IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

- 1. WHEN USING ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES, BASIC SAFETY PRECAUTIONS SHOULD ALWAYS BE FOLLOWED. READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS.
- 2. TO PROTECT AGAINST RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, DO NOT PUT THE MAIN BODY (MOTOR) IN WATER OR ANY OTHER LIQUID.
- 3. CLOSE SUPERVISION IS NECESSARY WHEN ANY APPLIANCE IS USED NEAR CHILDREN.
- 4. UNPLUG FROM OUTLET WHEN NOT IN USE, BEFORE ASSEMBLING OR TAKING OFF PARTS AND BEFORE CLEANING.






- ALWAYS UNPLUG THE APPLIANCE AFTER USE. ALWAYS DISCONNECT THE APPLIANCE FROM THE SUPPLY IF IT IS LEFT UNATTENDED AND BEFORE ASSEMBLING, DISASSEMBLING OR CLEANING. WHEN UNPLUGGING THE POWER CORD, MAKE SURE TO HOLD THE POWER CORD. Puling the wire to unplug may cause electric shock or fire.
- DO NOT WASH AT HIGH TEMPERATURES OF 80°C(176°F) OR HIGHER. DO NOT PUT THE APPLIANCE IN A DISHWASHER.
 DRYER OR A MICROWAVE ETC. It may cause a failure or parts deformation.
- THE APPLIANCE WEIGHS ABOUT 5.9kg (13lb). WHEN MOVING THE APPLIANCE, ENSURE TO MOVE IT HOLDING GRIPS TIGHTLY AT THE BOTTOM OF BODY WITH BOTH HANDS.


GUIDE TO OPERATING MODES

1 MOOD-LIGHT



MOOD-LIGHT

This is indicator light for standby mode and proper assemble of the chamber. Moodlight will blink when the chamber set is not assembled properly or during use of simple cleaning mode. If the mood-light blinks when not in use of simple cleaning mode, please check if the chamber set is properly assembled to the body.



2 OPERATION BUTTONS AND INDICATOR LIGHTS (REFER TO P7)



ON|OFF

• ON | OFF - Use for standby and stop, stop extract, stop simple cleaning, power off, and exit power-saving mode. Operating state can be checked by on/off status of [ON/OFF] Indicator light.



EXTRACT

• EXTRACT - Use to extract. [EXTRACT] mode can be used after stopping the other operation by pressing [ON/OFF] button. Operating state can be checked by on/off status of [EXTRACT] Indicator light.



REVERSE

• **REVERSE** - Use when ingredients are overloaded or extraction stops during normal operation normal operation. [**REVERSE**] mode can be used after stopping the other operation by pressing [**ON/OFF**] button. It operates while holding the button. Operating state can be checked by on/off status of [**REVERSE**] indicator light.



CLEAN


• **CLEAN** - Use for simple cleaning. [CLEAN] mode can be used after stopping the other operation by pressing [ON/OFF] button. It will automatically repeat spinning (about 45sec.) and stop. Operating state can be checked by on/off status of [CLEAN] Indicator light.

STANDBY MODE

ON/OFF indicator light / Mood-light

• It indicates that it Is operational.

All indicator lights will be on when power cord is plugged in and off in order, except [ON/OFF] indicator light(\bigcirc) and <Mood-light>. It is stated before operating [EXTRACT], [REVERSE], [CLEAN] mode.







OFF MODE

ON/OFF indicator light / Mood-light

Use to turn off the power completely.

[ON/OFF] indicator light(\bigcirc) and <Mood-light> will slowly be off when [ON/OFF] button is pressed over 2 seconds. Power will completely be off when [ON/OFF button is pressed over 2 seconds during the extraction.



POWER-SAVING MODE

ON/OFF indicator light / Mood-light

 When it does not operate over 3 minutes, it will automatically switch to <Power-Saving> mode. All indicator lights and front <Mood-light> will be off.



RESTART MODE

ON/OFF indicator light / Mood-light

• Use to wake from <Power-Saving> mode.

Press[ON/OFF] button once, and [ON/OFF] indicator light(()) and <Mood-light> will be on.



