



THE BARTONDALE SPIKE CABERNET SAUVINGON

COLOR:

Deep red with purple hues

NOSE:

Dark, bold, and ripe. Driven by a multitude of currant fruits and spices. Great power and longevity to this wine. Very seductive and certainly not for the fainthearted. Finishing with subtle coffee and mocha tannins.

PALATE:

An outstanding combination of fine black forest fruits and tannins balances with the fruit acid in perfect harmony. A wine of concentrated power that leaves a rich, juicy, dry mouthfeel.

VINTAGE:

The 2018 vintage was one of the greatest on record. The few hot days allowed fruit to achieve excellent flavours with a good balance of acidity. The reds are robust and powerful, with great depth of colour and rich tannins with ripe, full flavours.

WINEMAKING:

The longest vintage many have experienced is late ripening due to the cool climate
