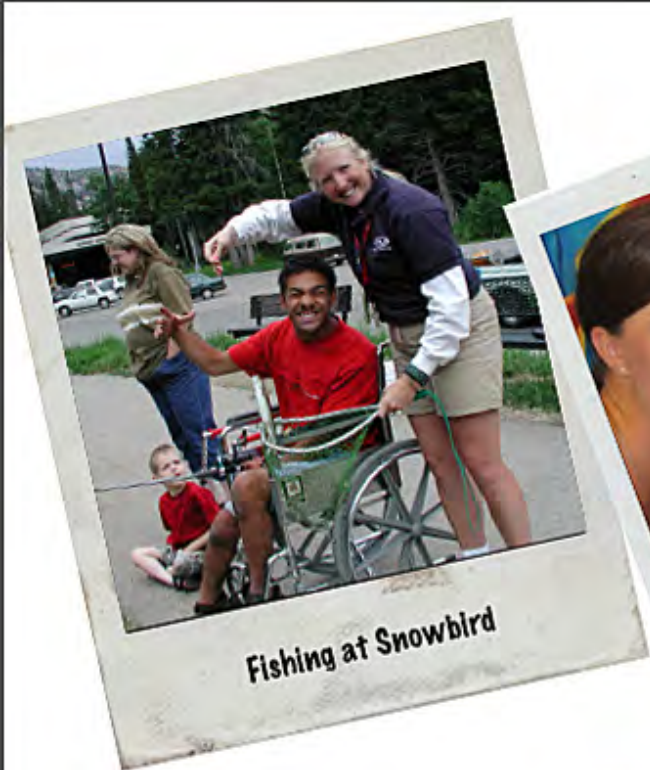

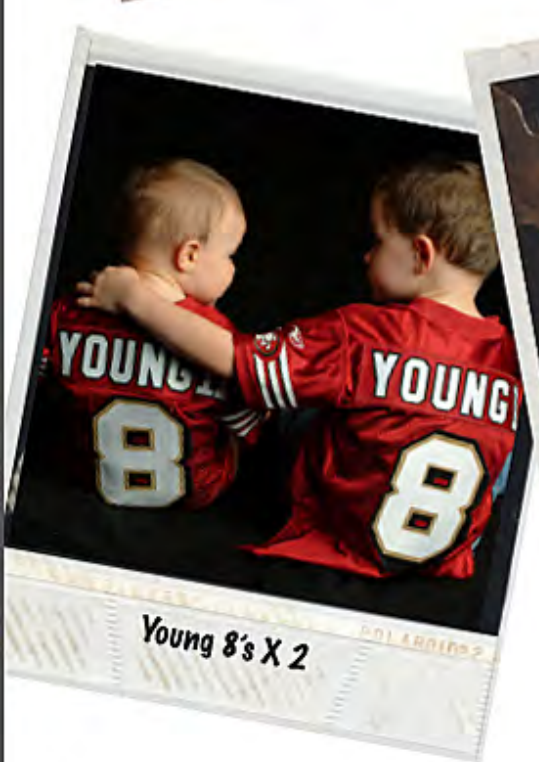

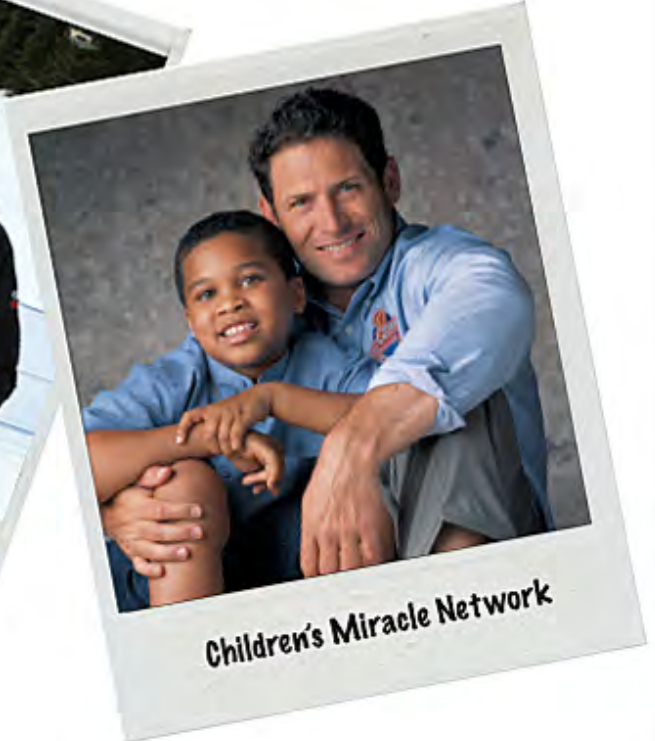

With the opening of our first Sophie's Place, patients at Primary Children's Hospital have been entertained by Chester Bennington, band members from Linkin Park and Stone Temple Pilots, Imagine Dragons, and many other local artists. The demand for music therapy by the medical staff and children seeking care at PCH has been great, and the program has doubled in size since we opened our doors six months ago.

