THEN:

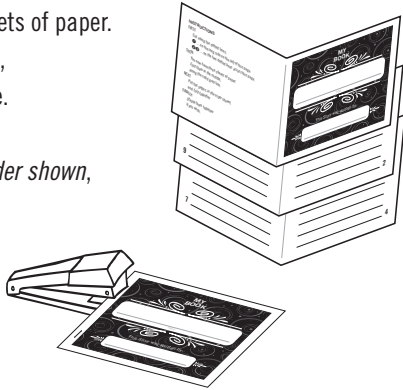
You now have three sheets of paper.

if you wish.

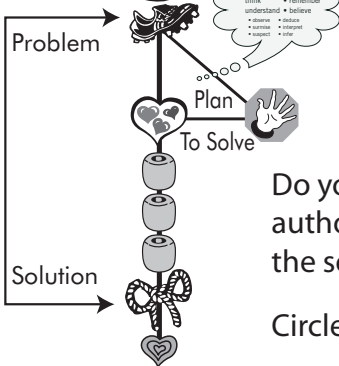
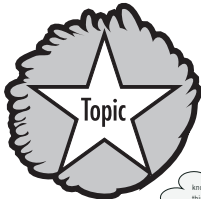
