Historically, the line between what we keep in our pantries versus our medicine cabinets has always been blurry: Turn-of-the-20th-century twentysomethings dabbed crushed beets on their cheeks to fake a girlish flush, and using fermented rice water as shampoo has been a Chinese hair-care ritual for centuries. I've been known to dip into the same jar of coconut oil to remove my makeup and roast sweet potatoes, and I consume turmeric for its anti-inflammatory properties as much as its comforting, bold flavor. But beauty brands are taking cues from the culinary world and its techniques in more complex ways as of late. The ancient art of fermentation has been co-opted to imbue balancing benefits in Korres's probiotic Greek-yogurt moisturizer, while California olive-oil producer Wonder Valley has transformed its tasty product into an antioxidant-rich skincare line. And one might expect to find a dollop of Byroe's deluxe cream, filled with fatty-acid-dense salmon caviar, plated *comme ça* at a Michelin-starred bistro. My latest indulgence: D.S. & Durga's gourmand candle, which captures a German breakfast's cozy *mise-en-scène*, complete with coffee and almond pastries. Decadent and subtly sweet—perfectly in tune with my tastes.
