# DRAW STRING PULLOVER

DESIGNED FOR YARN AND SOUL: SUPERFINE 400











### DRAW STRING PULLOVER

Knit in one piece from the top down with no shaping. Can be worn with slit at front or back.

Reversible. Minimal finishing.



#### THE FIT

XS (S, M, L, XL, 2XL). Shown in S. Bust: 31½ (35½, 39½, 43½, 47½, 51½)" Length: 18½ (19, 20½, 22, 23¼, 24½)"

### **SUPPLIES**

Yarn:

2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3) hanks Superfine 400 3003 Granite

### Needles:

1 long circular needle in size to get gauge.

2 long circular needles one size smaller.

#### Other stuff:

72" cord or ribbon of your choice for drawstring.
4 stitch markers

### **GAUGE**

5 sts = 1" in Stockinette.

### Suggested needle size:

US 7 (4.5 mm)

Please note: Correct gauge is important but needle size is not. Change your needle size if necessary – It doesn't matter what size needle you use to get correct gauge.



### HOW TO KNIT IT

### NECK

With smaller needle, cast on 258 (286, 314, 342, 370, 398) sts. Do not join – work back and forth in rows.

Row 1 (RS): K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \*. Row 2 (WS): P2, \*k2, p2; rep from \*. Rows 3-6: Rep rows 1-2 twice. Knit 2 rows for turning row.

(Knit 1 row then purl 1 row) 3 times.

With second smaller circular needle and RS facing, pick up 1 st for every st along the cast on edge.

**Join to form casing:** Fold at turning row and holding the two needles together, knit 1 st from each needle together across row to join – 258 (286, 314, 342, 370, 398) sts.

Change to larger needle.

#### YOKE

Continue working in rows and work even in Stockinette until piece measures  $6\frac{1}{2}(7, 7\frac{1}{2}, 8, 8\frac{1}{4}, 8\frac{1}{2})$ " from turning row, ending with a WS row.

**Body and sleeve rib (RS):** k40 (45, 50, 55, 60, 65) sts, pm, (p2, k2) 12 (13, 14, 15, 16, 17) times, p2, pm, k 78 (88, 98, 108, 118, 128) sts, pm, (p2, k2) 12 (13, 14, 15, 16, 17) times, p2, pm, k40 (45, 50, 55, 60, 65) sts.

Join to work in the round. Keeping body sts in Stockinette and sleeve sts in rib as established, work even in the round until sleeve rib measures 1".

**Bind off for sleeves:** Work body sts in Stockinette and bind off sleeve sts loosely in rib – 158 (178, 198, 218, 238, 258) sts for body.











### **BODY**

Work even in Stockinette until body measures 10 (10, 11, 12, 13, 14)" from sleeve bind off, or 1" less than desired finished length, and decrease 2 sts on last round – 156 (176, 196, 216, 236, 256) sts.

Change to smaller needle.

### **RIB**

Next round: \*K2, p2; rep from \*.

Work this round until rib measures 1" and bind off all sts in rib LOOSELY.

Thread drawstring through casing.

### STITCHES AND ABBREVIATIONS

### Stockinette

In rows: Knit on RS; Purl on WS In the round: Knit all sts every round. **k:** knit **p:** purl

**p.** pori

pm: place marker

rep: repeat

RS: right side st(s): stitche(s) WS: wrong side
