Revelation is not merely a literalistic, linear timetable of events ... The Apocalypse is ultimately a profound work of spiritual imagery, "unveiling" Jesus Christ Himself. Jesus is perfect eschatology. Jesus must be our ultimate lens: and Revelation does not present a "different," angrier Savior than the one we meet in the Gospels. It is Christ who must define the wrath of God, not the other way around. Is God's wrath retributive ... or is it restorative? Overall, the Apocalypse has a very personal application: it heralds an inbreaking of His deliverance into our own lives, even as the Triune God restores the entire Cosmos.

Course is comprised of 24 individual sessions, which include two overview introductory lessons, followed by individual lectures for each of the twenty-two chapters of the Book of Revelation.