GUIDE TO OPERATING MODES

EXTRACT MODE (REFER TO P14)

Extract indicator light / Mood-light

Use to extract.

Check if operating status is in <Standby> mode. [EXTRACT] does not operate during other operations so use only when its <Standby> mode.

- 1. Check if the chamber set is properly assembled.
- 2. If the chamber set is properly assembled, press [EXTRACT] button and put in ingredients. (>)
- 3. To stop the operation, press [ON/OFF] button.
- * After pressing [EXTRACT] button, insert ingredients immediately. Idling can shorten product life.
- * Never insert finger, fork or spoon etc. into the hopper, juice outlet, and pulp outlet during operation except the pusher. It may cause product damage and personal injury.



ON/OFF indicator light / Mood-light

Alarming ingredients overload

When ingredients are overloaded during extraction, the <Extract> indicator light will blink in yellow(>) with the beep and stop the operation. Operation will automatically stop and switch to <Standby> mode. Release ingredients that are stuck, using [REVERSE] button, and continue



REVERSE MODE (REFER TO P19)

Reverse indicator light / Mood-light

Use for reverse.

[EXTRACT].

Use when ingredients are overloaded or extraction stops during normal operation. Reverse does not operate during other operations so use only when its <Standby> mode.

- 1. Press [REVERSE] button after stopping the operation by pressing [ON/ OFF] button.
- <Reverse> mode operates only while holding [REVERSE] button.
 It will stop when you release the button.
- * Never insert finger, fork or spoon etc. into the hopper, juice outlet, and pulp outlet during operation except the pusher. It may cause product damage and personal injury.




GUIDE TO OPERATING MODES

SIMPLE CLEANING MODE

CLEAN indicator light / Mood-light

- Cleaning prevents flavors getting mixed with residues left in the chamber when extracting various ingredients.
- Disassemble and wash the chamber after simple cleaning which helps easier to clean.



- 1. Make sure and use only when the operation state is in stop.
- Close juice cap, open the control lever and fill the chamber to the line with clean water.
- 3. Press [CLEAN] button to operate.
- When operation stops after simple cleaning, open juice cap and release water.
- * There might be residues in the chamber after simple cleaning, so cplease clean it with cleaning brush in order to store it after use.

ASSEMBLE THE CHAMBER SET ALARM

ON/OFF indicator light / Mood-light

• Use to check if the chamber is assembled properly.

If the chamber is not assembled properly, the mood-light will blink and the appliance will not operate. Please operate it after assembling the chamber set onto the body properly.

*Using without proper assemble of the chamber set may cause product damage and personal injury.

STOPPING OPERATION (STANDBY / OFF)

Extract indicator light / Mood-light

Use when extract operation stops.

Standby mode: Press [ON/OFF/ button once from <Extract> mode. [EXTRACT] indicator light(>) will be off, operation will stop and switch to <Standby> mode. Off Mode: It will be <OFF> mode when [ON/OFF] button is pressed over 2 seconds. (Both [EXTRACT] indicator light and <Mood Light> will be off.)





How to assemble

Assemble the strainer under the groove of spinning brush just like from the picture.

If they are not completely assembled, the chamber set will not be closed.


Put the assembled part in proper place by moving left and right in the chamber just like the picture no.1.


Assemble the squeezing screw like the picture.


Put the auger by turning it to fit in the spinning brush grooves.


After putting the hopper on the chamber, turn it clockwise until it is locked completely.

Mount the chamber set on the body.


























Place the control lever of the chamber set to

Assemble the bottom of the chamber to bump of the body.





If the sign < ▲ > on the body and the sign < ▼ > behind of the chamber set are aligned well, it is perfectly assembled.






Cleaning for parts

- 01. Unplug the power cord with dry hands after the unit has been completely stopped.
- 02. Remove the chamber set from the main body. Twist the chamber cover to open and lift up the parts in order to disassemble the unit.
- 03. Use a cleaning brush and wash the chamber set under running water.
- 04. Open the control lever (OPEN) and juice cap to wash the chamber.
- 05. Wipe the main body with a damp towel or a soft cloth.
- 06. The silicone packing can be disassembled and washed. (Including juice cap packing, chamber packing, silicone brush)
- 07. Soak in water diluted with one or two drops of baking soda or natural bleach for dishes for about 30 minutes to sterilize and clean.

