They are made with a MINIMUM of 80% natural plant based ingredients and essential oils. Propylene glycol (a synthetic plant based fixative) is what holds and 'fixes' our fragrances, ensuring a long lasting scent in cosmetics, soaps and candles.

PHTHALATE FREE, VEGAN AND CRUELTY FREE.

Our natural fragrances are completely oil based, and are suitable to use in the oil stages of cosmetic manufacturing and soaps (after trace formation).

Due to their low vaporization/boiling point, natural fragrance oil should be added to your candle creations at the lowest possible temperature - when the soy wax starts to cloud / solidify.

Our Pure Coconut Candle Wax is made from cold-pressed coconut meat, the same way Coconut Oil is extracted. It then goes through a hydrogenation process, where coconut oil is transformed into a creamy white coloured candle wax. Coconuts are considered a renewable sustainable crop due to the high yield and crop renewal per acre. Our pure coconut candle wax is non GMO and has no pesticides. So... What's not to love about pure coconut candle wax. Here are 15 reasons why I think pure coconut wax is worth its weight in gold!!!

1. Appearance - It's bright White in colour.
2. It's odourless – It does not smell like coconuts... At all!
3. You won't get any frosting or bloom ruining the appearance of your candle creations.
4. Great jar adhesion - jars do not need to be preheated or fussed with.
5. It's easy to use, you can pour your coconut wax candles at any temperature.
6. Single pour! If you're using a wick holder you can make your coconut wax candles in a single pour, as there is simply no need to do re-pours. The tops may appear slightly uneven, however this does not affect the candle in any way. I believe this is what identifies the candle as a pure coconut wax candle and as such should be celebrated. And it's a great marketing tool to educate the customers how to recognise and identify if the coconut wax candle is PURE! If you don't personally like the natural look you can always blend super creamy soy wax with coconut wax at 50/50 for the top pour to get creamy smooth tops.

7. It's non toxic and burns cleaner than other types of candle wax. Coconut wax emits zero soot particles, as the wax is petro-carbon soot free. Coconut wax does not blacken walls nor add toxic carcinogens into the air you breathe.

8. Burns slower and longer – Coconut Wax burns longer than soy wax, about 10 to 15% longer for the same volume. So if you've made a 250gm soy wax candle you'd expect 50 hours burn time, but the exact same size candle using coconut wax, you'd expect 56 to 58 hours burn time. Coconut Wax candles, tolerate short burns and they also do extremely well with longer burns too. So if you want to burn your coconut wax candle for a quick 1 hour burst or enjoy a long evening with a candle flickering, it makes no difference. Just remember to trim the wick between burns to keep everything nice and safe.

9. Vibrant colours – whether you want rich deep colours, pastels or vibrant neons, amazing colours can be achieved using coconut wax. Coconut wax takes colour vibrantly and the colour lasts and lasts without fading. Soy wax is typically much harder to colour and often after a few weeks you may find colours start to fade in soy wax. You won't find such problems with coconut wax.

The trick when making candles using Essential oils and natural fragrance oils is to add them when the coconut wax is hot, BUT not too hot that they burn off and evaporate. Because Coconut candle wax has the lowest melting point of all candle waxes, it easily melts in a plastic pouring jug in the microwave, it's perfect to make candles using essential oils. I recommend using 5% essential oils when making coconut wax candles.

12. Has a superior scent throw (both cold and hot).

The best part- the icing on the cake!!!! I've left the very best for last! While the scent throw of a soy candle is great, the scent throw off of a Coconut wax candle is simply off the wall, magnificent! The smell is so strong when the candle is cold. This makes selling coconut wax candles so easy, because when people open them to smell them, they get a great first impression. It just gets better and better too, because when you burn a coconut wax candle the smell envelopes the room and stimulates the senses. It also means you can cut down on fragrance load and offset the cost of the coconut wax.

13. This wax also blends well with other waxes. I have personally used it at 70% coconut wax to 30% soy wax and found it to be a perfect marriage. I achieved creamy tops with one pour when this blend was used.

14. It's 100% natural – Celebrate this fact by educating your customers about how to recognise pure coconut wax and all its benefits.

15. We think the best properties of pure coconut candle wax is that it's pure, sustainable and eco-friendly and that it enhances every aspect and detail of candle making, from appearance colour, burn time and the intensity of scent throw. As I said right at the beginning... It's the candle industry's new darling, and mine too!!!

STEP 1

THE PREPARATION FOR MAKING CANDLES:

Gather your supplies. Just like baking your favorite recipe there's some prep work before you begin. You will need a pot to melt the wax. (I recommend one with a solid bottom, and a pourer on the side. This certainly makes life easier.)

