In the frame of the recently published volume **WOMEN MOBILIZING MEMORY** (Columbia University Press, 2019), editors and contributors will talk about their contribution to the book in the Armenian/Turkish context. **WOMEN MOBILIZING MEMORY**, a transnational exploration of the intersection of feminism, history, and memory, shows how the recollection of violent histories can generate possibilities for progressive futures.
