



SUPERFINE 400 #18 CRESCENT SHAWL AND SCARF

designed for
Yarn and Soul
Superfine 400 Braids

Choose the colorful striped shawl that drapes beautifully around the shoulders or the long scarf that can be wrapped several times for a cozy fit. Use any stripe sequence you like; directions are for the sequence used in models. The stripes get longer and use more yarn as you go, so end with a couple of thin stripes.





CRESCENT SHAWL AND SCARF

Choose the first increase row for the colorful striped shawl or the second for the scarf. Bind off sooner for a smaller shawl or scarf.

THE DETAILS

THE MEASUREMENTS

Shawl: 21" wide at center, 100" long

Scarf: 17" wide at center and 112" long

SUPPLIES

Yarn:

Superfine Braid, shown in colorways:

Under the Sea 3000-70 (Scarf)

50 g /200 yards each of 5 colors:

A – 3046 peacock blue

B – 3057 midnight blue

C – 3091 sea green

D – 3094 emerald

E – 3047 faded denim

Storm 3000-30 (Shawl)

50 g /200 yards each of 5 colors:

A – 3047 faded denim

B – 3003 granite

C – 3005 storm cloud

D – 3077 pewter

E – 3075 smoke

Needles:

Knitting needles sized to get gauge.

GAUGE

4 sts and 9 rows = 1" in garter stitch.

Suggested needle size: US 6 (4 mm)

How to check your gauge:

With size US 6 (4 mm), needles, CO 20 sts. Work in garter st (knit every row) until you have a square; measure how many sts fit across 4" then divide by 4; this is your stitches per inch. If you like the fabric as it is, you don't need to change it. To modify, proceed as follows. If you have more than 4 sts per inch, your knitting may be too tight; unravel and try another swatch on a bigger needle. If you have fewer than 4 sts per inch, your knitting may be too loose, try again with a smaller needle. If you want to be daring, you can cast on and skip checking your gauge – your piece will still fit.



HOW TO KNIT IT

SHAWL AND SCARF:

With A, CO 8 sts

Row 1: K1, *yo, k1; rep from * -- 15 sts.

Increase Row For Shawl:

Row 2: K1, yo, knit until 1 st rem, yo, k1--(2 sts increased).

Increase Row For Scarf:

Row 2: K1, yo, k1, yo, knit until 1 st rem, yo, k1--(3 sts increased).

Rep your choice of row 2 for 19 more rows, change to color B and rep Row 2 four times.

Continue as follows, increasing as established on Row 2:

Color C: 20 rows.

Color A: 4 rows

Color D: 20 Rows

Color C: 4 rows

Color E: 20 Rows

Color D: 4 rows

Color B: 20 Rows

Color E: 4 rows

Color A: 20 Rows

Color B: 4 rows

Color C: 4 rows

Color E: 4 rows

With E, or last color used, BO as follows: K2, return 2 sts on RH needle to LH needle, k2tog-tbl, *k1, return 2 sts on RH needle to LH needle, k2tog-tbl; rep from * until 1 st rem. Fasten off last st.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block, paying special attention to the curve of the top middle back.



STITCHES AND ABBREVIATIONS

Garter stitch
Knit on both RS and WS rows

BO: bind off
CO: cast on
k: knit
k2tog: knit 2 stitches together (1 st decreased)
LH: left hand
rem: remain(s)
rep: repeat
RH: right hand
st(s): stitch(es)
tbl: through back loop
yo: yarn over (1 st increased)