You can microwave the wax but I find it gets too hot and affects the look of the finished product. You can also pour from the pot into a plastic jug to make filling jars easier.

YOU WILL NEED:

- A clean pot.
- Fragrance oils.
- Pure Coconut wax.
- Candle wicks.
- Clean jars (suitable heat proof jars).
- Double sided tape or stickums.
- A butter knife or screwdriver to stick the wick to bottom of the jar.
- Sharp scissors to trim the wick.
- Thermometer.
- Newspaper to catch any spills when pouring.
- Isopropyl alcohol for the cleanup.

Stick the wicks to the bottom of the jar, make sure they are centered. A very small amount of double sided tape works well. I find the foam one is the best. Ensure the tape is not larger than the wick as this may cause a fire risk. Press down with a butter knife to ensure good adhesion.

STEP 2

THE MAKING OF THE COCONUT WAX CANDLE

Melt the wax slowly at a low heat, stir to help it melt. Heat range of 65° - 70° degrees celsius. Set up your making area, lay down clean newspaper to catch any spills.

Ensure all jars are ready with centered wicks, placed on top of the paper. When the wax has melted, test with a thermometer to make sure wax is between 48° - 52° degrees Celsius and add your fragrance. If the wax is too hot it will burn off the fragrance, leaving you with a barely there, subtle scent, rather than a candle with an amazing scent throw. Add fragrance oils, between 8-10% of total wax weight or essential oils, I recommend 5% for essential oils. Mix well to ensure fragrance goes through all the wax.

STEP 3

THE CREATION OF YOUR CANDLE

Test with a thermometer to make sure wax is between 40°- 46° degrees Celsius and carefully pour the melted wax into your jar. As it's at a lower temperature, it will be reasonably thick and easy to control and pour without risk of splashing or spilling. I usually pour into two stages so I can center the wick. Stage 1: pour the jar 80% full, let cool to semi-solid, center the wick and complete final pour.

STEP 4

WAITING IS THE HARDEST PART

The wax will begin hardening right away, so do not move or adjust your candle until it has set solid. As the wax begins to harden, you'll see the wax go whitish in colour. Leave to sit for at least three hours before moving. I find it best to trim the wick 5 to 6 hours later to avoid the wick disturbing the top of the candle. Trim the wick, using sharp scissors. Generally, you should trim the wick 1 - 1.5cm above the level of your wax. Make sure you allow 3 days for the candle fragrances to cure before burning. 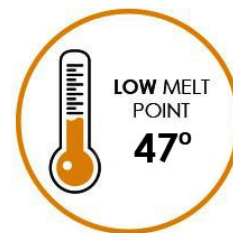

THE PREPARATION FOR MAKING SOY CANDLES:

Gather your supplies. Just like baking your favorite recipe there's some prep work before you begin. You will need a pot to melt the wax. (I recommend one with a solid bottom, and a pourer on the side. This certainly makes life easier.)

You can microwave the wax but I find it gets too hot and affects the look of the finished product. You can also pour from the pot into a plastic jug to make filling jars easier.

YOU WILL NEED:

- A clean pot.
- Fragrance oils.
- Soy wax.
- Candle wicks.
- Clean jars (suitable heat proof jars).
- Double sided tape or stickums.
- A butter knife or screwdriver to stick the wick to bottom of the jar.

STEP 3

Test with a thermometer to make sure wax is between 48° - 52° degrees Celsius and carefully pour the melted soy wax into your jar. 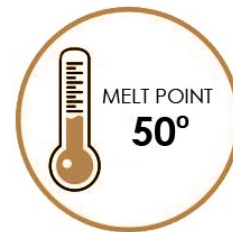

Add fragrance oils, between 9-11% of total wax weight or essential oils, I recommend 5% for essential oils. Mix well to ensure fragrance goes through all the wax.

STEP 3

THE CREATION OF YOUR CANDLE

Test with a thermometer to make sure wax is between 50°- 55° degrees Celsius and carefully pour the melted soy wax into your jar. As it's at a lower temperature, it will be reasonably thick and easy to control and pour without risk of splashing or spilling. I usually pour into two stages so I can center the wick. Stage 1: pour the jar 80% full, let cool to semi-solid, center the wick and complete final pour.

STEP 4

WAITING IS THE HARDEST PART

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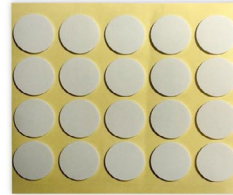

Soy melts

HOW TO MAKE AMAZING SOY WAX MELTS LIKE A PRO!

