

Pretreatment

Regular maintenance is vital in order to keep the wood floors in a strong and beautiful condition for a long time. Well-kept surfaces also result in fast and easy cleaning and maintenance.



- 1. The unfinished woodwork must be sanded finely (grit 100-120) and it must be completely clean and dry before application of the pretreatment product.
- 2. Shake the container. Pour the pretreatment product into a plastic bucket and stir regularly to get a uniform result.
- 3. Apply the pretreatment product undiluted with the WOCA Applicator, a nylon brush or roller in an even coat on the floor lengthwise. Apply at least 1 litre of pretreatment product to 10 m2 of wood. On vertically mounted woodwork, apply from bottom to top.
- 4. After a drying time of 24 hours at 20°C/68°F (the wood must be completely dry), de-nib standing fibres with a fine sanding polishing pad before the final basic treatment. Subsequently, vacuum clean the floor.
- 5. Finish the floor with one of the well-known WOCA oils or treat with Basic Soap or Natural Soap, White.
- 6. Clean tools with water after use.

With Active Stains, the use of WOCA Wood Cleaner should occur after application and sealed with oil.
