

All, I have just posted a document from the Claims Officer Gary Suoja. This is concerning the Sultan River Claims. If you have equipment down on the Sultan and it is not operational it needs to be repaired or removed. We are also going to be changing our lock on the gate at Sultan Basin Road next month. IMPORTANT NOTICE!

SULTAN RIVER LOCK CHANGE January 2024

THE LOCK ON THE SULTAN RIVER GATE WILL BE CHANGED AS WEATHER PERMITS BY JANUARY 31, 2024. YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO TURN IN OLD KEY AND CLAIM PACKAGE ON OR BEFORE MARCH 31 OR THE FIRST SCHEDULED WORK PARTY ON THE CLAIM AND IF YOU DO NOT YOU WILL

FORFEIT YOUR \$50.00 DEPOSIT. WE WILL BE RENEGOTIATING AN ACCESS AGREEMENT WITH DNR AND BLM TO THE RIVER CLAIMS. CURRENT AGREEMENT IN YOUR PACKAGE EXPIRES MARCH 2024. WE WILL NEED TO HAVE CLAIMS CLEANED OF DEBRIS TO RENEGOTIATE. 1. THERE WILL BE "TRASH" REMOVAL OF ALL DREDGE COMPONENTS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT AND ALL OTHER MINING EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS LEFT IN, ON OR NEAR THE RIVER AFTER LOCK CHANGE. ANYTHING LEFT WILL BE CONSIDERED ABANDONED AND TREATED AS "TRASH" OR WPMA PROPERTY TO BE JUNKED, TOSSED, REMOVED OR SOLD. 2. IF YOU HAVE A CURRENTLY ISSUED KEY AND EQUIPMENT ON THE RIVER YOU WILL NEED TO REMOVE IT BEFORE LOCK CHANGE OR REGISTER THE EQUIPMENT AND MATERIAL WITH THE CLAIMS MANAGER IN WRITING - SPECIFYING THE EQUIPMENT AND ITS LOCATION. ANYTHING REGISTERED BUT NOT LOCATED WHERE INDICATED IS SUBJECT TO #1 ABOVE. 3. THE PURPOSE OF THIS ACTIVITY IS TO CLEAN UP CLAIM SITES AND ARRANGE ANOTHER 5 YEARS OF ACCESS. BECAUSE OF THE LOCK CHANGE YOU WILL LOSE ACCESS TO THE SITE AND YOUR EQUIPMENT UNLESS YOU ACT.

NEW KEYS: BECAUSE OF THE NEED FOR WORK ON TRAILS, ACCESS ROAD AND TRASH PICKUP - OBTAINING A NEW KEY WILL REQUIRE PARTICIPATION AT A WORK PARTY IN THE SPRING. THE WPMA WILL TRY TO MANAGE AT LEAST 3 WORK PARTIES BEGINNING IN LATE MARCH OR APRIL 2024 ON THE SULTAN CLAIMS. KEYS WILL ONLY BE ISSUED AT THE END OF A WORK PARTY. NO WORK - NO KEY. REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF KEYS WILL BE SIMILAR TO CURRENT REQUIREMENTS AND SUBJECT TO FINAL NEGOTIATIONS WITH BLM AND DNR. IN ADDITION, THERE IS CONSIDERATION OF INSURANCE REQUIREMENT FOR A HELICOPTER LIFT OUT IN THE EVENT A MEMBER IS INJURED, ILL OR OTHERWISE UNABLE TO GET OUT OF THE CLAIM. THE INSURANCE BEING NEGOTIATED IS APPROXIMATELY \$75 PER KEY HOLDER AND IS GOOD ONLY FOR THE MEMBER PURCHASING. WE WILL HAVE MORE DETAILS TO COME.