NOTE

- 1. If the unit is not cleaned immediately after use, a residue may dry and stick to the unit. This will make disassembling and cleaning difficult as well as lead to performance degradation.
- 2. Do not wash with hot or boiling water, an iron scrubber, abrasive material, sink solvents, or sharp deaning tools. Do not put it in a dishwasher or dish dryer. After washing, thoroughly and naturally dry, and store in a clean area.



Juice Cap Packing



Open the juice cap, hold the chamber and juice cap with one hand, and remove the juice cap packing with your other hand to disassemble.

Please be careful not to drop or damage the juice cap and chamber when disassembling the unit.


Chamber Packing



Grab the chamber packing in the chamber shaft with both hands, and lift up to remove.

Identify the upper and lower part of the chamber packing and assemble. (Refer to image)

Spinning Brush




Remove the silicone brush from the spinning brush holder.

Please follow the recommended method to separate the silicone brush. Otherwise, it may cause damage of spinning brush holder and silicone brush.

Use a cleaning brush and wash the inside and outside of the spinning brush holder under running water.

Wash the silicone brush under running water as the same method.





Place the control lever into CLOSE position at Standby.

Press [EXTRACT] button.

For your safety, this appliance only works when it's correctly assembled with chamber set.

Put ingredients gradually in the hopper chute. Push ingredients that are stuck with the pusher.

Do not press the ingredients with anything except the pusher provided.

Please put the ingredients as 3~4cm sizes.

When you extract over 400ml at once, please open the control lever every 400ml to emit the pulp.

Place the control lever into half-closed () position before putting the last ingredients.

> The hopper will be opened easily as long as the residues in the strainer are released.

After extraction is completed, press the [ON/OFF] button to stop the operation.

> Stop the machine slowly after press the button for safety and product performance.

Ingredients which needs caution.

- It may cause damage or failure.
- Fruits with hard seeds such as persimmon, Japanese apricot, lemon, plum, peach etc. that are hard to chew with our teeth should be taken out before extraction.
- For stalk vegetables with strong fiber such as water parsleys, celery etc. should be cut into small size about 3~4cm before putting into the hopper chute.
- Do not put in sesame, coffee beans, bark of the tree, Chinese pepper, etc. which cannot be extracted.
- Do not put in fruits preserved in alcohol, sugar, honey, etc. (grapes, apricot, berries, etc.) and enzymes (glasswort, house leek, etc.).
- We recommend you to drink green vegetable juice and fruit juice immediately after extraction rather than keeping them for long time.
- Do not use for grinding grains.
- It may cause damage or failure.
- Do not re-squeeze residues expelled through the pulp outlet.
- Soft fruits can be re-squeezed.
- Do not operate the appliance before putting in the ingredients.
- Do not use the appliance for more than 30 minutes continuously.
- It may cause a failure due to overheating of the motor.
- When using continuously, stop it and give it 5 minutes of interval and then you may use it again.
- Never insert finger, fork or spoon etc. into juice outlet during the operation.
- Inserting such as chopsticks etc. into Juice outlet during operation may cause them to stuck into the spinning brush and cause damage to the parts.
- Do not press the ingredients with anything except the pusher.
- It may stick to the screw and cause injury and failure.
- Do not operate the switch with wet hands.
- It may cause electric shock or fire. Do not put foreign objects near the switch.
- When you extract over 400ml at once, please open the control lever every 400ml to emit the pulp.
- The hopper can't be opened or it may cause damage when the pressure in the chamber increases.




Withered ingredients because of refrigerated for long term may make small amount of juice or impossible to make juice. If the unit is not cleaned immediately after use, a residue may dry and stick to the unit. This will make assembling and cleaning difficult as well as lead to performance degradation.

EXTRACT ONIOFF

HOW TO USE CONTROL LEVER BY MODE


- The control lever is between the juice cap and pulp outlet.
- The control lever has various functions and can help to extract juice by characteristic of ingredients except extract function.