STEP 1

THE PREPARATION FOR MAKING SOY MELTS

Gather your supplies. Just like baking your favourite recipe there's some prep work before you begin. You will need a pot to melt the wax. (I recommend one with a solid bottom, and a pourer on the side. This certainly makes life easier.) You can microwave the wax but I find it gets too hot and can affect the look of the finished product. If the wax temperature is too high it will cause the fragrance to burn off, leaving a weakly scented soy wax melt. You can also pour from a pot into a plastic jug to make filling the soy wax moulds easier.

YOU WILL NEED:

- A clean pot.
- Fragrance oils.
- Soy wax extended burn. This harder soy wax makes the best melts that hold their shape when made and packed. Extended burn soy wax also makes melt that last longer in the wax melt warmer.
- Clean dry silicone soy wax moulds.
- Thermometer.
- Newspaper to catch any spills when pouring.
- Isopropyl alcohol for the clean up.

STEP 2

THE MAKING OF THE SOY WAX MELT/TARTS

Melt soy wax slowly at a low heat, stir to help it melt. If using a microwave, melt in 1-minute bursts. Set up your making area, lay down clean newspaper to catch any spills. Place soy wax moulds in the middle of the paper.

When the wax has melted, test with a thermometer to make sure the wax is lower than 40 degrees Celsius. If the soy wax is too hot it will burn off the fragrance, leaving you with a barely there, subtle scent, rather than a soy melt with an amazing scent throw and fragrance

complexity. Add fragrance oils and or essential oils. Between 10 and 12% of total soy wax weight. Mix well to ensure fragrance goes through all wax.

STEP 3

THE CREATION OF YOUR SOY WAX CANDLE

Carefully pour the fragranced, melted soy wax into the moulds. As its lower than 40 degrees C it will be reasonably thick and easy to control and pour without risk of splashing or spilling. I pour melts in one pour. Carefully fill to the top, do not over fill. As overfilling will cause wastage.

STEP 4

WAITING IS THE HARDEST PART

The soy wax will begin hardening right away, so do not move or adjust your moulds until all soy melts have set solid. As the soy wax begins to harden, you'll see the soy wax go whitish in colour. Leave to sit for at least 1 hour before disturbing. When the melts have hardened, gently turn them out of the silicone moulds.

While you can use your melts straight away, the fragrance will not be fully developed. It takes 3 days for the fragrance to cure. If you can hold yourself back for 3 days, you will experience a much better scent throw. You will notice different layers of scent rather than just experiencing the top notes.

STEP 5

THE PRESENTATION: Soy wax melts make the most amazing gifts. There are so many ways to present them. Make sure whatever you store them in that it's airtight. The presentation tubes provided make a visually appealing gift, just use your imagination when designing a label and some pretty ribbons and voilà.. I recommend taping the bottom of the tube so you don't lose your soy wax creations before you add all the pretties.

TROUBLESHOOTING

TIPS & TRICKS WHEN MAKING SOY WAX CANDLES

Super Creamy soy wax is our best-selling wax because it is so easy to use, and performs exceptionally, when used correctly. We sell this wax by the pallet to many commercial candle companies, and have received great feedback and reorders.

I too, am a passionate candle maker and have made hundreds of soy candles using Super Creamy wax. So, we certainly consider this wax thoroughly tested.

However, we strongly recommend testing products on a small scale first to ensure you get the right results. As our products are natural, there can be variations from using different waxes and different fragrances. They may perform differently from what you have experienced in the past, and as such your formulations may need to be slightly adjusted.

Soy waxes are not all the same. Not all soy waxes are 100% natural. Many contain unnatural / unhealthy additives like paraffin wax sourced from petroleum, unethically sourced palm wax - causing deforestation issues around the world and even tallow wax (rendered fat of animals).

They often state that their additives are natural, but don't list what they are? This raises many red flags for me.

Our 100% natural soy waxes are hydrogenated and formulated to exact specifications so they may perform differently from other soy waxes containing additives. As your dealing with natural products, not synthetics, never assume that what works for another brand of soy wax and brand of candle fragrance oil will be the same without thoroughly testing.

OVERHEATING OUR SOY WAXES MAY CONTRIBUTE TO ALL THE PROBLEMS LISTED BELOW:

Melt the soy wax in a pot with a thick bottom on a very low heat, until it turns into its liquid form - approx. 40 degrees. Using the microwave to melt soy wax will often cause problems and affect the look of the finished product. As you are not able to control the heat.

