Our Story

HOW IT ALL STARTED

The story began when **Eng. Mohamed Hatab** was diagnosed with cancer at the age of 9 years. During his treatment, he developed a sense of helping others, however due to his young age he was unable to pursue this until he graduated with a degree in Engineering.

During his studies in the UK, he came across the process of manufacturing artificial limbs through his colleague studying Biomedical Engineering. This sparked his sense of aid once again, and consequently he decided to integrate his field of study with Biomedical engineering to manufacture prosthetic devices in Egypt. As such, he succeeded in **developing upper and lower limb prosthesis using 3D printing technology and decided to donate these devices for free to people in need.**



Vision

*For all amputees, regardless of race, origin or religion to find the **appropriate psychological, physical and social support** required by them at no cost.*

Goal

*To provide **assistance to amputees and attempt to integrate them into society** by providing psychological rehabilitation along with custom-made prosthetic devices and lifelong maintenance.*

Send Picture & Video

Sending a picture and video of the amputation to ensure that the device can be manufactured (it is required that the arm should be amputated below the elbow and the leg should be amputated above the knee or below the knee)



Appointment

After receiving confirmation from the foundation, an appointment is set for the patient to visit the foundation at its head office



Social Research

During the appointment, personal data and any required documents are taken and a social research is conducted



Physical & Psychological Assessments

Physical and psychological assessments of the patient are carried out & measurements are taken to manufacture the device



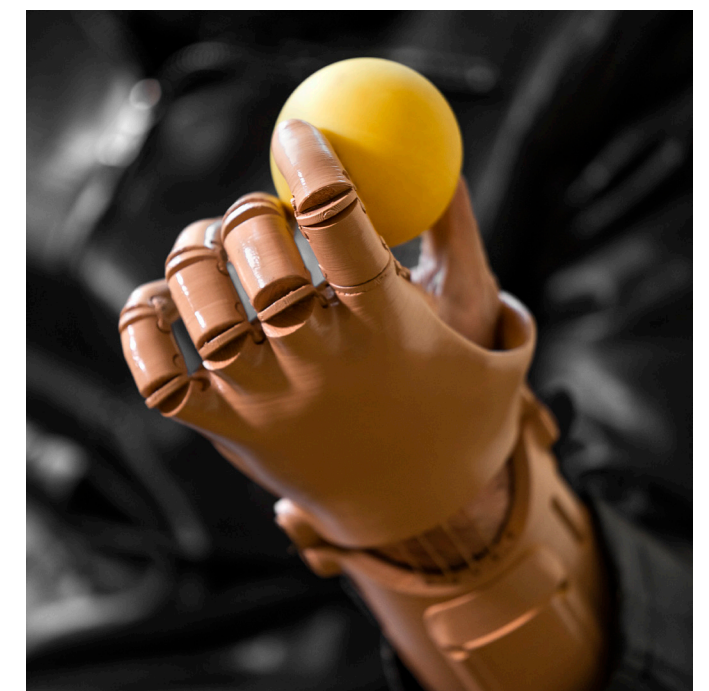
Receive The Prosthetic Device

After a week, the amputee returns to the foundation once again to receive the prosthetic device, if no modifications are required



Follow-ups

Monthly and annual follow-ups are determined and maintenance appointments are set to ensure the efficiency and good use of the device





Facts & Figures

WITH HAND IN HAND

The registered causes of amputation in Egypt are accidents and diseases, such as diabetes, bone cancer and genetic diseases. We approximate that the number of amputations in Egypt **exceeds one million cases, and the percentage of cases is divided into the following:**