CLOSE Preparation/Extraction mode

For general ingredients, the extraction rate is good when you close (CLOSE) the control lever during operation. When you extract over 400ml at once, please open the control lever every 400ml to emit the pulp.


For juicing the fruits with hard seeds, such as grapes, rubus coreanus, and pomegranates, place the control lever into close (CLOSE) and switch into half-closed() position when the juice begins to come out.



Completion, Simple Cleaning Mode

Place the control lever into half-closed(**()**) position when putting in the last ingredients and release the residues. The hopper will open easily when the residues in the strainer are released.

For Simple Cleaning Mode, place the control lever into half-closed (()) position and release the residues.



OPEN O Cleaning Mode

When detaching and cleaning the chamber, place the control lever completely into (OPEN ()) position. You can easily and conveniently clean the chamber.



When it is hard to open the hopper after the operation:


• Place the control lever into half-closed (①) position and press Reverse button for about 3~4 seconds. Repeat this for 2~3 times and the hopper will be open easily.

HOW TO USE CONTROL LEVER BY INGREDIENTS

• Use the control lever by the properties of each ingredients, you can make a more delicious juice.

Ingredients

Apple, pear, melon, watermelon, strawberry, blueberry, orange, grapefruits, lemon, mango, plum, peach, cherry, persimmon, pineapple, wheat-grass, parsley, celery, dandelion, carrot, ginger, potato, beet, tomato, paprika, broccoli, cauliflower, cabbage, kale, spinach, Cooked sweet potato and pumpkin, Cone.



1. Start as OCLOSE position.

When extraction is almost finished, place the control lever into, Half-Opened position

Seed ingredients

Grapes, pomegranate, blackberry, kiwi



1. Start as OCLOSE position.

2. When juice starts to come out, place the control lever into when juice starts to come out.

Mixed with Milk

Banana, strawberry and blueberry, etc.



1. Start as OCLOSE position.

WHEN THE SQUEEZING SCREW STOPS DURING THE OPERATION

- * This is a reference about how to trim the ingredients,
- so if you have allergy please choose your own proper ingredients.
- * Please refer to the recipe book for the product usage of each ingredient.

For juicing

Apple, pear, kiwi, oriental melon

Fruits like apple, pear, kiwi, oriental melon, etc. put them with seeds and peels. However, apple seeds contain toxicity, so it is better to remove them.

Pomegranate, grapes

Separate each grape from the cluster. Peel the pomegranate and use flesh only.

grapefruit

Watermelon, orange, Peel off the skin of watermelon, orange, grapefruit and cut them into right

Mango, cherry, peach

Fruits like mango, cherry, peach, or plum, etc. have hard seeds which are hard to swallow. Those seeds might cause stoppage or parts damage, so they must be removed before using it.


Wheat, chives

Put a handful of wheat or chives in not to be scattered.

Water parsleys, angelica, celery, kale

Cut fibrous ingredients into small sized less than 3cm.

When the squeezing screw stops during the operation



Press [ON/OFF] button to stop the operation. Then, press [REVERSE] for 3~5 seconds and repeat this 2~3 times.

> [REVERSE] is the button to push back the ingredients upward. Reverse only works while pressing the button, and the rotation of the squeezing screw stops if you release the button.

Press [EXTRACT] button to operate after reverse operation is completely stopped.

NOTE

Even after following the directions above and still doesn't work, please unplug the power cord and disassemble chamber set, and clean it. And try it again.

USE BY STRAINER TYPES



Coarse strainer has larger holes for making thick and

It is to make juice with soft fruits and thick juice like banana, strawberry, and also useful for smoothie, latte, or soup.

Fine strainer

Fine strainer has tiny and fine holes for making clean juice.

SIMPLE CLEAN MODE




Check if it is on <Standby>. Close juice cap and place the control lever into half-opened () position.

Fill the chamber with clean water to the end-line of the chamber.

Press cleaning button to operate. It will stop automatically after cleaning (about 45sec.) with the beep.

