

The choice is yours?

Group Holidays

You will be joining a group of people ranging in size from 4 – 12. Generally, we will be staying together in group accommodation. It's a fantastic way to meet new friends and also catch up with old acquaintances.

1:1 Holiday

All Access Holidays offers lots of holiday options. However, sometimes they are just not the ones people are looking for. That's where our 1:1 experiences come into play. Our 1:1 holidays allow you to specify where you would like to go and the things you would like to do when you are on holiday. You will be accompanied by one of our awesome Support Workers. In the past our 1:1 holidays have taken us all over Australia and to as far afield as Japan.

Rollers Retreat

Everyone needs some R&R at times. So, if a peaceful retreat is what you are after then we have just the solution for you. All Access Holidays has a beautiful, fully wheelchair-accessible house on Phillip Island. Equipped with all mod cons, 4 bedrooms, 2 rollin bathrooms, and a fully adapted kitchen, the Phillip Island retreat is an ideal place to refresh and rejuvenate.

Care Ratios

The cost of a holiday will depend on the level of care that a person requires. All Access Holidays operates care ratios based on a person's needs. Our group holidays are able to facilitate 1:1, 1:2, & 1:4 care ratios. The difference in price between care ratios is reflected in the support needs a person has.

How do I know if a holiday will be suitable for me?

Holidays, like people, are all different. Some might be more active than others, others might be more relaxed. It really depends. So, for each holiday we have attached some signs that will give you an indication of what type of holiday you can expect.

Will the NDIS pay for my holiday?

The NDIS will pay for the care that you receive on holiday. The NDIS will not cover accommodation, entertainment, flights,entrance fees or food and drink

All Access Rollers Retreat

We all need a break at times. But for some that can be harder than for others. For people who use wheelchairs or have additional mobility needs obtaining the accommodation that caters to all of your needs can be challenging. This is not helped by providers of accommodation claiming to be accessible when they are anything but. Having a ramp at the door does not mean you are accessible.

All Access Holidays saw a need to offer accommodation that is both peaceful, tranquil, and also completely and utterly accessible. So, when an opportunity came up to invest in such a house we jumped at the chance. Let us introduce you to our beautiful, fully accessible retreat, in one of Australia's favourite holiday destinations, Phillip Island.

Nestled in the lovely town of Rhyll, our retreat has 4 bedrooms, 3 bathrooms (two are roll in shower with grab rails), two spacious living areas, a kitchen with modified cooking, meal preparation and washing up areas. Also offered is a double king split, high/low, plegia bed, a single hospital bed with hoist and outside is a carport with direct access to the house via the sunroom with extra wide parking in the driveway for larger vans.

This house was designed around a person who became a quadriplegic in later life. So, everything for a person in a wheelchair or who has additional access needs can rest assured that everything has been thought of to maximise their convenience and comfort.

How to book

1. Pick your favourite holiday from our catalogue or website

Contact our office on 1300 585 876 or via email info@allaccessholidays.com

2. Next, we will confirm if there are places still available on your chosen holiday.

If places are still available, we will get onto all of the fun paperwork! If not, we will suggest some awesome alternatives.

3. Once you have picked the perfect holiday, we will email you a quote for the trip that consists of two component parts:

A – The care component: this is the part of the invoice that will be paid for via your NDIS funds.

B – The personal contribution: this covers accommodation, entertainment, entrance fees & food.

4. When you have decided on your dream holiday, we will issue an invoice of \$250.

This is your booking deposit. Once this is paid your place on the holiday is reserved. The full payment of the balance is due 30 days prior to departure for domestic holidays.

We will then make the appropriate arrangements for all of your transportation and support needs.

Payment Options

We understand that the personal contribution for the holiday can at times seem expensive. You may not have the money to pay the amount that is owed right at that moment. However, we don't want that to be the reason why you can't come on holiday. In order to make the process as accessible as possible, All Access Holidays has flexible payment options open to our clients on a fortnightly or monthly basis. Ask us how to set your very own holiday account.





- By paying your deposit you are indicating your acceptance of these terms and conditions and a legally binding agreement is formed between AHA and you.
- These terms and conditions can only be varied by agreement between AAH and you.

Our Services

AAH takes people with disabilities on holidays around Australia and overseas. It is a condition of all international bookings that the Client holds a valid passport at the time of paying the deposit to AAH. AAH is a service provider for the purposes of the Competition and Consumer Act 2010 ("the Consumer Law").

We provide holiday packages planned by us that include:

- Booking accommodation,
- · Provision of all means, snacks and non-alcoholic beverages
- · Arranging and booking your flights (the cost of which is not included in our fees)
- · All excursions and transfers booked and paid for
- Entertainment and activities included in your itinerary
- · All-day care and support,

We also provide tailored holidays for small groups. We will prepare a quote and itinerary which will stipulate the holiday inclusions based upon the Client needs. If something is not included in a tailored itinerary it is excluded.

Our services are only available where we can accommodate Clients' care needs and provide a safe and pleasant experience for all travelling Clients. AAH retains the discretion to decline to offer services for this reason.

- We require a deposit of 25% of the price to secure your booking
