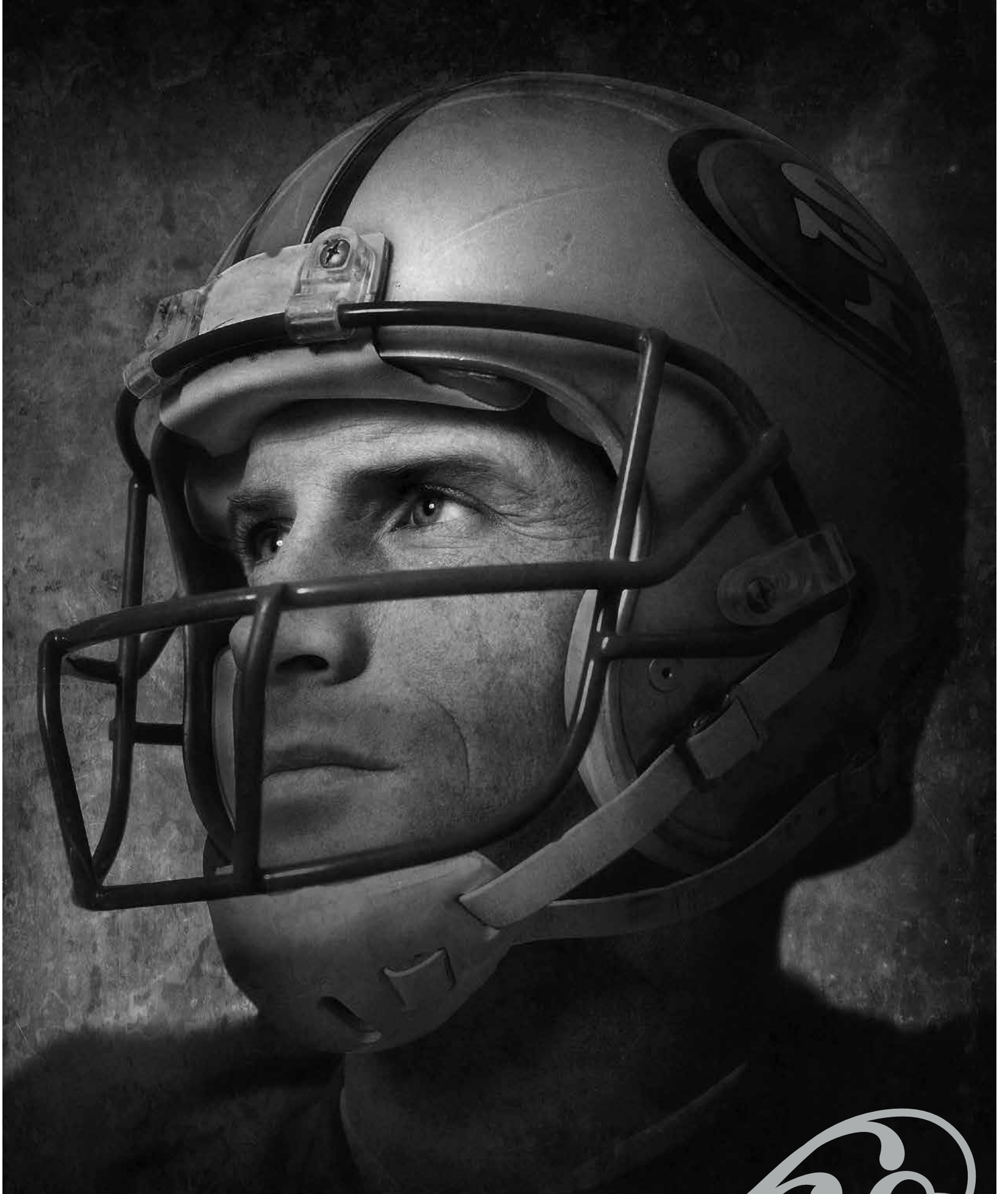

Founded in 1993 by NFL Hall of Famer Steve Young, Forever Young Foundation is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization focused on passing on hope and resources for the development, strength, and education of children. The Foundation serves children facing significant physical, emotional, and financial challenges by providing them with academic, athletic, and therapeutic opportunities currently unavailable to them. Forever Young Foundation primarily focuses its efforts in the United States and Africa.



HOSPITAL FOREVER YOUNG ZONES

are recreational rooms created to provide opportunities to exercise the imagination of seriously ill children who face emotional and physical challenges. These Zones provide a safe space where staff can build supportive relationships with children and teens to help them in their recovery. They provide a sanctuary where children working through serious illness and rigorous treatments can relax, play, and just be kids.

MULTIMEDIA FOREVER YOUNG ZONES

are spaces built with a state-of-the-art radio, TV, film, and design studio, as well as a professional-quality recording studio with isolated vocal booths and digital audio mixing boards. The goal of these Zones is to put advanced technological tools into the hands of creative young people, allowing them to develop their own artistic expression while preparing them for careers in media and design.



GIVE

In 2018, as a part of the GIVE initiative, Forever Young Institute collaborated with UServe Utah, Cicero Group, Community Foundation of Utah, Intermountain Health Care, and Martin Frey and Associates, to create Fora ~ a partnership that focuses on donor best practices training. We held our first forum in Salt Lake City in October 2018. The event brought philanthropists, foundations, and businesses together to share innovative and new practices with the funding community ~ to share what's being done on a daily basis to improve outputs and outcomes of funding dollars. It was a thought-sharing summit to help guide what we can all do to have the greatest impact on those we serve.

FOREVER YOUNG INITIATIVES

FOREVER YOUNG INSTITUTE

Forever Young Foundation has partnered with the Arbinger Institute, a leader in management training and team building, to provide a year-long training for nonprofit professionals. With a mission to inspire excellence in nonprofit leaders and to help build sustainable, efficient nonprofit organizations, Forever Young Institute instructs participants how to develop, implement, and update a one-year operating plan and a three-year long-range strategic business plan; hold themselves accountable to their contributors; and keep board members, staff, and volunteers focused on achieving results. Through underwriting from Forever Young Foundation, private donors, and corporations, this training is offered at minimal cost to nonprofit leaders seeking to ensure the sustainability of their organizations for generations to come. Since its inception in 2010, over 275 nonprofits have participated, including 25 in 2018.



ENGAGE NOW AFRICA

Forever Young's charitable efforts in Africa are administered through the African NGO, Engage Now Africa. Created by Lynette and Bob Gay in 2002, Engage Now Africa is committed to fighting poverty, illiteracy, and disease. The ENA mission is to heal, rescue, and lift those living in Africa through the funding and building of schools, microcredit loans, and providing humanitarian assistance.

Forever Young Foundation and Engage Now Africa are empowering Africans to address their challenges with sustainable solutions.





SOPHIE'S PLACE

is a dedicated music therapy space built in children's hospitals ~ providing treatment for young people suffering from pain, chronic illness, and serious injury. While most people know music has an extraordinary power to bring comfort and peace to the soul, clinical studies have proven that music therapy offers a new evidence-based, integrative medical approach in treating young hospital patients.

8 TO 80 ZONES

are a collaborative effort between Steve Young and Jerry Rice to provide youth living in underserved communities the skills to pursue careers in technology and media. 8 to 80 Zones not only allow for artistic expression but also afford students the opportunity to gain training on industry standard equipment in the areas of television, radio, voice recording, and graphic design. These Zones also provide additional fundraising opportunities for each center.