When operation stops after simplecleaning, open juice cap and release water.

How to assemble the squeezer set and body



1 Mount the serving spout on the body.

Align the grooves of the serving spout bottom with the bumps of the body.

Put the cone to the spin axis on the body.

Cleaning

- 1. Turn off and the remove the plug from the power outlet before deaning.
- 2. Remove the cone and serving spout from the body and clean the parts under running water.
- 3. Rinse or wash all squeezer parts immediately after use. Dried citrus pulp is difficult to clean.

NOTE

DO NOT WASH AT HIGH TEMPERATURES OF 80°C OR HIGHER. DO NOT PUT THE APPLIANCE AND PARTS IN A DISHWASHER, DRYER OR A MICROWAVE ETC.

It may cause a failure or parts deformation.

How to use squeezer



Press the [EXTRACT] button to turn on.

Prepare the juice cup that holds the juice.

Cut the citrus fruit in half. Place a citrus fruit half onto the cone and push down gently.

If you extract an excessive amount of ingredients, it may overflow.

3 When the juice fills up the serving spout, gently press the juice outlet so that juice comes out.

When you press the outlet, the squeezer will stop. Please be careful that the juice does not overflow.

NOTE

It may cause a failure or parts deformation.

Cautions for squeezer

- Remove seeds before extract. If not removed, it may contain the seeds in juice.
- If you want clear juice, use the hurom chamber for juicing
- Please wash all the pesticide on the fruit before extract.
- Please use fruit at room temperature than the frozen fruit in order to obtain a large amount.
- Please select the fruits of smooth and bright colors and avoid fruits have solid and shrink shell.
- We recommend you drink juice immediately after extraction rather than keeping them for long time.

1. The main body itself will not work.

For your safety, this unit only works when it's correctly assembled with the chamber set.

3. The Appliance does not work.

Make sure that the power cord is properly plugged in.

Check if the hopper is assembled properly.

If the hopper has not been locked into place, the appliance will not operate for safety reasons.

Check if the appliance is assembled according to the directions in the manual.

Refer to instructions for assembly in the manual or consult with your Customer Service Center for additional assistance.

4. The appliance stops during normal operation.

Have you inserted heavy loads or large pieces of ingredients into the appliance?

Refer to page 19 of the manual and follow the guideline for using [REVERSE] button.

If the issue is not resolved after following the above process, please contact your local Customer Service Center.

5. The hopper does not open.

There might be a lot of residues inside. Put the control lever in half-closed (①) position, and press [EXTRACT] button to release residues. Press [REVERSE] button for 3~5 seconds and stop it. Repeat this process 2~3 times.

Have you placed any foreign substances or solid objects (hard seed such as persimmon seed) in the juicer?

 $\label{press} \hbox{\tt [REVERSE]} \ button\ and\ push\ the\ ingredients\ back\ up\ toward\ the\ hopper\ chute.$

Do not attempt to open by force. Please contact your local Customer Service Center for assistance.



Do not insert too many ingredients at once.

If you insert an excessive amount of ingredients or thick ingredients, the unit may stop.



7. Do not use in ways other than pressing on the pusher in the inlet.

It may cause damage, injury, etc.

8. Juice leaks over the body.

Have you inserted a lot of ingredients into the hopper chute?

If you insert a large amount of ingredients compared to the pulp outlet, the packing is slightly pushed away, so the juice leaks out of the gap. Do not put too much ingredients by force and just put gradually for extraction.

9. There are fine lines or scratch marks around the squeezing screw.

These are molding marks resulting from the normal manufacturing process.

This is a normal product and there is no problem for use.

10. The Chamber shakes when squeezing.

Slight shaking may be caused by the motor.

Depending on the texture of the ingredient, there may be slight shaking.

This is a normal phenomenon as squeezing screw rotates and it is not a malfunction. Hard ingredients (e.g. carrot, potato, radish, beet, etc.) may cause more shaking than soft ingredients.

11. Chamber set does not fit into the body.

If the control lever is in OPEN oposition, the chamber set does not fit in to the body. Before assembling the chamber set, make sure that the control lever is in CLOSE position.
