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#### **OTHER INFO**

ACCESSIBILITY - Our beautiful classroom space is located on the second floor of a heritage building, and is unfortunately only accessible by stairs. We are happy to assist you up to the second floor.

ARRIVE EARLY - Please plan to arrive at least 15 minutes before your class start time to check in at The Cloth Shop before heading up to the classroom space.

- Full payment is required at the time of registration to reserve your place in the class or event.
- In order to make our classes run smoothly for the shop, the instructors, and fellow participants, please notify us in writing by email if you are unable to attend.
- We require a minimum of 1 week notice to cancel, and refunds will be issued by store credit as follows:

  - Less than 1 week notice = 50% refund issued as store credit
  - 48 hours notice or less = no refund, no store credit
- Late arrivals, missed sessions, or no-shows are not eligible for a refund or credit.
- If we need to cancel due to low enrolment or any other reason, we will provide a minimum of 3 days notice and offer a refund or transfer to another class.
