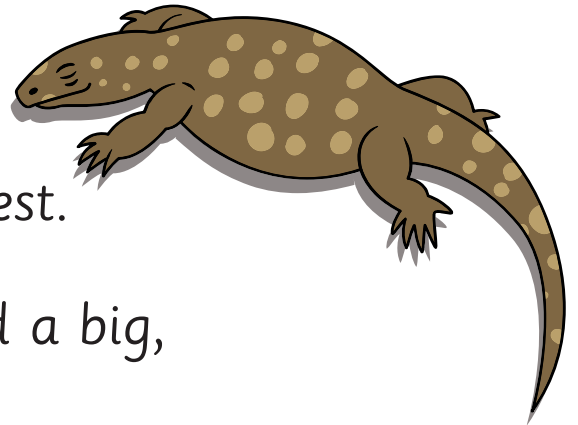

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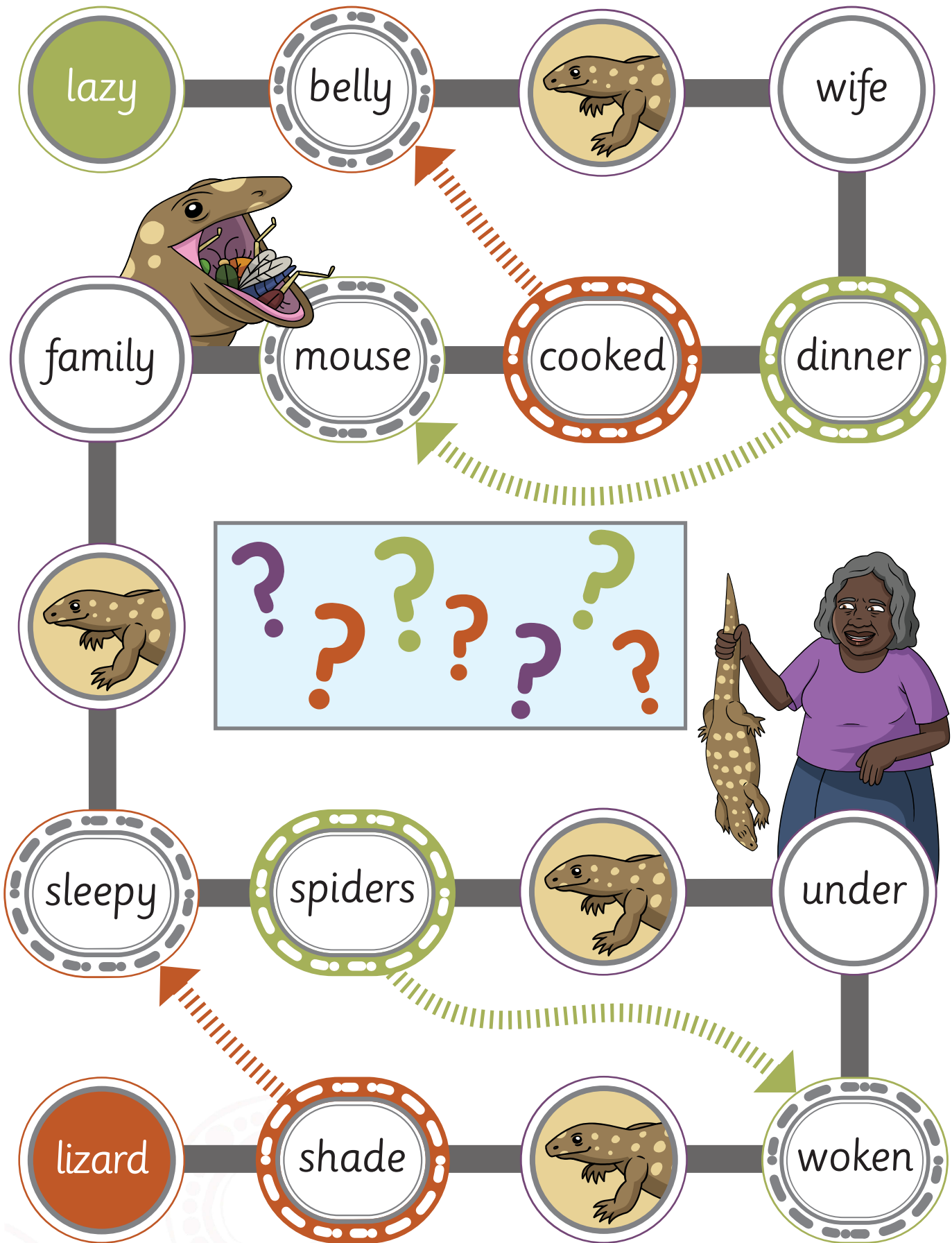

**Materials:** 1 die, player tokens, game board, cards