Overheating soy wax by either pot or microwave will change the chemistry of the soy wax and may cause the soy wax to separate. (I once forgot about a batch of soy wax on the stove, and it came to the boil. I left the wax to see what would happen to it? It set to an almost desert like finish with highs lows and shiny spots. After hours of trolling through the internet, I found a solution. I managed to recover the overheated soy wax, by adding 50gms of shea butter per kg to the soy wax. This returned the soy wax to the required creamy finish. If the temperature fluctuations are too much for me to manage, I add some shea butter to my final, top pour to avoid any issues.

When adding fragrance always take a few minutes to stir the candle fragrance thoroughly through the soy wax. If not mixed thoroughly this may cause separation and the fragrance may leach from the wax. If the fragrance is added to soy wax to hot it will burn off leaving a barley there scent.

Bubbling - Make sure the first pour wax is not cold, as the change in temperature by adding warm soy from the second pour will cause bubbles to come to the candle surface and affect the finished look of your soy candle.

Frosting (candles turning white) - Pouring your candles at too hot of a temperature (Pour soy wax at the coolest possible temperature). Many factors affect the formation of frosting such as fragrance, dye pour temperature, cooling temperature, and storage temperature. Typically an easy fix with a heat gun.

Rough lumpy candle tops - Caused by pouring the soy wax at a temperature that's too hot for the wax. Always pour your soy wax at the coolest possible temperature. Always ensure, that the first pour is hard enough to leave a finger mark in the soy wax, before completing the second pour. Otherwise, the heat of the new soy wax will cause the semi set soy wax from the first pour to come up to the surface of your soy candle. This causes a lumpy curdled effect.

Cooling too quickly or too slowly - In this heat, I recommend using a fan to keep the candle pouring room temperature constant. Also, keep a 5- 6cm space between the jars to allow them to cool evenly. When the temperature is cold it may cause the soy wax to crack. Always keep your work space at an even temperature. Place newspaper or cardboard down to insulate jars/containers from stone or granite counter tops that can cause uneven cooling during cooler months.

If it's your first time making candles, or you're having an issue don't worry? Most problems can be easily fixed. Another tip I learned years ago, is to use a heat gun (Bunnings sell these for under \$30 a great investment - or you can carefully use your hair-dryer only with the diffuser) to re-melt the candle surface back to its liquid form allowing it to reset to a smooth finish.

The look of the candles won't affect the scent throw or performance, as soon as you light the candle it will return to a liquid wax pool. When it re-hardens it will be to a smooth finish. However, if you're gifting your soy candles you can add a small amount of shea butter (50gms of shea butter per 1kg of soy wax) to the top pour to ensure a smooth creamy finish every time. A great way of not having to manage all the environmental factors that mother nature throws at us.

Mushrooming wicks - this occurs with most natural wicks (Just remind your customers to always re-trim the wick before relighting to 1.5cm).

Too much smoke? - Generally caused by too large a wick or the candle is sitting in a draft. (Drafts supply more oxygen than the wick can burn off, causing incomplete combustion).

Soap Making

BASIC GUIDE

STEP 1

THE PREPARATION: MAKING MELT & POUR SOAP

Gather your supplies. Just like baking your favourite recipe there's some prep work before you begin. You will need a pot to melt the wax. (I recommend one with a solid bottom, and a pourer on the side. This certainly makes life easier.) Or you can microwave the Melt and pour soap using a long spout pouring jug but be very careful as it's very easy for it to get too hot and burn, this will affect the look of the finished product.

You can also pour from your pot into a long spout pouring jug to make filling the reusable soap moulds easier.

YOU WILL NEED:

- A clean pot.
- A long spout pouring jug.
- Fragrance oils 25-30mls per 1kg.
- 1Kg Melt and pour soap base.
- Isopropyl alcohol with sprayer.
- Newspaper to catch any spills when pouring.

Set up your soap making area, lay down clean newspaper to catch any spills. Ensure all reusable soap moulds are clean, and on a flat surface. Clean soap moulds by spraying with isopropyl alcohol. This also helps the melt and pour soap base to adhere nicely to the mould. Let dry.

STEP 2

THE MAKING

Chop the 1Kg block of Melt and Pour Soap Base into approx. 9-10 pieces. Place into a pot melt on very low heat, stir gently until melted. Or place into a microwaveable pouring jug – Melt for 2 minutes, then continue to melt in 30 second bursts, between bursts, stir the soap to help it melt evenly until all soap has returned to its liquid form. Never let soap boil as it's easy to burn. Depending on the strength of your microwave this can take a few minutes. Melt soy wax slowly at a low heat, stir to help it melt.

When melt and pour soap has melted, test with thermometer to make sure soap is under than 40 degrees celsius. If the soap is too hot it will burn off the fragrance, leaving you with a barely there, subtle scent, rather than a soap with an amazing scent. Add fragrance oils and or essential oils. Between 25 to 30mls of fragrance per 1Kg total soap weight.

