Installation Instructions

Kit contents

A 1x wheelie bar
B 2x adjusting washers
C 2x M8x25 bolt
D 4x M6x20 bolt
E 4x M6 nut



X Tools needed

- Allen key 4mm and 5mm
- Socket wrench size 10
- Ratcheting wrench with appropriate extension
- Torque wrench
- long nose pliers
- diagonal cutting nippers

* Tools, recommended by our mechanics; propper installation can also be carried out with different tools.

1. Remove the driver seat



2. Remove the passenger seat



1. Disconnect the vires from tail light and turn signal







1. Remove the 4 bolts, holding the plate holder

1. Take down the plate holder



1. Remove 2 bolts, holding the tail light

1. Remove the rubber washers



RER.

1. Place the wheelie bar A

2. Hold the wheelie bar with one hand and tighten bolts **C** (not completely) with the other hand.

1. Put in bolts **D**, tighten (not completely) on other side with washers







1. Tighten both upper bolts C



2. Tighten completely to 15Nm



1. Tuck back cables 000

- 2. Put back passenger seat

3. Tighten the bolt