We invite you to look through this annual report and join Forever Young Foundation in celebrating 20 years of accomplishments made possible with your help. As our team works to support and enhance our diverse FYF family of charities, our outreach has grown through our newest initiative, Sophie's Place. These are special spaces created in children's hospitals where life-changing treatment is prescribed to children using music therapy. Our partnership with The Taylor Family Foundation has taken music therapy on the road as well, through our mobile Sophie's Place van. It serves children in long-term healthcare facilities where the need for specialized programming is great but often cost prohibitive. Sophie's Place will be expanding from Primary Children's Hospital into Cardon Children's Medical Center, Sutter Children's Center, and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital Stanford in the near future.

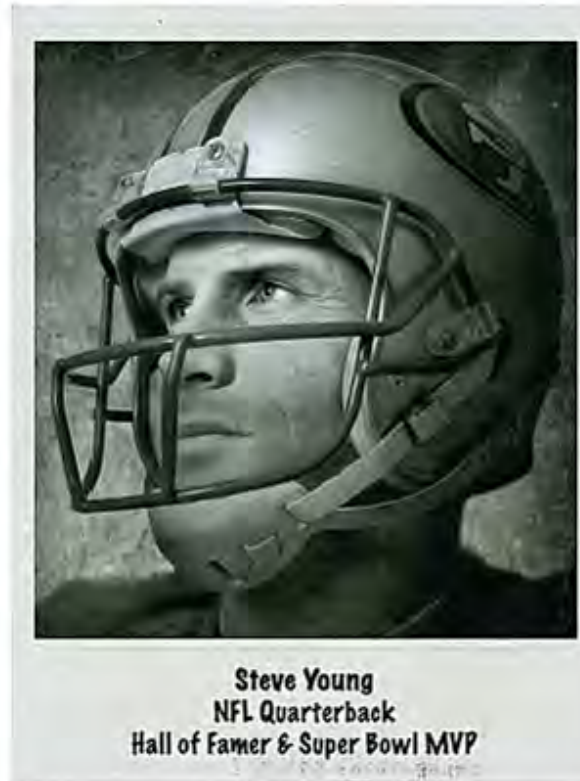
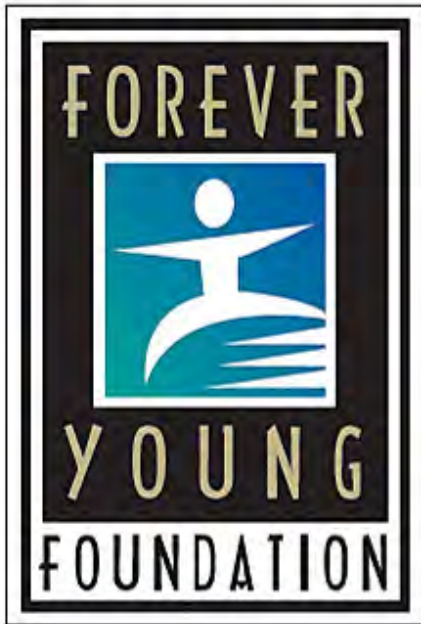