Mix slowly / folding to ensure fragrance goes through all the melted soap without causing additional bubbles. As bubbles will affect the finished look of your soap creation.

STEP 3

THE CREATION

Carefully pour the soap into the reusable soap moulds as close as possible, to avoid making extra bubbles. Bubbles will typically appear after the pouring process, regardless of how careful you are. It's an easy fix, spritz the surface layer of the soap with isopropyl alcohol to remove surface bubbles.

This is where I find the long spout pouring jug really handy. Fill all moulds at 1 time. The soap will begin hardening right away, so do not move or adjust your reusable moulds, until the soap has set solid. Allow the soap to fully cool and harden for at least 6 hours, overnight is always better, to ensure soap removes from the silicone mould cleanly. Turn upside down onto clean surface and remove soap from mould carefully - wrap individually in airtight plastic or cellophane.

STEP 4

WAITING IS THE HARDEST PART

Make sure you allow 3 days for the fragrances to cure, in your soap creations before using. Otherwise, the full spectrum of fragrance notes will not be appreciated. Clean your reusable silicone mould with hot water, store away in a clean place for your next soap adventure.

Single Note fragrances

Q: WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN SINGLE NOTE FRAGRANCE OILS AND THE OTHER FRAGRANCE OIL BLENDS?

A: Soy wax candle making is so incredibly easy. Imagine being able to dream up a fragrance idea, then select all the different fragrance notes that make up that fragrance (you'll find the biggest selection of single note fragrances here) or if you love a certain fragrance but you wish one of the notes was a bit stronger. Then you can customise a blend by adding more of what you're after.

Example, I love black raspberry and vanilla natural fragrance oil, but I thought to make it “extra amazeballs” it should have some plummy notes to give it a bit of depth. So, I added 5% black plum natural fragrance oil and mixed it together. I then made a small tealight candle to test the scent and its throw. After testing my soy candle (burning it) I made another slight adjustment and added another 5% vanilla pod.

I again tested my soy candle... I’m thrilled to say perfection was achieved.

Example, I found this Jo Malone soy candle on google, that I’d love to recreate but I can’t find anything similar in New Zealand? It said it had 4 fragrances in it? Top note of Xxxxxxx mid note of XXXXXXXX in a base of XXXXXX and XXXXXXXX. How do I know what percentage of each when I am recreating the fragrance? Always remember we need to finish at 100% So in this case, I would suggest the top note would be the strongest, let’s start with 40% then add the mid-note fragrance at say 30%. You then have 30% to play with for the two base notes. You could use 15% of each or 20% then down to 10%. It’s totally your call.

Remember to test on a small scale first. Then recreate.

Q: DO I HAVE TO ADJUST THE NATURAL FRAGRANCE OILS? CAN’T I JUST USE THEM AS THEY ARE MIXED?

A: Absolutely you can use them just as they are. They are in fact perfect, for the hobby candlemaker. But if you’re a budding entrepreneur trying to break through and stand out from the soy candle making crowd, you need to be different.

Elizabeth Arden said the secret to success is to reinvent something everyone’s familiar with and change it up by no more than 10%.

Q: WHAT IF I MESS UP MY FRAGRANCE BLEND AND IT SMELLS YUCKY?

A: Test and measure in very small batches. You’ll find great wee droppers for kids (usually used for pamol) at your local pharmacy for around a \$1.00 each. Test and measure enough fragrance to make a couple of tea light candles. Then you can test the scent throw when the candle is burning. Remember to keep notes, when creating your masterpieces, so you can recreate your new stand out soy wax candle.

Don’t be scared, be confident when creating natural fragrances. If all else fails My No. 1 rule is Vanilla’s fix everything.

Q: CAN I REALLY MAKE MONEY MAKING AND SELLING MY OWN SOY WAX CANDLES?

A: Heck yes!!!!!! It’s an extremely profitable business. There’s many a candle maker who’s quietly taking home an easy \$500 to \$1000 after a weekend market. There’s even more of them online, selling nationally!! Imagine the possibilities.

If you’ve got a bit of technical ability there are some slick websites you can put together in a few days that will get your candle creations selling nationwide.

How Much fragrance should I add to my candles?



Q: HOW MUCH FRAGRANCE SHOULD I USE WHEN MAKING SOY WAX CANDLES?

A: Great question. I always use 15% natural fragrance, because I love my soy candle's super strong. But the joys of making your own soy candles means you can make them however you want. If you like a subtle scent then adjust your candle fragrance accordingly.

