This is a great way to get your foot in the door. While not the highest paying opportunity, water taxi operations and always looking for extra captains.






Many boat brokers and dealers use licensed captains to conduct sea trials on behalf of potential buyers.




There are a large number of people who purchased boats who have no idea how to operate them safely. Experienced captains can give new boat owners the necessary knowledge and skill.









