Year-Round Water Use Schedule	3 days/week	1 day/week
GROUP A: addresses ending in 00-30	Sun, Tue, Fri	Tue
GROUP B: addresses ending in 31-60	Mon, Wed, Sat	Wed
GROUP C: addresses ending in 61-99	Sun, Tue, Thu	Thu

Note: properties with internal addressing should use the street address to determine their watering day.