75% **Due to Accidents**
which are mainly due to negligence in safety procedures

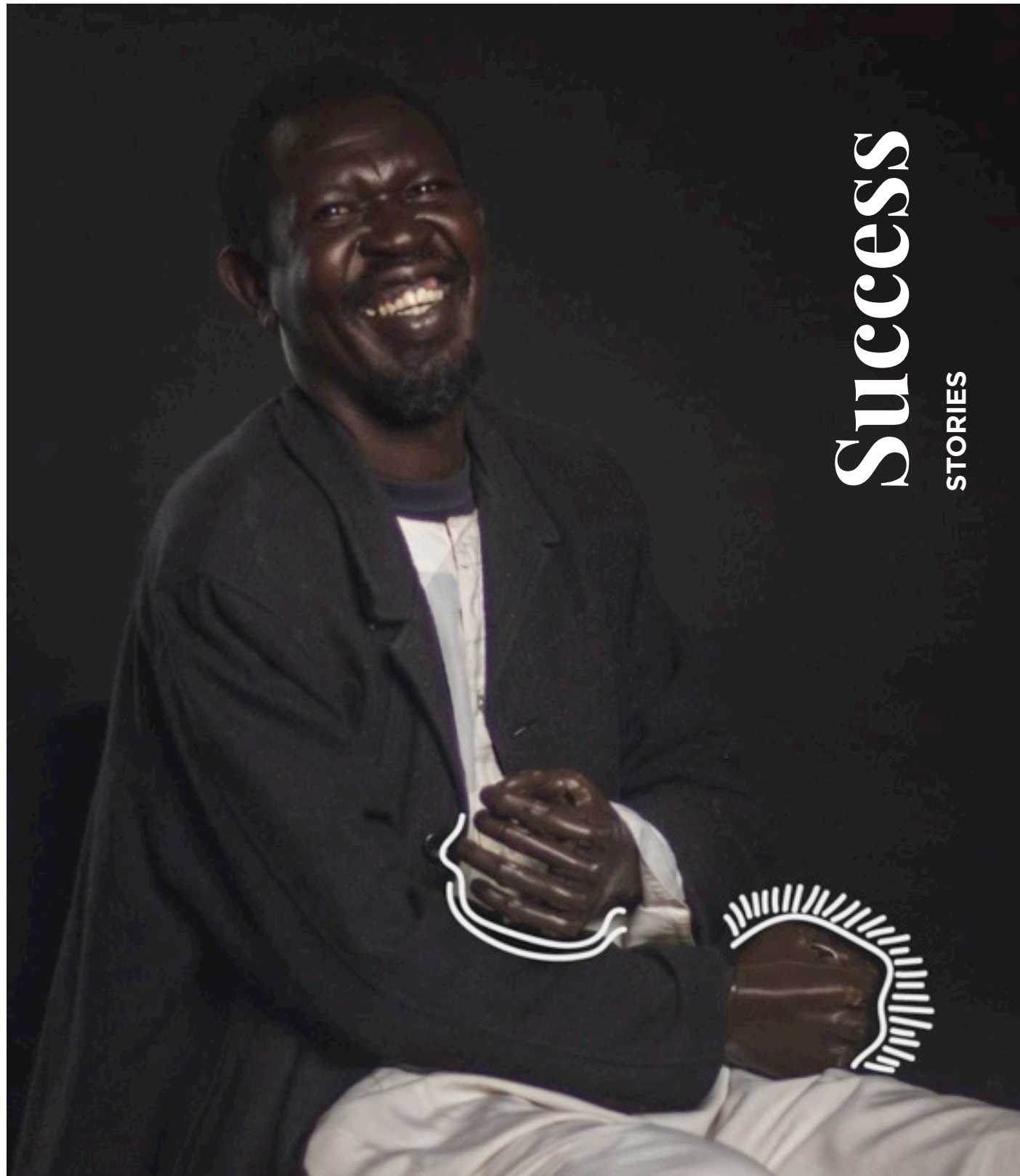


20% **Children**

He came to Hand in Hand on 27/10/2020 and we managed to fit him with **two prosthetic devices that instantly enabled him to live a better life.**



Shams Ahmad Sobhy

A 20 year old who as a kid lost both her hearing and speech due to illness and later joined the hearing and speech institute. Shams was involved in a train accident in 2011 that resulted in the loss of both her lower limbs below the knee. She came to us on 19/10/2021 and we managed to fit her with two lower limbs prosthetic devices and now, **SHE CAN WALK!**

We currently develop below wrist prosthetic devices to cater for finger amputees. By pushing against the device with their wrist, the device closes to allow the user to hold objects.

Below Elbow

12,000 LE



We also develop below elbow prosthetic devices that cater for hand amputees. By bending their elbow, the device closes to allow the user to hold an object.

Below Knee

18,000 LE



As of 2022, we have started delivering below knee prosthetic devices. These devices are custom made to each patient with the use of high tech manufacturing processes and materials. Our devices have also been tested by Mobilab & Care, Thomas More in Belgium to allow us to deliver absolute safety and comfort for our users.

Above Knee

24,000 LE



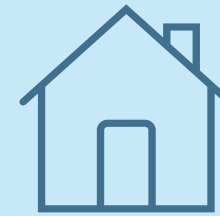

Frequently Asked Questions

What is Hand in Hand Foundation?

Hand in Hand was established in 2020 with the aim of enabling the amputee population in Egypt, where we utilise the latest NGO development methodologies in order to aid amputees (psychologically, and by providing prosthesis) free of charge.

Is the institution subject to the Ministry of Solidarity?

Hand in Hand was established in 2020 with the aim of enabling the amputee population in Egypt, where we utilise the latest NGO development methodologies in order to aid amputees (psychologically, and by providing prosthesis) free of charge.

What are the services offered by Hand in Hand?

We provide psychological rehabilitation, high tech custom-made prosthetic devices, and lifelong maintenance & support.

What are the conditions for obtaining a prosthetic device?

Six months have passed since the amputation, in order to ensure that the wound has fully healed.

For children, the child must be at least 5 years old in order to grasp the mechanics of the device.

To be psychologically qualified, which is done through the Department of the Psychology at the foundation.

Who is Eligible for the Prosthetic Limb?

Anyone who has lost a limb, regardless of the reason, whether through illness, accident, or congenital (by birth).

Prosthetics Prices?

Below the wrist: **9,600 EGP**

Below the elbow: **12,000 EGP**

Below the knee: **18,000 EG**

Above the knee: **24,000 EG**

What are the types of prosthetics provided?

Fully functional mechanical prosthetic devices are available for below wrist, below elbow, above knee, and below knee amputees.

Is it possible to discount the donation from the value of Zakat?

According to Dar Al-Ifta, it is permissible to donate as zakat and charity.
