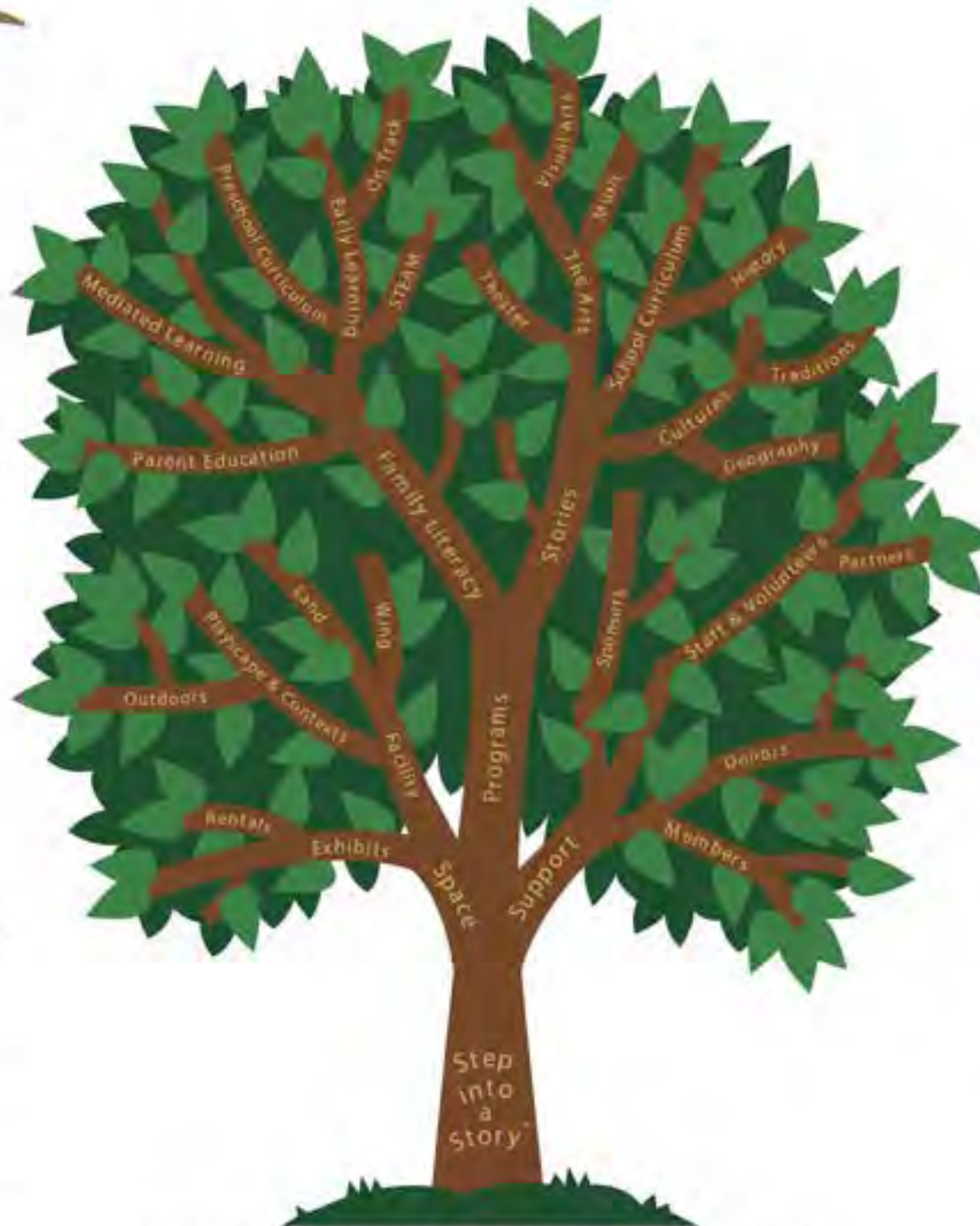

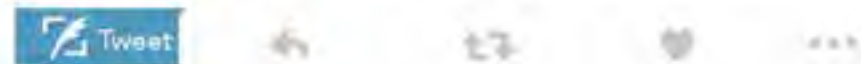

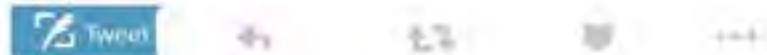

Founded in 1993 by Hall of Famer and Super Bowl MVP Steve Young, Forever Young Foundation is a nonprofit, 501(c)(3) organization that serves children facing significant physical, emotional, and financial challenges. Funds raised further our efforts to provide academic, athletic, and therapeutic opportunities currently unavailable to these children.

Forever Young Foundation's primary development focus continues to be in Northern California, Arizona, Utah, and Africa. The Foundation's efforts include the creation of Forever Young Zones and 8 to 80 Zones, which provide technology and multimedia labs as well as state-of-the-art interactive play areas in children's hospitals. Sophie's Place creates music therapy facilities in children's hospitals. Through music and the playing of instruments, these rooms assist in treatment and care for young people suffering from chronic illness, brain trauma, or serious injury.

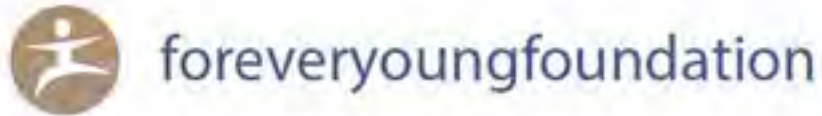