If you're selling your soy candles in a market or retail environment, it's important to have a strong scent. Why? Cause in often in a big area with so many conflicting smells (at markets often yummy ones) your soy wax candle will need to be strong enough to break through all the conflicting smells. In a retail environment often they are left with lids off, and typically lose scent over time.

If you want to burn your soy candles at home or give them as gifts I recommend a 12 to 15% fragrance load. Why? Triple scented soy candles and melts always outsell standard scented candles. People today, just don't have the time to wait 3 hours for the room to smell beautiful. The fragrance throws need to be pretty instant, or there'll be no repeat orders I'm afraid.

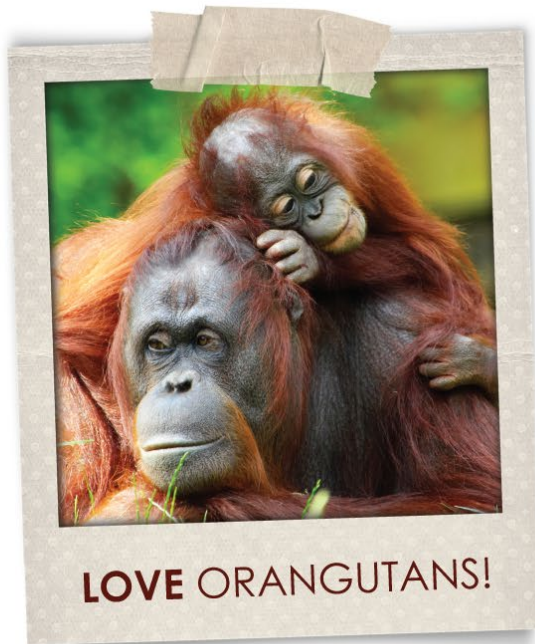

Q: I BOUGHT A SCENTED SOY CANDLE AT THE WAREHOUSE IT SMELT GREAT, BUT WHEN I BURNT IT THERE WAS NO SMELL. DID I DO SOMETHING WRONG?

A: Firstly, is it really a soy candle? Or is it a scented candle? Often the packaging and wording can be misleading? Cheap candles, often made in China are not made of soy wax. They are typically made from 50/50 paraffin wax and palm wax. This is a deadly combination for the health of our planet and the health of our families. Let me explain. Paraffin Wax is a petroleum waste product that's been deodorized and chemically bleached before it was made into candle wax.

Most candles made in China are made using a blend of paraffin and palm wax, which creates highly toxic benzene and toluene when burned (both are known carcinogens). In fact, the toxins released from paraffin candles are the same as those found in diesel fuel fumes.

Most Palm wax comes from non-sustainable palm plantations. Greedy corporations are cutting down some of the oldest and most diverse rainforests in the world, to make way for more palm trees.

Thus, causing Orangutan populations to be misplaced???. Come on people "misplaced," the word's a joke. How many Orangutan rescue programs does there need to be on the animal planet before we admit palm plantations are akin to Orangutan genocide.

Due to the bad publicity, around these bad boys, you'll find most ingredient labels from candles bought at the warehouse, farmers, and Kmart state they are a soy wax blend. Do not be misled, Chinese blends always contain paraffin wax and palm wax as these cheap waxes are at least 35% cheaper than soy wax. This is bad news for the consumer but great news for you the budding soy candle makers.

Secondly, some cheap candle makers only scent the top layer (the final pour) of the candle. This gives a great first impression. A lovely strong scent. This is often why people buy scented candles, to begin with. BUT buyer beware. Once they get the candle home, and there's no scent throw. There won't be any repeat business.

Another trick often used in China is to scent the packaging, yep that's right they spray the box with the scent, so it smells amazing. You get the candle home and all you'll get is a pretty flickering light.

Top 20 Fragrances



Q: What are the advantages of using soy wax when making candles?

A: The benefits are huge and outstanding - soy candle's wax versus paraffin and palm wax candles!!!

Soy wax is non-toxic and non-carcinogenic. Soy wax candles produce little or no soot, (unless you forget to trim your wick. Long wicks create an uptake of carbon, and often create unwanted smoke.) and the candle is so they are a great alternative for those with allergies and breathing problems. Soy candle wax is environmentally safe, biodegradable, and renewable. Soy wax candles are extremely economical as they typically burn up to 50% longer than paraffin wax candles. My favourite thing about Soy wax other than the obvious health and environmental issues is the scent throw. Soy wax holds natural fragrance oils exceptionally well, and due to its low melt point, (this means that it burns cooler.) natural fragrance oils can really live up to their full potential.

Q: DO I REALLY NEED A DOUBLE BOILER TO MAKE SOY CANDLES?

