We hereby state that, We are familiar and well versed with the concept of electronic voting system as prescribed under the said Rules.

The Management of the Company is responsible to ensure compliance with the requirements of (i) the Companies Act 2013 and the rules made thereunder and (ii) the SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015, ("LODR") relating to e-voting on the resolutions contained in the Notice calling the Annual General Meeting.







- 2 Our responsibility as scrutinizer for the e-voting facility both for e-voting prior to the AGM (remote e-voting) and voting at the AGM by electronics means (e-voting) is restricted to make scrutinizer's report of the votes cast "in favour" or "against" the resolutions stated below, based on the reports generated from the e-voting system provided by M/s.
