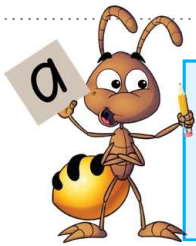

The old blue bike – snakes and ladders



Materials: 1 die, player counters, game board

Instructions: Players put their token on the start. They take turns to roll the die and move forward spaces, saying each word as they pass. Go up the ladders and down the snakes when landed on.

Variation: If a player lands on a ladder, they read the word, say a rhyming word and go up the ladder.
