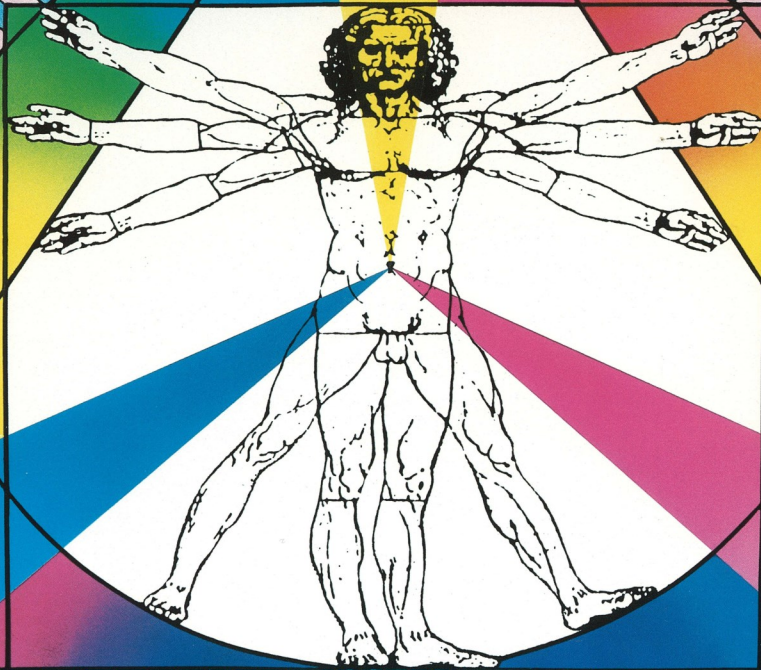

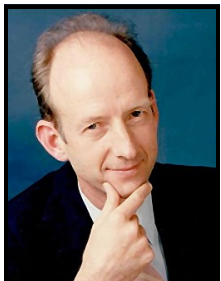
Practitioner and Education:

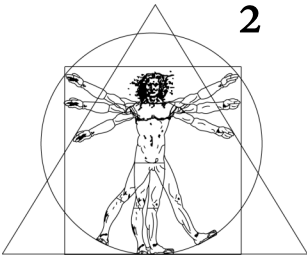