A: Nope not true at all. You only need an old pot or a new cheap and cheerful one from Kmart or the warehouse or even your local \$2.00 shop. The trick is to watch it constantly stand at the stove, stir the wax until it all melts. Do not let the soy wax boil.

While you're at the \$2.00 shop be sure to grab a thermometer, to test the heat of the soy wax before you add any natural fragrance oils. Look for a pot with a side pourer. If you can't find one be sure to grab a silicone pourer to attach to the side of a standard pot. This will certainly make life easier.

You can even use your microwave and the microwave pouring jug if you're only making 3 or 4 candles at a time. Remember making soy candles is super easy, it's not rocket science.

Q: HELP MY CANDLE DYE ISN'T LOOKING, RIGHT? WHAT AM I DOING WRONG?

A: The magic jug – add 100mls of soy wax into the microwave pouring jug. Melt soy wax until very hot. Add required (measured) amount of soy candle dye to the melted soy wax.

Keep microwaving in 30 seconds to 1-minute bursts. Stir in between 30 seconds to 1-minute bursts until all candle dye has dissolved completely into melted soy wax. Then add melted wax / dye mixture back into wax pot stir thoroughly to mix.

Pros & Cons

OF RECYCLING CANDLE JARS... LET'S ALL AGREE SCENTED CANDLES ARE AMAZING.



Recycling Candle Jars... Let's all agree scented candles are amazing. They smell incredible and nothing comes close to replicating the soft mesmerising, flickering light of a soy candle. The downside is that all candles involve fire; a potential danger when instructions are not followed carefully.

I am big on sustainability and doing the right thing for the planet. It's such a nice feeling to be able to reuse things before throwing them into the recycle bin when we can. I am also big on doing the right thing for my customers and my family. That means I have set a few guidelines to ensure my candle creations are as safe as possible. Safety is paramount in my mind, I could never live with myself if I was responsible for an injury or an accident.

The pros and cons of recycling glass candle jars!

Glass - Exploding candle jars are quite a legitimate problem. A very prominent candle brand has recently been on Fair Go and in the Herald, they have been taking a beating for their candle jars exploding. Consumers are outraged that the exploding candles are putting themselves and their homes at risk. Often, these incidents occur due to a lack of education, common sense or simply forgetfulness.

Me, well I fall into the forgetful category. I get so caught up in doing something (crafting) that I lose track of time. Before you know it I forget what time it is. Three hours escape into five hours and then a loud crack brings me back to the reality that I left my candle burning too long.

Another one I am guilty of is burning a candle and either falling asleep or completely forgetting about it. Then I find it still going in the morning. Naughty naughty me.

Typically, what causes glass candle jars to explode, is that the candle has burned too low, causing an excessive build-up of heat in the bottom of the jar. A simple draught at this stage, from a door or window and crack, or even a body whisking past and it's over and over.

The safety instructions tell us to watch the candle, to never leave it unsupervised. To stop burning the candle when 1 cm of wax remains but... life takes over, we get busy and it's really our fault isn't it, because we didn't follow the safety instructions.

Due to my easily distracted nature, super creamy soy wax is always my preferred choice. Why because it burns at a much lower heat than paraffin wax, palm wax or beeswax. The lower melt point causes much less strain on the glass.

Recycling glass - Not every glass container can be used to safely make candles; glass can become stressed from constant heating and cooling of the wax. Glass weakens as it accumulates heat bumps and scratches from use.

If you're looking to recycle a previously used candle glass jar, the rule of thumb is to only recycle the jar once, and ONLY once. Then up-cycle the jar, (make it into something else) or lastly pop it into the recycle bin. So it can start its journey all over again.

When recycling glass candle jars, always ensure the thickness of the glass wall (width) is more than 2mm thick to avoid explosions. Glass vases and many drinking glasses are not suitable as they are too thin and are not made to withstand heat. I personally won't refill any companies candle jars that are branded as this is a trademark violation, that could lead to costly legal action.

How to remove old wax from previously used candle jars.



Turn jars upside down and place onto an old baking tray with sides to catch the excess wax.

Place into a cool oven, heat oven to 65 degrees.

Remove tray carefully from the oven when the soy wax has melted out of candle jars.

Leave the jars to cool, scrape wax away from the neck of the jar.

Wash with warm soapy water. I find sugar soap the best.

Allow to dry and follow these simple (mostly) fool proof, safety practices.

Select glassware intended to withstand heat.

Carefully check glass candle jar has no cracks chips or deep scratches.

Select the lowest melt point soy wax to keep the glass cool.

Select the smallest wick possible, to ensure enough heat to melt soy wax across the jar.

