<u>Church 212</u>°

You may be wondering why our church name is actually a number. More specifically, 212° is a <u>temperature</u>. At 211 degrees, water is very hot - but at 212 degrees, water boils. At 212 degrees, steam is created and harnessed into energy to perform work.

Church 212° is about going the extra degree in our faith, going the extra degree in our relationships and going the extra degree as a church to bring the Good News of Jesus to a world who desperately needs Him.

Our History

- Lead Pastor, Stephanie Harrison. She served along beside her husband and they answered the call to ministry in 1974.
- They married in 1975.
- Mike & Stephanie helped start a church in 1977 where they served as youth pastors 3 years.
- In 1982 they planted their first church as lead pastors in Cullman Alabama and was there for 19 years.
- In 2001 They planted a church in Birmingham, Alabama and was there until 2006.
- August 3, 2008 Church 212° began:
 - 35 people met 12 weeks to determine the DNA of the church
 - We wrote the purpose, values, and strategy for our church (this and more are shared in this class).
- Dr. Mike Harrison passed away March 6th 2023.

Purpose, Mission and Strategy

Our Purpose

"Church 212° exists to <u>restore people</u> with the love of God, to <u>ignite</u> <u>passion</u> by authentic worship, and to <u>reveal God's purpose</u> to our generation through the ministry of reconciliation."

We have developed a mission and a strategy to shape our church culture in agreement with our statement of purpose.

Our Mission

There are 3 points of passion in our mission:

Romans 10:13, 14



Discipleship Pathways

1 <u>start</u>

- pastor's lunch^o explains the church's vision, mission, strategy, and how to get involved – membership.
- <u>essentials</u>[•] is a class to help the believer grow into a strong fully developed Christian. This helps Christians move to becoming true followers of Christ discipleship. "Essentials 201" is held the second Sunday of each month.
- <u>discovery</u>^o This class will help you discover your personality, gifts, and purpose in life, and see how God combines them for the best fit in ministry. The discovery^o session also introduces you to our <u>dream team</u>^o where you can learn more about serving in the ministries of Church 212^o.

<u>dream team</u>° Ephesians 2:8 – 10; 4:11 – 16.

Main Scriptures:

Acts 2:42-47

- A place to <u>Grow</u>. "As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another" (Proverbs 27:17)


Church 212° life groups are for everyone. They are where we pray for one another, care for one another, share our challenges with one another and grow.

Our Structure:

- 1. A registered 501c3 with the State of California and the Federal government.
- 2. We have a corporate board that act as trustees of the corporation.
- 3. We have a Finance Committee who reviews financial reports.
- 4. The budget process: proposed by our Pastoral staff, which is vision-driven, organized and presented by our CFO to the Finance Committee (FT); FT makes recommendations to the board for final approval.

5. Annual business meeting to report on the progress of our ministry goals; to give a financial account of finances received and spent; to present future goals and budget for the new year.
