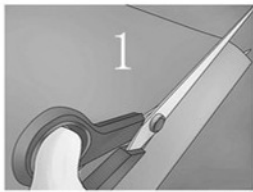


5 STEPS TO MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE



STEP 1:

Cut a strip of paper or a piece of string. The paper should be approx 1cm wide & 12 cm long.



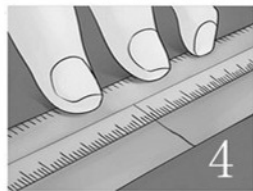
STEP 2:

Wrap the paper or string around the finger to be sized, slide the paper or string up to the knuckle, as the ring must be sized large enough to be able to slip off & on, over the knuckle.



STEP 3:

Use a pen to mark the paper or string where the long end overlaps.



STEP 4:

Measure the mark from the end of the length of paper or string with a ruler. Use the metric side for more accurate sizing.



STEP 5:

Locate the ring size by locating your measuring on the sizing chart below. If the measurement falls in between two sizes, it's recommended you choose the larger size.

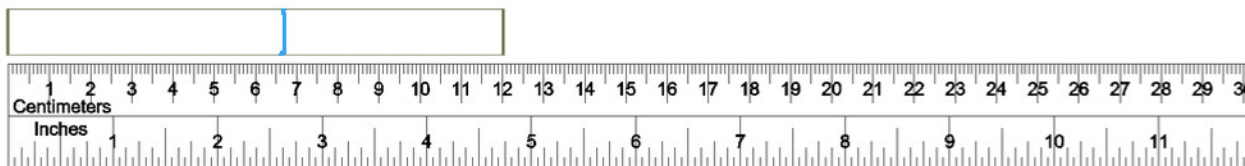
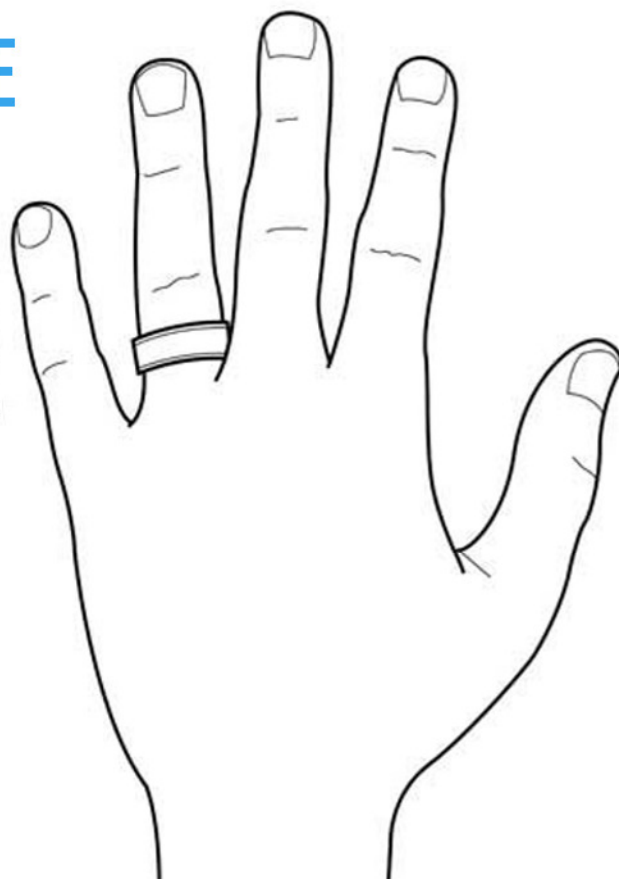
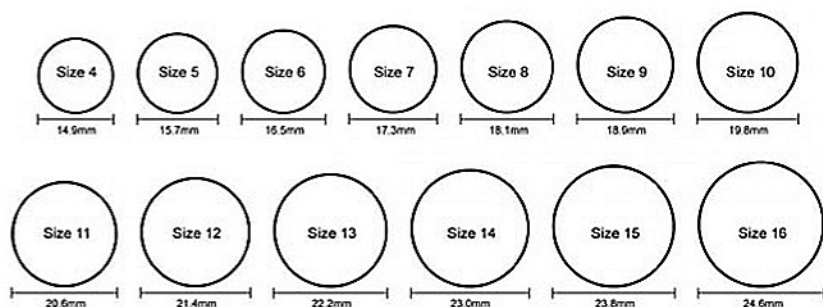


FIGURE OUT YOUR RING SIZE