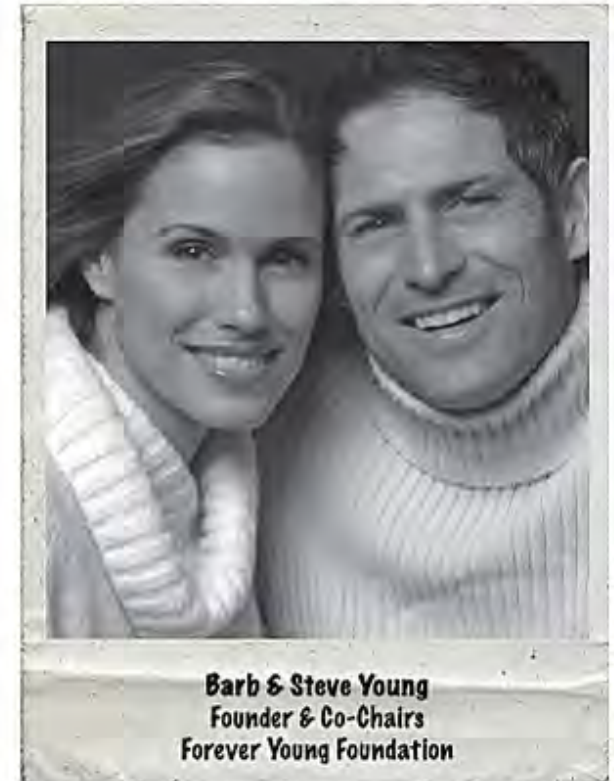

Forever Young Foundation's primary development focus continues to be in Northern California, Arizona, Utah, and Africa. The Foundation's efforts include the creation of Forever Young Zones, which provide technology and multimedia labs in NFL YET Centers as well as state-of-the-art interactive play areas in children's hospitals. Our newest initiative, Sophie's Place, creates music-therapy facilities in children's hospitals. Through music and the playing of instruments, these rooms will assist in treatment and care for young people suffering from chronic illness, brain trauma or serious injury.

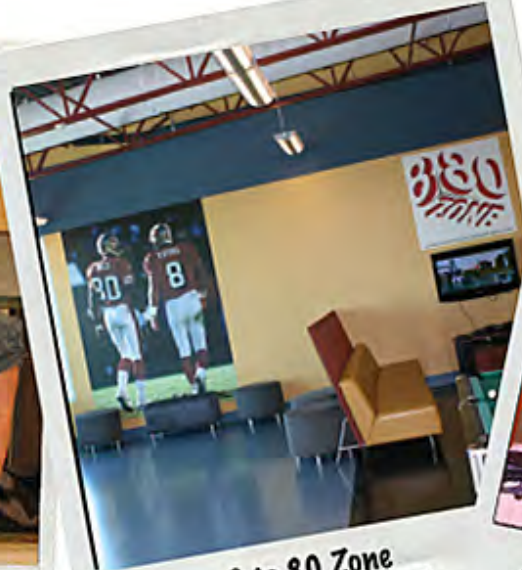

MULTIMEDIA ZONES

Multimedia Forever Young Zones provide a state-of-the-art radio, TV, film and design studio, as well as a professional-quality recording studio with an isolated vocal booth and digital audio mixing. This multimedia equipment and programming will enable youth to develop diverse, high-level communication skills, while training on professional equipment. The goal of these zones is to put technological tools into the hands of creative young people, allowing them to explore and prepare for careers in media and design while developing practical production and copy through their own artistic expression.

HOSPITAL ZONES

Hospital Forever Young Zones are recreational-therapy rooms created to provide tools for exercising the imagination of seriously ill children who face emotional and physical challenges. Forever Young Foundation has three Zones in the following children's hospitals: Primary Children's Hospital in Salt Lake City, Utah; Lucile Packard Children's Hospital in Palo Alto, California; and Cardon Children's Medical Center in Mesa, Arizona. These Zones provide a safe place where staff can build supportive relationships with children and teens to help them in their recovery processes. They provide a sanctuary where children working through serious illness and rigorous treatments can relax, play, and just be children.

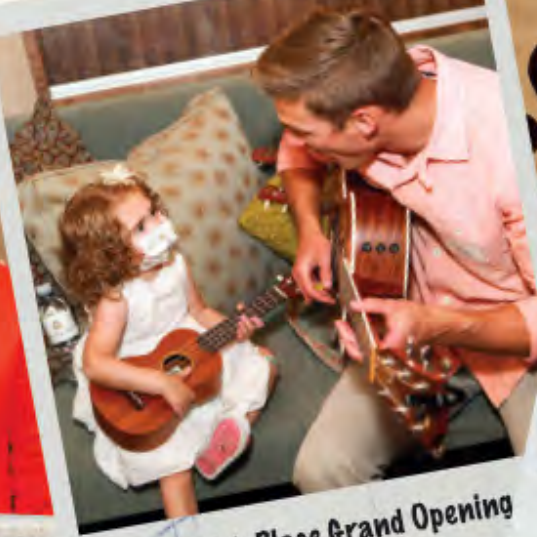

Wasatch Adaptive Sports

In 1986, Steve Young and Wasatch Adaptive Sports held the first Steve Young Ski Classic. This year marked the 27th annual event. Steve and other celebrities ski with the children to raise funds for the year-round activities the program provides.

Wasatch Adaptive Sports is a premier ski and summer program for children with special needs. They offer ski lessons, snowshoe tours, and sledge hockey throughout the winter, and numerous outdoor recreational activities such as hiking on barrier-free trails, fishing, biking, tram rides, and environmental awareness programs in the summer. Participation in these activities enhances the physical and mental health of the children served, improves their self-image, lessens depression, and allows them the opportunity to just have fun!

With the aid of the Forever Young Foundation, the Wasatch Adaptive Sports program gave 1,950 lessons to special-needs children in both the summer and winter. At least 90 percent of the lessons provided by Wasatch Adaptive Sports are offered via full or partial scholarship.
