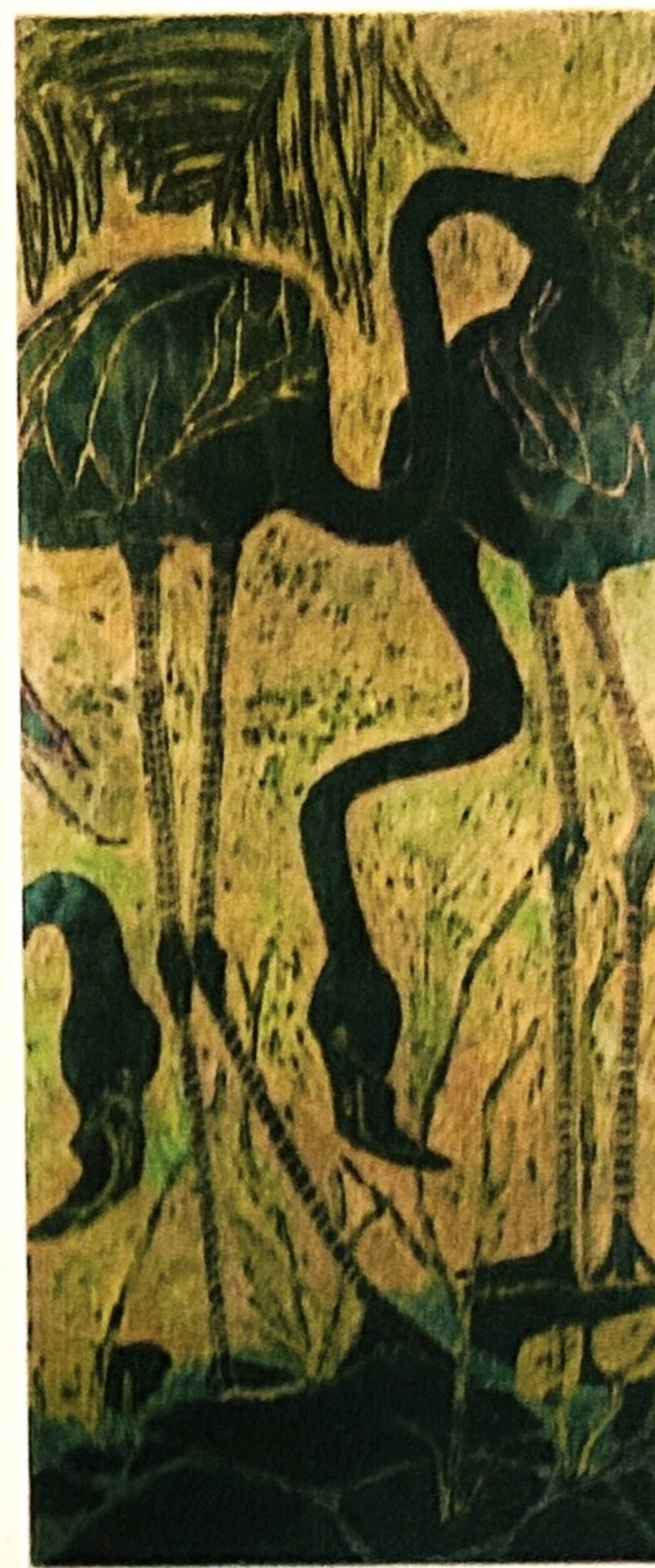

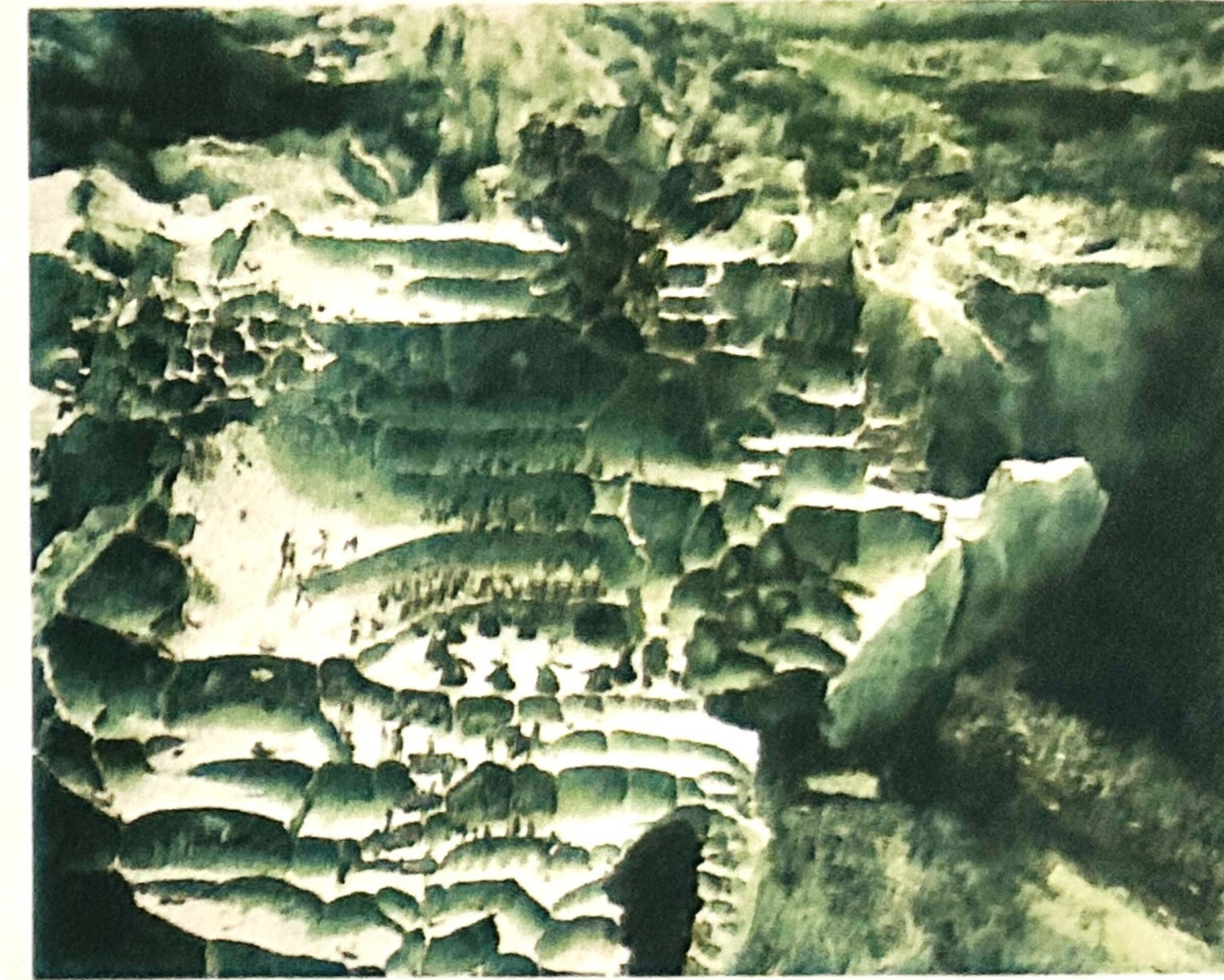

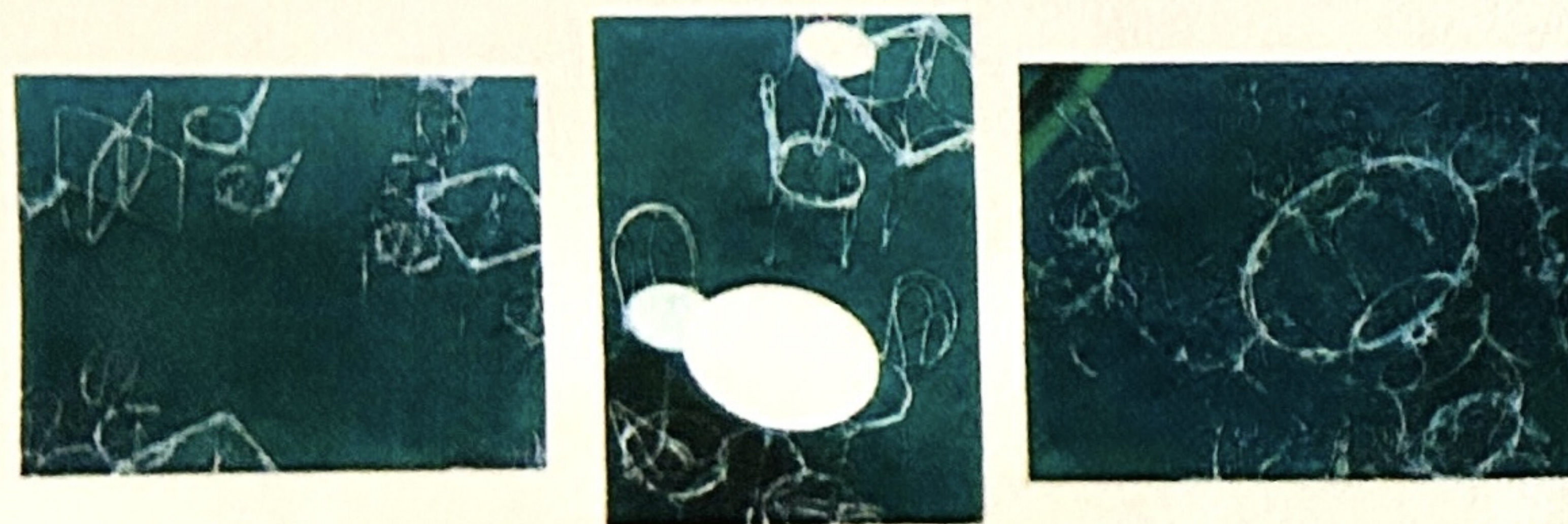

Opening day coming up for Art Maui 2006

Art Maui volunteer Ken Hultquist hangs one of the six panels that make up Maui artist Paul Mulloney's piece, "Freedom Is Slavery — A 21st Century Conundrum," on March 7 at the Maui Arts & Cultural Center's Schaefer International Gallery. Hultquist was part of a volunteer crew setting up the show that opened March 12. Out of 715 works entered by Maui County artists this year, Art Maui's three-person jury chose 79 to be exhibited. "The criteria for the work is excellent, irrespective of specific style," said show Chairman Bill Scobie-Mitchell. "It's a strong show. It's a lot smaller than previous shows." The show will run through April 8 at the Schaefer Gallery. Admission is free.
