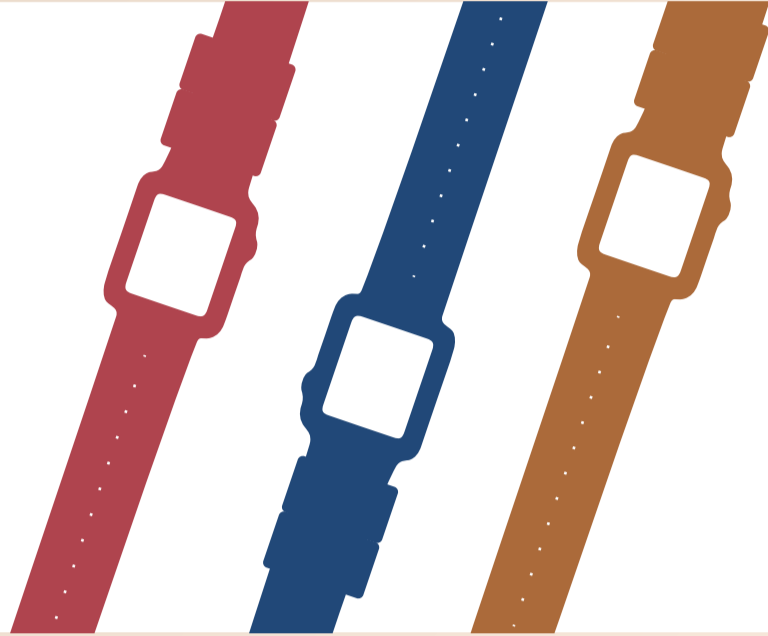
FIT

Brand-name watch bands are manufactured to quality-control guidelines. Thus, you can feel confident that things are going to fit.



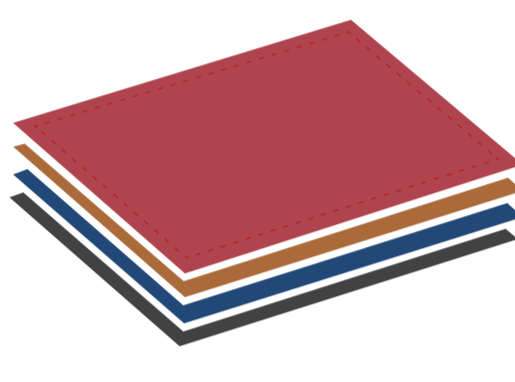
QUALITY

MANUFACTURING & MATERIALS

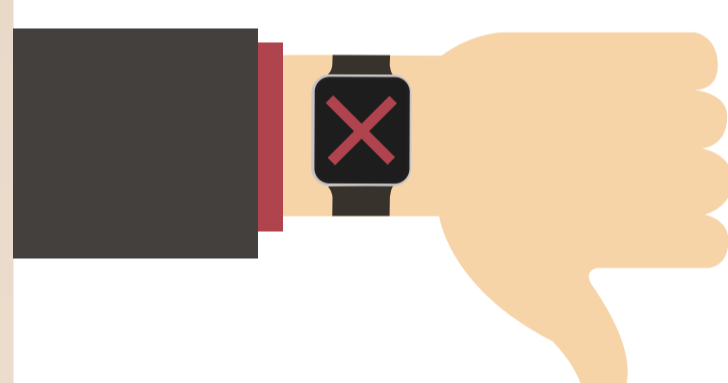
There's a steadiness, an appropriate weight, and a tightness to something that's made well. You'll know when you have a brand name band around your wrist.

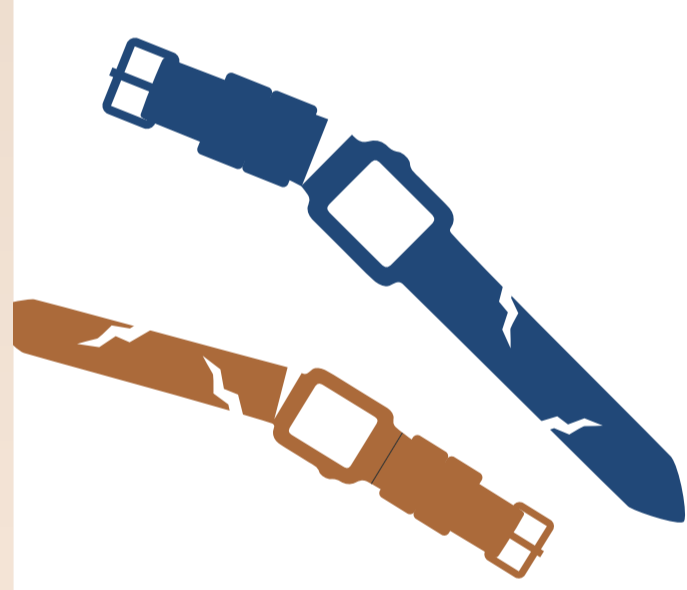
KNOCK-OFF BRAND

FIT



The fit around your wrist should match up much more to your expectations -- not too snug, not too loose. Cheap knock off brands may be loose on this aspect.

QUALITY



You'll start to notice over time and in most cases it won't take long, for knock-off Watch bands to start falling part. Quality is peace of mind, both day to day and long term.

MANUFACTURING & MATERIALS



In order to get the band to such a cheap price, the manufacturer has to take short cuts and that usually means cheaper materials that don't last.
