To make your egg hunt safe for kids with

Food Allergies and other dietary restrictions, take these steps to include everyone:



- Don't use hard-boiled eggs or confetti-filled eggs if there's a chance someone with an egg allergy will participate.
- · Get little toys instead of (or in addition to) candy
- Make sure ingredient labels are available for any candy you do include
- Color-code your plastic eggs so kids with allergies know which ones are safe. Use eggs that are

- Tell kids to hunt for their own special color of eggs. Ask parents to help keep things fair.
