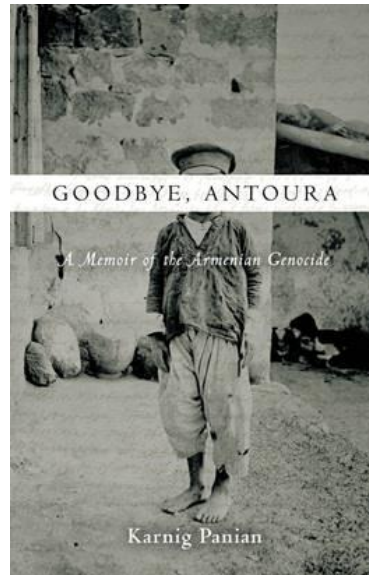


# GOODBYE, ANTOURA: A MEMOIR OF THE ARMENIAN GENOCIDE
