

USE AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR BALLISTIC PANELS

- 2. Wash panel with a sponge or cloth using a mild soap
- 3. Wipe with clean water using a sponge or cloth
- **4.** Make sure panel is completely dry before using
- **5.** Do not submerge panel in any type of liquid
- 6. DO NOT DRY CLEAN OR BLEACH

STORAGE

Proper storage of your soft armor panels is essential to maintaining their life throughout the warranty period. Store your vest laying flat in a clean and dry area at normal room temperatures. DO NOT fold or crease your armor. DO NOT store your vest in the backseat or trunk of a vehicle. Keep your vest out of direct sunlight.