Ensure wicks are always centered.

If you or your customer have the most amazing jar ever, and you or they love it to pieces, I recommend you make candles in tea lights or in a small tin, (that fits inside the jar) then place inside the jar. That way you get the pleasure of the candle and the satisfaction that your precious jar will be with you forever!!!

Oh, and the knowledge that you're doing the right thing by not risking anyone's safety.

MAKE YOUR VERY OWN Reed Diffusers



Lets all agree reed diffusers are superb way to add constant fragrance to your home, when they work? If your anything like me you've probably been suckered into buying 1 or 6 reed diffusers because of the fragrance name, the pretty bottle or the gorgeous packing. Or maybe Santas elves have even popped a few into your Santa sack.

Being a lover of anything that smells good, overall I have been pretty disappointed with the lack of smell from most reed diffusers.

Most store bought reed diffusers, smell pretty (when your very close up) but they certainly don't fill the room, like they say on the box? Another thing that really bothers me, is that they have no ingredients written on the bottle or packaging? This obvious avoidance leads me to believe I am probably inhaling some solvent not fit for humans? Or why else leave it off the packaging?

So with all these things in mind I set out to find the best materials available and believe I have found the perfect solution. A reed diffuser that actually fills the room!!!! This is true, hand on heart :)

Just follow 5 simple instructions, and in minutes you'll have a custom reed diffuser like you always wanted. Check out our easy 50ml starter kits here

Or if you want to reuse or recycle a pretty bottle you have at home, follow the instructions below, and purchase all the pieces individually.

The Reeds – Always ensure the reeds are twice as tall as your diffuser, this ensures good distribution of fragrance. I typically like to use uneven numbers of reed sticks, as I think it uneven numbers always look better. If the sticks are too long and your creation looks unbalanced, trim the sticks before placing fragrance into the jar. You can check out our reed sticks here

The vessel – Always ensure its glass, and has no cracks or chips. As fragranced oils, essential oils and reed diffuser base will strip varnish off polished surfaces, and may damage delicate surfaces. Always wipe diffuser jar with a soft dry cloth before placing on delicate surfaces.

The Scent - This is where it gets fun! You can either use essential oils or fragranced oils.

Recommended ratios when mixing fragrance oils to NZCS Premium Reed Diffuser is 20%. If a stronger scent is required 25% can be added, often larger rooms require an increased fragrance ratio.

100ml bottle of base – add 20 - 25mls fragrance oil.

250ml bottle of base – add 50 - 60mls fragrance oil.

500ml bottle of base – add 100 - 120mls fragrance oil.

1 Litre bottle of base – add 200 - 250mls of fragrance oil.

STRONG 20-25 drops of essential oil

SUBTLE 10-12 drops of essential oil

Please note: We recommend you do your own personal testing to ensure the desired scent throw is achieved as some fragrance oils are much stronger than others.

Always complete filling of diffuser base over newspaper or a hard surface that will not stain or damage, as diffuser base is solvent based.

Keep away from wood and plastic surfaces and store safely away from children and pets.

Store only in original bottle or glass bottle.

Putting it all together, is as easy as 1,2,3,4,5

- Assemble your reed diffuser creation on top of newspaper or handee towel to grab any spills, and make sure you do this over a bench top or sink to avoid marking fragile surfaces.
- Make sure your reed diffuser jar is clean and dry. Place clean jar on top of newspaper or handee towel. Place reed sticks into the jar to check the length that looks right, and the number of reed sticks that look right.
- Pour into a measuring jug the fragrance or essential oil required.
- Then pour the required amount of reed diffuser on top. Mix well and carefully pour into your diffuser jar. Do not fill to the top as you need to leave space to allow for the reed sticks. You can always add more later.
- Place reed sticks into jar. Leave for 1 - 2 hours, then flip the reed sticks over and insert the dry end into the jar to saturate the other end. Ensure you wash your hands thoroughly and clean the jar with a soft clean cloth before placing in final area.
- Placement is super important. Be sure to place your reed diffuser in an area that gets air flow, to ensure the scent moves around the room. Never place in a stagnant corner, as you'll never get the benefits of all your hard work :)

Tips: I recommend flipping the reed sticks over weekly, until the scent has diminished. It's recommended to replace the reed sticks every time you, remake your diffuser as the reed sticks get covered in dust and lose their ability to diffuse oils.

Perfect placement is the key to reed diffuser success, The entry or foyer works well, when you open the door you are enveloped in beautiful fragrance that sets the scene for whats to come. If your placing your reed diffuser in your bed room or a smaller room make sure its not in a corner, you'll want to ensure airflow to really get the best out of your diffuser..
