The two main Captain's Licenses issued by the Coast Guard are the Operator of Uninspected Passenger Vessels also known as the OUPV/Six-Pack License and the 25/50/100 Ton Master License.





The 25/50 or 100 Ton Master allows the holder to operate inspected vessels as well as uninspected vessels.



Any vessel that is authorized to carry more than 6 paying passengers must have onboard a Captain who holds a Master License.

There are TWO additional endorsements that can be added to your license:



The Towing Endorsement may be issued to those who hold a Six-Pack or Master License and would like to engage in assisting vessels for a fee.




To "commercially assist" other vessels that may be aground, disabled or out of fuel, or experiencing some other malfunction requires an endorsement for Commercial Assistance Towing.



Licensed Master or Mates may also be endorsed for Sail or Auxiliary Sail, as appropriate. This endorsement authorizes the holder to operate inspected sail or auxiliary sailing vessels within the scope and limitations of their license.
